2. The reporting period began with the Provisional Battalion located at NUI CON THIEN. On 8 December 1966 at 1515H the units at NUI CON THIEN became OPCON to 3d Battalion, 4th Marines. The Provisional Battalion was reformed on 8 December 1966 at CAM LO, there were no changes in personnel at this date, rather a shift of commands was effected.

a. At 1430 on 5 December 1966 K Co 3/4 became OPCON to Provisional Battalion

b. At 1515H 8 December 1966 Golf Co 2/3 became OPCON to Provisional Battalion.

- d. At 1515H on 8 December 1966 K Co 3/4 dropped from OpCon of Provisional Battalion to 3rd Battalion 4th Marines.
- e. At 1515H 8 December 1966 1st Plt H Co 2/3 became OpCon to Provisional Battalion.
- f. At 0800H on 10 December 1966 Provisional Co was formed and became OpCon to Provisional Ba.
- g. On 11 December 1966 F Co 2/9 dropped from OpCon of Provisional Battalion to 3d Battalion 4th Marines.
- h. At 1400H on 11 December 1966 I Co 3/26 became OpCon to Provisional Battalion.
- i. At 1000H on 12th December 1966 1st Plt H Co 2/3 dropped from OpCon of Provisional Battalion to 2d Battalion 3d Marines.

SECTION IIIINTELLIGENCE1. Area of Operations.

a. General: The area of operations for the Provisional Battalion 4th Marines during the period 1 December through 1515H 8 December 1966 lies within Gio Linh District, Quang Tri Province, Republic of South Vietnam. The area is bounded on the north by the southern boundary of the DMZ, on the east by north-south grid line YD 16 on the south from (YD 160 672) to (YD 088673) and on the west by the river at (YD 088 673) northward along the river to the southern boundary of the DMZ. This area lies within the piedmont between the coastal lowlands on the east and the mountainous area immediately to the west. The area of operation for the Provisional Battalion 4th Marines during the period 8 December 1966 to 0600H 24 December 1966 lies within Cam Lo District, Quang Tri Province, Republic of South Vietnam. The area is bounded on the north by grid line YD 64 and on the east by grid line YD 16 and on the west by grid line YD 07. The southern boundary is the Cam Lo River.

3. General Trends.

a. During the reporting period there was an increase in booby trap/land mines in the vicinity of NUI CON THIEN. It is felt that these booby traps/land mines were due to the increased activity with in the T-OR by friendly units. Previous incidents of booby traps/land mines were infrequent.

b. During the period of 8-24 December 1966 there were frequent rallier reports of a VC platoon operating to the east of Provisional Battalion TAOH. Patrols and ambushes were increased along the eastern boundary of the TAOH but with negative results.

c. Twice during the period of 8 December to 24 December 1966, reports were received from the Army Advisor at Cam Lo of a VC cadre operating in the southeast area of the TAOR. Units were immediately sent into these areas but negative results were obtained.

d. Most signings during the period were of small groups (2-3 personnel which confirmed the reports of no large units working within the Provisional Battalion TAOR.

SECTION IVOPERATIONS1. FIELD COMBATa. 21 December 1966

(1) At 0630H Company L hit a booby trap at YD 113712 resulting in 3WIA friendly. Booby trap consisted of two chicom grenades detonated by a trip wire tied to a vine.

(2) At 0745H Company L hit booby trap at YD 113713 resulting in 2 WIA friendly. Booby trap was of same type as described above.

(3) Between 0800H and 1000H Company L found 4 more booby traps of type described above. All were detonated in place by L Co.

(4) At 1150H Company L found two VCS at YD 113719. Returned VCS to Provisional CP for questioning.

(5) At 1200H Company L had one man step into a punji trap at YD 113718 resulting in 1 WIA friendly.

(6) At 1303H Company L found two VC's at YD 117722. Returned VCS to Provisional CP for questioning.

(7) At 1400H Company L found one VCS at YD 110722. Returned VCS to Provisional CP for questioning.

b. 22 December 1966

(1) At 1005H India Co 3/4 found one anti-personnel mine at YD 136706. Mine of pressure type. Destroyed in place.

