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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. At 111145H a patrol from "G" Company at YD 835168 began receiving small arms fire from 841168, 840170 and 836168. VC were observed wearing black and white clothing. PF's in the same area also reported contact with VC. Some VC were between "G" Company and the PF's. "G" Company returned small arms fire and fired an 81mm mortar mission. A helicopter gunship and platoon of reinforcements were dispatched. The reinforcements were never committed. The patrol from "G" Company after firing ceased, searched the area and at YD 840170 found large blood marks, one pair of combat boots, one utility shirt, one cartridge belt with .45 cal pistol, hand grenades and K-bar attached.

2. At 111200H CAC-6's CP at YD 820182 received 100 small arms rounds and 10 60mm mortar rounds, from estimated one platoon of VC at YD 811181 and YD 815198. Marines set up defense around their CP and called in an artillery mission. 8 HE 105mm rounds were fired. VC fled in north easterly direction.

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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

At 122100H in the vicinity of YD 853135, F. Co. 2/9 OP at YD 855133 observed 3 V. C. moving from the West. The V. C. threw 3 frag grenades from approximately 45 meters outside the F. Co. lines. F. Co. units returned fire with 1 rd of M-72, 3 M-26 Grenades, and 50 rds of small arms. The V. C. broke contact, withdrew to the N. W. dragging one body. 33 Rounds of 81mm mortar illumination was fired during the encounter.
