NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the period 1-3 March 3d Battalion (-) (Rein) continued search and destroy operations in their assigned AO. From 3-6 March companies I and L were opcon to 1st Bn, 4th Mar and company K(-) was opcon 2d Bn, 4th Mar from 1-10 March 1969. On 5 March the Alfa Command displaced by heli-lift to vicinity XD997615 and on 7 March assumed command of India and Lima companies. From 7-31 March 1969 3d Bn continued assigned search and destroy mission in "Mitters Ridge" area. Enemy activity was reported as extremely heavy, and contact with the enemy by the Battalion was almost continuous throughout this period.

## 17 INTELLIGENCE

Introduction. During the month of March, the Third Battalion, Fourth Marines saw a large increase in enemy activity. Our Battalion continued the defense and development of Vandegrift Combat Base, LZ Russell, Dong Ha Mountain and Mitters Ridge. While attempting to secure LZ Mack, LZ Sierra, and LZ Dodge, the Battalion came upon a well entrenched and freshly supplied enemy. Bitter fighting ensued until all objectives had been firmly secured. In our TAQR, it is evident that the enemy has been receiving fresh supplies and troops for we have uncovered large caches of food, clothing and weapons.

Weather. During the month of March, the weather varied from extreme hot temperatures to periods of rainy, cool days. For the first half of the month, 1-15 March, the temperature averaged a high of 88 degrees and a low of 72 degrees. The wind ranged 1-3 miles with a ceiling from 500 to 2500. The

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humidity averaged 85%. For the latter half of the month, 16-31 March, the temperature averaged a high of 81 degrees and a low of 66 degrees. The wind ranged from 2-5 miles with a ceiling from 500' to 2000'. The humidity averaged 83%.

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ENCLOSURE (3)

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a. Daily resupply of Class I, II and IV items have been conducted from Vandegrift Combat Base and Quang Tri LSA by helicopter and from Quang Tri by truck. Some Class IV items have come by motor convoy to Vandegrift Combat Base from Quang Tri and by helicopter to the companies at their various positions.

b. Scheme of Operations: The S-4 operation was once again divided into three areas.

(1) S-4 rear maintained all paperwork and coordinated movement of men and materials (primarily Class II) to Vandegrift Combat Base.

4. Maintenance. Minimum utilization of the M-151A1 and M-274A2 vehicles in accordance with Division Directives has alleviated many maintenance problems. The present 1st and 2d echelon maintenance program is highly effective and will continue for all vehicles.
