UNCLASSIFIEDSECTION IIIINTELLIGENCE1. Enemy Situation at the Beginning of the Period.a. Operation PRAIRIE, 01 November 1966 to 30 November 1966.

(1) Enemy units believed operating in the PRAIRIE area were the 324th-B NVA Division and elements of the 341st NVA Division, possibly a regiment of this unit. Also reportedly operating in this area was the 33rd Regular VC Battalion, the 23rd Regular VC Battalion and numerous unidentified VC small units. These units both NVA and VC were and still are believed to be operating in the CON THIEN, GIO LINN areas of PRAIRIE, particularly along the DMZ.

4. Significant Trends During Period.a. Friendly.

(1) Extensive use of Popular Force units with battalion scouts proved extremely useful in that their knowledge of the terrain and local populace enabled the battalion to become familiar with the area and the people with a minimum amount of effort. It is

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highly recommended that the use of these units be continued.

b. Enemy.

(1) The enemy appears to be avoiding contact as the lack of sightings would indicate. His intentions or motives can only be assumed. However agent reports and rallier reports would indicate the enemy may intensify operations during the December rains.

5. Enemy Situation at the End of the Period.

(1) The enemy situation has not notably changed. Enemy sightings and movements have been insignificant.

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SECTION IVOPERATIONS & TRAINING

1. General. The battalion operated within its assigned TAOR during 1-30 November 1966, with most movements being of Company size or smaller. Operations were of a search and destroy or reconnaissance in force nature. The general method of operation was for companies to make a sweep of an assigned area during the daylight hours and to assume ambush positions at night.

3. Command and Control.

- a. 16Nov66-20Nov66, Company M, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines was OPCON to 2nd Battalion, 9th Marines.
- b. 20Nov66, Company M, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines returned OPCON 3d Battalion, 4th Marines.
- c. 20Nov66-23Nov66, Company H, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines was OPCON to 3d Battalion, 4th Marines.
- d. 20Nov66-30Nov66, Company I, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines was OPCON to Provisional Battalion, 4th Marines.

4. Close Combat.a. 15 November 1966

(1) At 1515H, Company L spotted one NVA wearing green uniform, straw hat, makeshift poncho and carrying weapon. NVA was 175 meters from Company L's rear elements and was heading in a NE direction at YD099638. Company L fired M79 and hand grenades and dispatched a patrol with negative results.

b. 27 November 1966

(1) At 2000H, Company M had two NVA/VC approach their lines at YD120668. Company M returned fire when NVA/VC opened fire with S/A. Results 1 NVA/VC KIA (Conf), 1 NVA/VC WIA (Conf), 1 cartridge belt, 1 knife, 1 canteen, 1 first aid pouch, 1 flashlight, 20 lbs. rice, 1 cigarette lighter, fishing line, mirror and wallet with 60 Piastres and undetermined amount of NV currency.

5. Significant Events.

- a. On 02 November 1966, the 3d Battalion, 4th Marines moved from Camp Carroll to a new base camp located northeast of CAM LO.

- b. On 22 November the 3d Battalion, 4th Marines TAOR was enlarged to facilitate the operations with the Provisional Battalion at CON THIEN.

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SECTION VLOGISTICS1. General.

a. The Logistic resources of this Battalion have been used to the fullest extent possible during this reporting period. While maintaining a defensive posture the past month, maximum effort has been made to improve our supply status. The supplies necessary to sustain this Battalion's combat effectiveness have been provided, and a 5 day stockpile of food and ammo has been completed. Plans have been formulated and action commenced to move the vehicles, supplies and equipment, presently in storage at PHU BAI, to DONG HA. This move should be completed during December.

b. The heavy rains in this locale coupled with the proximity of this unit to the lowlands have required relocation of many facilities. Additionally, maximum effort on the part of all personnel of this Battalion has been given to the maintenance of equipment, facilities and roads. Daily attention has been given to the aforementioned, as well as the repair and rework of drainage ditches and storage facilities.

2. Transportation.

a. The following vehicles are currently dead-lined in PHU BAI.

- (1) 3 Truck Platform Utility M274 - these vehicles require second echelon maintenance. Parts have been on order since June.
- (2) 2 Truck Utility 1/4 Ton 4x4 M422 - turned in to Field Maintenance for repair during August.
- (3) 1 MRC 83 - Requires clutch maintenance.

b. The following vehicles are operative and will be moved to DONG HA/CAM LO as soon as transportation is available.

- (1) 2 Truck Utility 1/4 Ton M422
- (2) 6 Trailer M416
- (3) 1 IUB & SVC Unit Power CP

cc. The following vehicles are in Field Maintenance in DONG HA.

- (1) 1 Truck Utility M422 - Since 01 Oct.

