

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

INTELLIGENCE

During the period the battalion sighted two hundred and fifty-eight Viet Cong by either Observation Posts or Visual Reconnaissance flights, in or near the Tactical Area of Responsibility.

Thirty-two Viet Cong Suspects were apprehended in which one was sent back to his village cleared of all suspicions. The other thrity-one were sent to MUCHS THUY District Headquarters for further interrogation. There were two Viet Cong captives which were sent to the 3d ITT in Da Mang.

FIRE ALL Enemy contacts during October 4s-2s follows:

012156 Cot - Co I sprung ambush at vicinity YD 802148 on estimated 15 VC moving direction ME to SW. After brief firefight, enemy withdrew, Two VC KIA, After ambush plateon leader decided to move to higher ground and set in a good defensive position for remainder of night. A five man scouting party was sent out and as it reached the high ground at vicinity YD 804148, they engaged approximately ten VC and took them under fire. The enemy broke contact. One U.S. H-1 carbine captured.

041905 Oct - Rock formation found by FLSU vicinity YD 885154 and a bamboo stake found vicinity YD 886154 lined up with helicopter sightest HAM 161 Command Post. Both rock formation and bamboo stake was found in front of

perimeter lines.

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050455 Oct - C Recon tripped booby trapped frag grenade vicinity ID 797109. Two friendly WIA's neither serious.

050725 Get - Company L found and destroyed one AP mine vic YD 798095. 082123 Oct - Combined Action Company, 2d platoon in vie THUY TAN Village (YD 893154) was probed with one hand grenade. Sent out patrol to check area.

Patrol returned with negative contact. 150300 Oct - C Recon plt (YD 816105) sighted six VC moving south vie YD 799122 wearing mixed clothing. Recon opened fire on group. Two VC KIA. Two M-1 carbines ser #4611762 and #5728093, and one MAT 49 (Modified) smg ser #C 34823. 162131 Oct 2 Company K, 3d plt, in ambush position vicinity YD 807158 sighted 3 to 5 VC carrying rice along trail. When the VC were eight to ten feet from ambush they opened fire. 3d platoon immediately returned the fire, One WC KIA.

One CHICOM 7.62mm (Modified) K-50 ser #363717 captured. 172030 Oct - Combined Action Squad in THUY PHU on patrol was crossing the river vicinity ID 908110. As two men of patrol had walked across the bridge and reached the east bank of the river they sighted two VC coming out of the brush. They immediately fired at the VC. The two VC returned the fire with automatic weapons and the patrol also received automatic weapons fire from two other VC in the brush. After approximately 30 seconds the VC dispersed. Negative results. 191811 Oct - Combined Action Company sighted four VC vic YD 920110 and then eight VC (First four part of the eight) wearing khaki and civilian clothes, carrying small arms. The patrol immediately opened fire and pursued the VC, but due to the flooded rice paddies contact was lost vic YD 900096. A search was made with negative results.

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201615 Oct - Company I, 1st platoon while in ambush site vic YD 797070 spotted four VC in boat crossing river. When VC were getting out of boat, ambush opened fire. One VC threw a grenade in ambush position. One friendly KIA, two friendly WIA.

221545 Oct - Company I, while moving by truck to night position hit a mine vicinity YD 859152. Metallic Pressure type mine. Believed two mines beside

each other. Seven friendly WIA.

230718 Oct - C Recon while moving along trail in a northerly direction, one man triggered a booby trap at vic YD 798108. Type booby trap unknown. Four friendly WIA.

230918 Oct - Company I, while moving to join ARVN Forces triggered a home made booby trap at vic YD 799098. Four friendly WIA. Booby trap shrapnel composed of thumb tacks.


281445 Oct - H&SCo sector of lines received three incoming rounds small amrs fire from vicinity YD 872135. Outpost #2 observed three people in that area without weapons. Company I Mobile Force sent out to check the people. Negative results.

302211 Oct - Company K, 2d platoon while in ambush was fired upon by an unknown number of VC at vic YD 913099. Incoming fire was believed to be automatic carbine fire. While lighting up helicopter LZ for medical evacuation of friendly WIA. three VC were seen moving northeast of Company VIa nogition.