(2) At 1130H India Co found undetermined amount of rice at YD 140717. Rice to be returned to Provisional CP. India Co also picked up one VCS and returned same to Provisional CP for questioning.

(3) At 1210H India Co located a second rice cache of undetermined amount at YD 139716.

(4) At 1230H Lima Co located at YD 152715 found two VCS. Returned same to Provisional Battalion.

(5) At 1230H India Co located at YD 139716 found one VCS and returned same to Provisional CP for questioning.

(6) At 1415H Lima Co located a rice cache at YD 159717 of 3,000 lbs.

(7) At 1520H Lima Co found three VCS at YD 150716. Returned same to Provisional Battalion.

(8) At 1530 Lima Co located another rice cache of 4,000 lbs. at YD 156715.

(9) At 1545H Lima Co found one VCS at YD 139717. Returned VCS to Provisional Battalion CP for questioning.

(10) At 1830H India Co found 4 more rice caches at YD 139715 consisting of 3,000 lbs. of rice.

e. 05 December 1966

(1) At 0945H Lima Co found a rice cache of 3,000 lbs. at YD 153716.

(2) At 1008H Lima Co found three rice caches of undetermined size at YD 157718.

d. 21 December 1966

(1) At 1400H Lima Co at YD 153716 received 7 to 8 rds. of sniper fire from YD 155720. Returned fire with S/A's and called artillery fire on target with negative results.

e. 02 December 1966

(1) At 1015H Lima Co at YD 180725 received 5 to 6 rds. of enemy 60mm mortar fire from vicinity YD 185726. Called artillery fire on target. Unable to check target because of present mission.

(2) At 1020H Kilo Co at YD 180716 received one short round as a result of artillery mission fired by Lima Co, resulting in one WIA friendly.

(3) At 1405H Lima Co at YD 133719 received one WIA friendly from electrically detonated booby trap. At the same time Lima Co received one sniper rd. from YD 130725. Returned fire with S/A's resulting in one enemy KIA and one enemy WIA captured.

f. 10 December 1966

(1) At 1220H Foxrot Co while on patrol spotted 3 VC at YD 161639. Opened fire with S/A and M-79 with negative results.

g. 11 December 1966

(1) At 2140H, Golf Co in night position at YD 165645 received two enemy grenades approximately 20 meters in front of their position. Negative results.

h. 15 December 1966

(1) At 2047H, India Co, 3/26 ambush at YD 163623 received S/A's and incoming grenades resulting in two KIA's friendly and five WIA friendly. MedEvac called and all ambush personnel with exception of KIA's were evacuated.

i. 16 December 1966

(1) At 0750H, India Co, 3/26 retrieved bodies of two friendly KIA's resulting from action of night of 15 December 1966. Found evidence of one WIA enemy (prob).

j. 18 December 1966

(1) At 1822H, Lima Co at YD 136674 received one RPG rocket round on flank of lead tank resulting in three WIA's friendly. Returned fire with S/A's and 90mm canister from tank. Swept area with negative results.

SECTION VLOGISTICS

1. During the period 1-8 December 1966 all resupply for the Provisional Battalion was done by helicopters. A five day supply of Class I (excluding water) and Class V was kept on hand. All resupply requests were transmitted by the MST to the LSA. Resupply requests were made daily prior to 1700 for resupply the following day. Daily water resupply was flown in by helicopter from Dong Ha. The supply of water consisted of from 150 to 190 5 gal. expeditionary cans per day with no more than a one day supply on hand at any time. During the period rain water was caught in field expedient containers for use as washing and cleaning water.
2. With the return of the Provisional Battalion to Cam Lo on 8 December 1966 resupply was effected from the LSA at Dong Ha using two trucks daily. There no longer existed a need for resupply by air since the roads leading to the position at Cam Lo were adequate for truck usage. The water point that had previously been installed at the Cam Lo river was utilized and no further problems with water resupply were encountered. A five day supply of Class I and Class V was maintained at Cam Lo as it had been at Nui Son Thien. Requests for resupply were taken by the S-4 and then forwarded to 3d Battalion, 4th Marines rear at Dong Ha for final action. With the return of 3d Battalion 4th Marines to Dong Ha on 18 December all resupply requests were sent directly to the S-4 there and the requests of the Provisional Battalion were filled by that unit.
3. With the exception of a delay in receiving 106mm ammunition no further problems were encountered in logistics.