- (3) 1 Truck Utility M422 - Since 22 Nov.

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d. The following vehicles are located at CAM LO.

e. One major problem has been encountered with the advent of the monsoon season. The dirt road leading into the Battalion perimeter from CAM LO deteriorated where a stream bisected the road to the extent that vehicles were unable to cross the stream. Engineers were requested, and when provided, installed a culvert at this location and built up the area in order that vehicles could traverse this obstacle. The road mentioned is the only ground access from the south to this unit's position.

3. Resupply.

a. Resupply of this battalion for the past month has been accomplished on a daily basis, using two trucks. This method has proven to be satisfactory.

4. New Facilities.

a. A water point was established where Route 8B crosses the CAM LO River on 17 Nov 1966.

b. The water point is located approximately 1500 meters from the Battalion area. Water from this point is also provide to the 3d Battalion, 12th Marines and the 2nd Platoon, Company C, 3d Tank Battalion.

c. The water point has proven to be extremely valuable and has made possible a more economical use of vehicles and personnel. Prior to the establishment of this water point, the resupply trucks were required to make two (2) round trips to DONG HA daily to fill water trailers, a distance of approximately 12 miles one way.

5. Supply.

a. Several problems continue to exist in this area.

(1) 35% of individual equipment remains in short supply. Approximately 500 sets of utilities and 400 pairs of boots were obtained during November. Size distribution remains a problem.

(2) Individual Equipment

(a) This battalion is short approximately 175 Armored Vests. These have been on requisition since September, 1966.

b. The disposition of both supplies and troops into a

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forward and rear echelon has resulted in an unusual spread of supply personnel.

- (1) Two supply men are located in PHU BAI with the supplies in storage there.
- (2) One man is maintained at the LSA for support operations when companies are deployed and receive resupply by helicopters through the LSA.
- (3) One man is located presently with two companies at CON THIEN to assist with resupply of these units.
- (4) Two men are attending MUHMS School in Okinawa.
- (5) Four men are located with the Battalion forward and seven are located with the Battalion rear.

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SECTION VII.FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION1. SIGNIFICANT EVENTS.

- a. On 03 November 1966, India and Whiskey Batteries moved from Camp Carroll to the position occupied by 3d Battalion, 4th Marines.
- b. On 05 November 1966, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines moved up to the position of 3d Battalion, 4th Marines and assumed centralized fire control of India and Whiskey Batteries.
- c. On 11 November 1966, Headquarters, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines, decentralized fire control to India and Whiskey Batteries.
- d. On 13 November 1966, India and Whiskey Batteries began firing daylight H&I's on days of poor visibility for 3d Battalion, 4th Marines.
- e. During the latter part of the month, for psychological effects, several H&I missions were fired each night with one shell, illumination, followed by one shell HE, after a certain time lag.
- f. On 23 November, 1966, Whiskey Battery scoured firing operations and prepared to move out of the 3d Battalion, 4th Marines TAOR.

a. A total of 2928 rounds of Artillery ammunition were fired in support of 3d Battalion, 4th Marines during the month of November.

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SECTION VICOMMUNICATIONS - ELECTRONICS

1. Operation PRAIRIE: 31 November 1966 - 30 November 1966

a. Radio.

(1) The Battalion established the following radio circuits:

Battalion TAC (FM)
Regimental TAC (FM)
Regimental Command (FM)

(2) The supporting arms nets established were:

Air Nets (FM), (UHF)

(3) Interference was encountered on the Battalion TAC by a South Vietnamese Radio station. There were no cases of jamming or imitative deception.

b. Wire.

(1) Over seven miles of wire was laid to accommodate hot lines, trunk, and local lines. Three SB-22's were utilized.

c. Radio Relay.

(1) Radio Relay was employed from the battalion to Regiment using an AN/TRC-27B and was very successful. Two hot lines were utilized to link up Battalion COC with Regimental COC and two common-user channels were terminated into the battalion switchboard. The remainder of the channels were utilized by the Artillery Battalion (3/12).

d. Power.

(1) After some difficulty in trying to provide lights with inadequate generators during the month, the battalion's PU-239 was installed to provide lighting and power.

e. Message Center.

(1) 4th Marine Regiment maintained message/crypto guard for the battalion at DONG HA. The battalion S-1 delivered message traffic to the field by vehicle.

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SECTION VIIIAIR SUPPORT

1. During the reporting period air support was utilized in six categories consisting of reconnaissance, resupply, medevac, troop lift, fixed wing aerial observation, and tactical air strikes. Adverse weather hindered air operations mainly in helicopter usage. Due to operational demands, requests for this period exceeded all previous requests. Helicopter availability was such that many requirements were not filled.