311921 Oct - Company K, 3d platoon while vicinity YD 810148 made contact with 311921 Oct - Company K, 3d platoon with 3d squad Combined Action Company 312035 Oct - Company I, 3d platoon with 3d squad Combined Action Company moving to night ambush site, encountered unknown number VC vic YD 908104. Suspected three VC KIA, and others WIA. Two confirmed KIA's, and two weapons captured.

Three Visual Recommaissance flights are flown daily of the battalion TAOR for signs of Viet Cong activity.





1. SITUATION.

a. Enemy forces. Omitted.

2. MISSION. 3d Bn (Rein), 4th Mar (-) (Rein) provides security for the airfield and 8th RRU and controls TAOR by aggressive day and night patrolling.

3. EXECUTION.

a. Concept of operation. 3d Bn (Rein), 4th Mar (-) (Rein) accomplishes assigned mission by maintaining a porimeter deficuse around tital installations with three rifle companies (e), H&S Company, LSU and by aggressive patrolling of forward areas by perimeter units, two separate plateons, and a Recon Plateon. The Combined Action Company provides tactical forces and civic action units for the village areas. H&S Company provides a reserve plateon for duty during hours of darkness.

b. Company K - Airfield Defense Company

- (1) Provide two plateons (+) for the security of the airfield from 1708CO October to 2408CO October. Continue improving defenses. Provide a combat outpost. Conduct scheduled security patrols and ambushes after dark to possible enemy mortar range of the airfield in accordance with Reference (b). Maintain 24 hour communications with COC.
- (2) Provide two squads for Hill 225 and conduct a daily security patrol from Hill 225, in accordance with Reference (c). Conduct an inspection of Hill 225 during this period and report results to S-3.

- (a) With one squad, conduct a daylight ambush on Hill 52 (YD 814125). Return to Base Camp by conducting a security patrol to Hill 36 (YD 842155).
- (b) With two squads (+), conduct a night ambush along the dirt road within grid square (YD 8215).

(5) Friday, 22 October

Angelon Street

- (a) With one squad, conduct a daylight ambush withing grid square (YD 8015). (S-3 Operations Chief will accompany patrol.)
- (b) With two squads (+), conduct a night ambush within grid square (YD 8116).
- (6) Saturday, 23 October With one squad, conduct a daylight ambush within grid square (YD 8113).







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CLOSE COMBAT

- The 2nd Platoon of Company I and 2nd Platoon of Company L returned to Bn CP area. The 2nd Platoon of Company I held night ambush at coord (YD 802146). The 2nd Platoon of Copany L held night ambush at coord (YD 896083). At 2156, the 2nd Platoon of Company I made contact with the enemy. Friendly casual ties none. Known enemy casual ties, 2 KIA's. They captured I carbine with rice and 782 Gear. The Joint Action Company continued operations in villages of THUY LUONG, THUY TAN, THUY PHU, and LOC BON. Companies I, K, L and H&S with LSU and 4/12, maintained airfield and CP security.
- The 2nd Platoon of Company I and 2nd Platoon of Company L returned to Bn CP area. The 1st Platoon of Company L established a night ambush at coord (YD 907078). The 3d Platoon of C Recon Company held outpost at coord (YD 813079) and maintained observation over area. The Joint Action Company continued operations in villages of TEUY LUONG, THUY TAN, THUY PHU, and LOC BON. Companies I, K, L and H&S with LSU and 4/12, maintained airfield and CP security.
- The 3d Platoon of Company I and 1st Platoon of Company L returned to Bn CP area. The 3d Platoon of Company L established a night ambush at coord (YD 823152). C Recon maintained outpost during ARVN operation. They helilifted back after operation. Scouts accompanied Black Panther Company during ARVN operations. Helilifted back to Base Camp after operation. The Combined Action Company contined operations in villages of THUY LUCNG, THUY TAN, THUY PHU, and LOC BON. Companies I, K, L and H&S with LSU and 4/12, maintained airfield and CP security.