SECTION VICOMMUNICATIONS - ELECTRONICS

1. The Radio nets established at both NUI CON THIEN and CAM LO were:
 - (a) Regimental Command
 - (b) Regimental and Battalion Tactical
 - (c) Artillery
 - (d) Naval Gun fire (at NUI CON THIEN only)
 - (e) Air; both VHF and UHF
 - (f) 81mm Mortar
2. No enemy interference or jamming of nets was experienced
3. A covered-voice radio net was established and used at both NUI CON THIEN and CAM LO. The equipment used consisted of a AN/PRC 109 with KY-8 using the Regimental Command frequency.
4. With the shift of commands occurring on 8 December 1966, the communication facilities remaining at CAM LO were utilized by the Provisional Battalion for the remainder of the reporting period.
5. Although no unusual problems were encountered, a lack of adequate back up equipment could have presented difficulties. Since the equipment used by both Provisional Battalion and 3d Battalion, 4th Marines was taken from 3/4 Comm. assets.
6. The message center was controlled by 4th Marine Regiment and messages were delivered to the field on a daily basis by courier.

SECTION VII

FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION

1. Significant Events:

a. During the period 1 December 1966 to 8 December 1966 the Provisional Battalion had "A" Battery, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines in direct support.

b. The fires of "A" Battery were reinforced by fires from "I" Battery, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines while the Provisional Battalion located at NUI CON THIEN.

c. With the shift of the command from NUI CON THIEN to CAN LO, "I" Battery, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines provided direct support to the Provisional Battalion.

d. On 14 December 1966, "W" Battery, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines arrived at CAN LO and their fires were used in direct support of the Provisional Battalion.

e. These batteries fired a total of 5,394 rounds of 105mm ammunition in support of Provisional Battalion's operations.

(1) Timely and accurate fires were placed on targets of opportunity.

(2) Preparation fires were placed on objectives/LZ's and covering fires were placed on flank and rear areas.

(3) Extensive use was made of artillery in reconnaissance by fire.

(4) R&I fires were used to suppress enemy activity and deny access to key terrain.

SECTION VIIIAIR SUPPORT

1. During the period air was used for recon, resupply, TPQ's and aerial observation. Recon flights were scheduled daily and were used to reconnoiter areas for proposed ambushes and company operations. Recon flights also aided in determining landing zones for troop lifts for both recon in force and search and destroy operations.

2. During the period 01-08 December 1966, aerial resupply was a key factor during this period due to the inaccessibility of NUI CON THIEN by vehicle. Aerial resupply was handled through the S-4 Section with the air team assisting at the landing zone. After the displacement of the Provisional Battalion to CAM LO a requirement for aerial resupply no longer existed.

3. Aerial observer planes were used in conjunction with all company size operations for recon and spotting proposed targets or possible ambush sites. In the event of enemy contact, the aerial observer was already on station and in radio contact with the ground forces, which reduced the time lag in calling tactical air strikes.

4. Weather was a limiting factor during this period and in some cases caused cancellation of air requests.

SECTION IXMEDICAL AFFAIRS

1. The Provisional Battalion BAS, which consisted of 4 hospital corpsmen with equipment during 01-08 December 1966, and 6 hospital corpsmen with equipment during 08-24 December 1966, was adequate for handling all of the local and immediate needs of the Provisional Battalion.
2. MEDICAL TRENDS. The major problem area was in skin infections endemic to this area of Vietnam. Constant supervision of field sanitation and checking of personnel by unit corpsmen held this problem to a minimum.

5. PREVENTATIVE MEDICINE. Negative report.
6. MEDICAL SUPPLY. Although some items of medical supply remain in short supply there has been no reduction in medical services due to shortages. All medical supplies received came from FLSU at DONG Ha.

SECTION XCIVIL AFFAIRS - PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE

1. CIVIL AFFAIRS. Negative.
2. PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE. Numerous leaflet drops were conducted in both TAOR's that the Provisional Battalion operated in. These leaflets emphasized surrender appeals and separation from the family to the enemy. In addition the surrender appeals could be used as safe conduct passes by the enemy.
