

4. Survelliance: Most missions fired were fired into fortified hostile villages. The effect often could not be observed due to dense undergrowth.

# 5. Recommendations:

Whenever units set into defensive positions at night, Forward Observers should insure that their position is plotted on the firing charts of the Artillery Fire Control and Coordination Center. The purpose of this is for use of Counter Mortar fires utilizing polar plots. By using a polar plot all the observer has to do is give an azymuth and a distance to the target from his position. This is the fastest and easiest method of target location at night, against enemy mortars. The fastest possible reaction time in counter mortar fire is essential. This method also precludes the



possibility of an error on the part of an observer trying to find coordinates at night, the possibility of the position being revealed by the observer having to turn on a light to locate coordinates on a map, and the time consuming procedure involved in this. In order to use the polar plot, however, the position of the observer must have been previously plotted on the firing charts and the observer should insure that this is done.
