NARRATIVE SUMMARY1. General Overview of all Activities

- a. Third Battalion, Fourth Marines continued Operation HEMLOCK MOUNTAIN which commenced 9 May 1969. The battalion area of operation consisted of the vital areas of VANDEGRAFT COMBAT BASE, FSE CATES, HILL 950, HILL 691 and SIGNAL HILL and the ground area contiguous to these locations. ELLIOT COMBAT BASE and environs was added to the area of operation on 1 June 1969. For the period 12-17 June 1969 operational control of the western portion of the area of operation (FSE CATES, HILL 691 and HILL 950) was relinquished to TASK FORCE GUADALCARNAL to facilitate better coordination and control of their operations adjacent to our area of operation.
- b. Deliberate defense and improvement of the vital area continued throughout the month. Particular attention and effort was delegated to the improvement of bunkers, communication trenches, field of fire, and tactical wire.
- c. In conjunction with defense of the vital areas aggressive offensive operations were conducted throughout the month to locate and destroy the enemy. In response to continued rocket attacks on VANDEGRAFT COMBAT BASE elements were assigned to search the "Rocket Valley" area situated West and Northwest of SIGNAL HILL. With increased enemy harassment of Route 9 between ELLIOT COMBAT BASE and KEE GIO bridge a company was assigned to sweep and clear the ridgelines Northeast of ELLIOT COMBAT BASE. To bolster long range security around ELLIOT COMBAT BASE a company assumed the mission to meticulously search the caves which abound within the "RAZORBACK" Northwest of ELLIOT. Generally throughout the month few positive indications of enemy activity, other than rocket attacks and mining incidents, were encountered.

2. Intelligence

- a. During the month of June 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines took over the AO of VANDEGRAFT COMBAT BASE as Base Defense Battalion. The Battalion conducted reconnaissance patrols, ~~99%~~ and ambushes in and around VANDEGRAFT COMBAT BASE. The responsibility for the AO included FSE CATES (XD920437), HILL 691 (XD927443), HILL 950 (XD845465), and SIGNAL HILL (XD970480).
- b. During this period enemy activity was confined to rockets and mortars attacks on the VANDEGRAFT COMBAT BASE complex. One company had the task of the road sweep from ELLIOT COMBAT BASE and KEE GIO bridge. The road sweep found an assortment of different kinds of mines. They consisted of 10" Claymore mines, 8" and 10" pressure detonated mines, ED mines, command detonated and plastic coated anti-vehicle mines.
- c. Weather
During the month of June, the weather remained generally hot with periods of morning fog. During the period of 1 through 19 June the temperature averaged a high of 90 degrees and a low of 79 degrees. The humidity averaged 50% to 60%. The ceiling ranged from 2,000 to 5,000 feet scattered with visibility unlimited. The wind averaged 4 to 8 knots with gusts during the 1 through 19 of the month up to 25 knots. The period of 19 through 30 June the temperature averaged a high of 104 and a low of 78. The humidity averaged about 60%. The ceiling ranged from 2,000 to unlimited with visibility limited only in the morning. The wind averaged 5 through 12 knots variable.

(1). During June forward observer teams supported 3d Battalion, 4th Marines in its mission of defending the complex of VCI, ECF, Cates-691 and Ca Lu. Fire missions concentrated on counter rocket fire to suppress and destroy the rocket positions hitting VCI from the West.

In addition to individual missions on suspected rocket sights there were three counter rocket programs used. They were fired as rocket suppression before enemy attack. Though volume of fires and fire response time were adequate, supporting arms were not able to destroy the enemy ability to fire at will.

(2). The biggest fire support problem involved A.O. boundaries. 3/4's position at HILL 950 was located inside another task force's A.O. making it slow to get fire mission clearances or a battery to shoot. Also, the rocket belt that hit VCI was not always under the control of 3/4 which had the mission of defending the base. Another problem existed in the area that the 4th Marines and 3d Marine's boundaries met above Elliot. The boundary crossed the road in an area of enemy small unit action and frequent mining. Direct fire support liaison was not allowed between the two adjoining battalions in the respective A.O.'s. This necessitated a lengthy clearing system involving twenty minutes for a fire mission.