2. Recon flights were requested on a daily basis and were used to reconnoiter areas for proposed ambushes and operations. Recon flights also aided in determining the relocation of the battalion CP and in selecting landing zones for troop lifts.

3. During the month there were troop lifts on ten occasions. These lifts were used in supporting recon in force operations aiding mobility and accessibility to these operations. Most of the admin and resupply lifts were handled through the S-4 with weather being a predominant problem.

4. Although medevacs were few in number, the battalion had excellent results on requests.

5. Aerial observation planes were used throughout the month for patrols and recon in force operations. During company size operations A.O.'s were utilized for spotting possible enemy ambush sites. The A.O. rendered assistance in determining troop locations in heavy brush and aiding them in finding desired trails or check points.

6. There was little need for fixed wing support within the 1/4 THOR due to the lack of enemy contact. Fixed wing were used primarily for landing zone preps and for TPQ's.

Statistical report for Air requests during this period.

a. Recon Missions. Requested 21 with only 8 completions. Cancellations were due to weather and helicopter unavailability.

b. Troop lift. 1300 personnel lifted on 10 different occasions.

c. A.O. Approximately 12 sorties.

d. Fixed Wing. TPQ's, 87 targets hit with 112,000 lbs. of ordnance. Tactical air strikes, 16 sorties.

e. MedEvacs. Two emergency MedEvacs.

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SECTION IXMEDICAL AFFAIRS1. Medical Trends.

a. A BAS was established at CAM LO consisting of the Battalion Surgeon and BAS hospital corpsmen except those remaining at DONG HA for the maintenance of records and supply functions. At the BAS it was possible to establish a ward tent and retain patients for the treatment of minor illnesses, minor injuries, and skin infections endemic in this area.

b. During the month of November replacement Hospital Corpsmen were assigned to 3d Battalion, 4th Marines, bringing the battalion hospital corpsmen strength up to T/O and making it possible to bring each letter company up to full T/O.

2. Medical Supply. In general, the medical supply problem has improved, although there continues to be shortages and procurement difficulties of some items. Requested supplies of an emergency nature, specifically Gamma Globulin for a threatened hepatitis outbreak, were promptly dispatched from DA NANG, making early administration possible.

3. Battle Casualties. There were no battle casualties during the reporting period.

4. Non-Battle Casualties.

- a. Non-Battle death - 1
- b. Non-Battle injuries - 50

5. Preventive Medicine.

a. Administration of Gamma Globulin to the battalion for a threatened hepatitis outbreak.

b. Immersion foot problems have been minimal even though the monsoon season is in full force. It is felt that the evident success of 3d Battalion, 4th Marines with regard to this problem has been a result of making warming tents available, a policy of encouraging the troops to dry their feet daily, and careful inspection daily by the company corpsmen.

c. For the period of this report, flies and mosquito control problems have been minimal. Gastro-Intestinal illnesses continue to occur, but are not epidemic and have not been severe. Malaria has been minimal.

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d. Treatment of skin irritations, fungus and cellulitis.

(1) The following number of cases were treated at BAS.

130 skin irritations and cellulitis.

e. Treatment of flu and common cold cases.

(1) 50 cases of flu and common colds were treated at BAS with a loss of 225 working days.

f. In addition to the above approximately 20% of the command was treated for skin irritations at the company corpsman level.

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SECTION XCIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the period 01 to 30 November 1966, this battalion was seriously hampered in the conduct of civil affairs by the failure to receive MEDCAP Supplies. Medical treatment of civilians consisted mainly of infant care for body sores.
2. Contact with the local District Chief was maintained and liaison concerning civilian medical problems were discussed to determine requirements.
3. Soap received from benevolent organizations was distributed to needy local populace.

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SECTION XIPROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED, LESSONS LEARNED1. Lessons Learned.

Item: Navigation and determining location in flat terrain.

Discussion: In the generally flat terrain south of the DMZ in the CON THIEN area, the hedgerows and lack of reference points make it extremely difficult to navigate and determine an exact location.

Recommendation: That helicopter reconnaissance be used to its fullest advantage prior to entry into an area. This reconnaissance should include small unit leaders (squad and fire team) when possible due to the frequent separation of these units from their parent organization. Another successful method employed is by calling for artillery/mortar illumination during daylight hours and plotting a back azimuth from the round. This method must be used with discretion, however, because of the over flight of the canister beyond the illuminating round.

2. Problems Encountered.a. Effects of Weather.

(1) The heavy rains, accompanied by a sudden drop in temperature, during this period made it difficult to maintain the same tempo of offensive operations. The difficulty of the individual to maintain a high mental and physical posture necessitated increased emphasis on troop habitability and medical treatment. The extremes of weather required increased maintenance of organic vehicles and equipment and increased the necessity for awareness of 1st and 2nd echelon maintenance requirements.