Established blocking force there. 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


### LOGISTICS

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
## COMBAT AIR SUPPORT


### 1. Helicopter

a. Helicopter support was utilized an average of 3 hours per day during October. Normal support consisted of daily re-supply, small unit helicopter lifts, and some admin flights in support of the civil affairs program. The admin flights in support of the civil affairs program consisted of transporting food stuffs and other civil affairs materials from DA NANG to PHU BAI.

b. Major tactical lifts during October consisted of three company size lifts and two howtar battery lifts. The first two company lifts were of Company L on the 23rd and 25th of October, company lifts were of Company L on the 23rd and 25th of October, in support of OPERATION RED SNAPPER. The third was the lift of Company L on their return from a local operation at (YD 783135) on 29 October, which consisted of a civil affairs project in connection with a search and clear operation. The first battery lift was the lift of four guns of Howtars 4/12 to (YD 820082) and return in support of a company size operation in that area. The second lift was also of four guns of Howtars 4/12 to (YD 898077) and return on 25 October. The batteries mission was service practice firing.

2. Close Air Support. Only one airstrike was conducted during October. On 25 October, an airstrike, utilizing two F4's, was conducted on a reported VC radio site at (YD 945967). Target area coverage was excellent but no damage assessment was available as no actual target was sighted because of jungle cover.





### MEDICAL AND DENTAL SUPPORT

## 1. SUPPLY AND MAINTENANCE

- a. The Month of October, 6 Months after our initial landing, marked a great improvement in our ability to draw supplies from all but organic sources. We received up to 90% of our requests through the Medical and MedCAP systems. We are still unable to draw sanitation supplies (lime, Insecticides, and chlorine) through the Organic system.
- b. We were able to give routine immunizations to the entire Battalion, including Gamma Globulin and influenza, de due to receipt of these vaccines this month.
- c. This Month Electric lights were installed in the Battalion Aid Station.
- d. Due to our ambulance being in for repair for the past six weeks, it is difficult to obtain transportation for patients being sent to "A" Med Co., and picking up supplies for the Battalion Aid Station at "A" Med Company.
- e. A portable refrigerator was received from the Post Exchange enabling our supply section to maintain biologicals on a minor scale. The Battalion Aid Station still should have a larger refrigerator for maintaining our own biologicals for large quantities needed in routine innoculations.

### 2. RECORDS

- a. Innoculations were begun with a large percentage of the Battalion being innoculated. There was a three day period of scheduled shots, plus a three day stragglers shot period for stragglers. The last two days of October further stragglers innoculations were given thereby cutting the number of personnel not innoculated down further.
- b. Many new personnel arriving in the Battalion report without their health record and/or dental record, thereby requiring much time and paper work either in records transmittals and/or making new health records. Also many health records and Standard Forms (502 and/or 513) are returned to the Battalion Aid Station after the patient has been given a permanent change of station to sub unit No. 2, thereby

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
causing extra delay in returning the records to the proper place. Patients are also being returned to us after being permanently changed in station without their health records, and subsequently we are unable to find their health records at the Hospital or Command to which they were transferred. It is recommended that personnel be screened more closely before heaving thier commands to insure they have all records with them. Also all patients being discharged from a Hospital carry their own health record with them when they return to duty thereby insuring possible loss of only the Standard Forms (502, 513, or 600) of hospitalization and not the complete health record.

c. For the past four months the typewriter checked out to the Battalion Aid Station has been in for repair. Due to the large amount of paper work we have to borrow one from Headquarters and Service Company, or the S-1 Section, when available. Since we are unable to acquire their typewriters most of the time a personal typewriter was acquired for all necessary Battalion Aid Station Reports.

### 3. SANITATION

- a. During the Month of October, spraying around the compound has been held to a minimum due to the large amount of rainfall creating a dilution factor. It was noted that there was a marked decrease in flies and mosquitoes during this period of time. This was believed due to the large amount of rain.
- b. Three new head sites were constructed during the Month, and all heads were scrubbed daily with disinfectant.
- c. A new vegetable preparing shack was constructed and is now in use.
- d. The main drain leading from the galley to the sump area was completely covered and has eliminated a large amount of odor.
- e. The barber shops operated by indigenous personnel are being operated in a sanitary manner.
- f. More rodents have been noted in and around the compound area. A total of eleven rats have been caught this





month. Poison baits are being placed around the sanitary fill area.