(3). It is recommended that a prime consideration in A.O. boundaries be a concern for fire support. Also, direct fire support liaison should be allowed whenever it will bring fire on the enemy quicker.

5. LOGISTICS

a. Logistics

(1). Daily resupply of Class I, II, and IV items have been conducted from LZ Vandegrift by helicopter and truck. Some Class II items have come by motor convoy to Vandegrift from Quang Tri and by helicopter to the companies at their various positions. Due to the fact that Company I has occupied lines at Vandegrift and Company M occupied lines at Elliot, resupply to these companies is easily accomplished. Resupply to Lima and Kilo Companies was also good due to their stationary positions at FSE Cates, Hill 691, and HILL 950.

(2). Scheme of Operation: The S-4 operation was divided into three (3) areas.

(a). S-4 rear coordinated movement of men and material (primarily Class II) to Vandegrift.

(b). S-4 forward maintained all paper work. Our resupply base, LZ Vandegrift, is maintained with S-4 personnel, the battalion mess section, motor transport personnel, Battalion Mail-Room and one (1) mailman representative from each company. The messhall cooks for personnel and transients at LZ Vandegrift. Hot meals are given to the companies whenever their positions make it possible. The overall operations at LZ Vandegrift went smoothly and efficiently.

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(a) An S-4 capability was always maintained with the Battalion Command Post to handle incoming and outgoing goods and provide proper liaison with the Battalion Commander at each position.

b. Supply

(1) The overall supply support during this period was good.

(2) Some critical shortages of supplies existed and were reported in the Logistics Summary Report.

c. Transportation

(1) The Battalion holds four (4) M3791 vehicles on record. Of the four all vehicles are operational. One (1) M3791 is TAD to Task Force Hotel.

(2) The battalion is authorized thirty (30) M274A2 vehicles and presently holds twenty-six (26) with four (4) M274A2 vehicles currently on order. Of the (26) M274A2 vehicles presently held by the Battalion twenty (20) are operational, three (3) are at FLSC-B for major assemble repairs, two (2) are in the 3/4 rear area undergoing second echelon maintenance and one is in the 3/4 forward area undergoing second echelon repairs.

(3) The Battalion presently holds four (4) M107A1 water trailers. These are to be replaced by five (5) M119 water trailers. One M119 is now held by the Battalion and is operational. Four (4) M119 water trailers are currently on order.

(4) The Battalion holds one (1) M170 Ambulance which is operational.

(5) The Battalion holds five (5) communications vehicles. Four (4) are operational one (1) IRC-109 is awaiting acceptance at FLSC-B.

(6) The Battalion holds eighteen (18) M1601 (1/4 ton jeep trailer) vehicles.

(7) The Battalion holds twenty (20) M151A1 (1/4 ton jeep) vehicles. One (1) M151A1 is presently being used by Task Force Hotel. One (1) is awaiting acceptance at FLSC-B for clutch repair. Nineteen (19) are presently operational.

d. Maintenance

(1) The M274A2 vehicles create the most serious problems. Poor drivers maintenance and lack of interest in the vehicle compound the problem. It is quite difficult to obtain parts for these vehicles here in northern I Corps. Due to the outstanding work being done by the mule mechanic the deadline has been kept down to a minimum.

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(2) The Battalion in reality maintains two (2) rear. One at VCB, the other at Quang Tri. This almost doubles the transportation request and creates the necessity for many trips between VCB and Quang Tri.

6. Communications-Electronics

a. Generally radio and wire communication throughout the month has been clear and effective. A commanding general's inspection was held 17 June 1969 with the Communications Section passing with a very satisfactory mark.

b. For the units in the field a relay station was established at Elliot Combat Base to facilitate better communication as needed. Those companies, which manned the perimeter at Vandegrift Combat Base were provided, with telephones to facilitate defense communications.

c. An evaluation of the month shows that the present T/E is not sufficient to support this particular battalion. To meet present requirements five more RC-292's are needed. Fifteen TA-I's are on order. The present supply system does not provide sufficient BA-386's, RL-259's, MX-306's on DR's. When H-209 hand sets are turned into FLSG-B, they have to be complete or they won't be accepted for repair. This creates a problem because many times elements of the transmitter or receiver have been lost in the field. These elements can only be replaced by FLSG-B thus causing an unnecessary delay in handset repair.