- g. The overall sanitary condition of the compound is considered to be adequate.
- 4. The Medical Civil Action Program, MedCAP, continues to run smoothly. The same Villages, same type medical teams, and the same type protective elements are being utilized as last month. Also the Corpsman with the Joint action Squads are performing the same duties and saw the same number of patients, approximately, as last month. While "L" Company was engaged in "Operation Rawhide", The MedCAP team was flown by helicopter to the Village of Nguyet Bieu, and saw about 140 patients. This is the first time a MedCAP team has visited this village due to its location in the T. A. O. R.

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### CIVIL AFFAIRS

- 1. During this period, the civil affairs program continued as in the past. The Battalion Medical Team visited each of the four villages once each week. The Medical Team treated an average of sixty-seven (67) persons per visit. Foodstuffs, toys, soap and candy was distributed throughout the four villages. The Catholic Chaplain said Mass twice in the Village of Thuy Tan with a total attendance of forty-six (46) people.
- 2. Twenty-seven (27) persons were medically evacuated to hospital facilities.
- 3. A Claims/Civil Affairs Fund has been set up (Approved by the Division Civil Affairs Officer, with funds received from the sale of garbage and a percentage of the profits taken in by the proprietor of the store within our Battalion C. P. area. From said fund, five (5, claims were paid. Two (2, claims are pending at the present time.
- 4. On 14 October 1965, the Commanding Officer, Civil Affairs Officer, District Chief, Province Chief, Village Chief and Hamlet Chiefs attended a celebration in Thuy Phu which was held in commemoration of Ngo-Dai-Tan. He willed all his property and wealth to the Village of Thuy Phu when he died.
- 5. On 26 October 1965, the Village of Loc Bon held a meeting to publicly honor the Marines for the protection, medical aid and civic action projects done for them. The Village Chief, Village Elders, Village Council, Religious Leaders, Civil Affairs Officer and CaC #4 were in attendance. The Village Chief gave the Civil Affairs Officer two (2, baskets of fruit to show the gratitude of the people of Loc Bon.
- 6. On 28 October 1965, in the Village of Thuy Tan, the Marines of GAC #2 participated in the Honor Guard and Funeral Procession at the rites held for the PF who was killed on 27 October.
- 7. The Civilian Military Advisory Council held its monthly meeting on 2 October 1965. Present were all Village Chiefs, District Chief, two District Advisors (MACV), Battalion Commander and the Civil Affairs Officer.

### COMBINED ACTION COMPANY

- 1. The CAC centinued to conduct counterinsurgency operations in the four villages. Civic Action was conducted each day which involved miner read repairs, drainage repairs and bridge support. Medical assistance was rendered each day by the Plateon Corpsmen who treated an average of sixteen (16) patients in Lec Ben, twelve (12) patients in Thuy Tan, thirteen (13) patients in Thuy Phu and thirteen (13) patients in Thuy Lueng per day.
- 2. During negations, the CAC plateons remained in their respective villages six (6) days per week and averaged eighteen (15) eperations per week. The following special operations were conducted:
- a. Two (2) plateens conducted a clear and block operation at Kinh Deng in conjunction with ARVN Forces on 8 October 1965.
- b. Two (2) plateens conducted a clear and block eperation at Thuy Luong in conjunction with ARVN Forces on 17 October 1965.
- c. A plateen intercepted a VC squad attempting to enter the Hamlet of Phu Bai II, Village of Thuy Phu on 19 October 1965. The VC spetted the Marines at a distance and retreated through populated areas into the jungle.
- d. Two (2) plateens acted as a blocking force in the Village of Lec Ben to intercept a VC plateen en 24 October 1965. Negative results.
- 3. Through the activities of the CAC, the villages remain pro-RVN and has successfully denied their use to the VC evertly and have curtailed any covert activities.
