NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of December 1967, operations continued at a normal level. Four Officers and 87 enlisted personnel were joined, and two officers and 53 enlisted personnel were dropped from the Battalion. During this reporting period the Battalion has continued to support the III Marine Amphibious Force Headquarters with Communication Center, Combat Operations Center, radio and wire communications. Due to an influx of personnel, the III Marine Amphibious Force Communication Center has been able to establish a three section watch. Total message count at the III Marine Amphibious Force Communication Center for the month of December was 63,440. Traffic count for the Combat Operations Center was 14,495. In-country and out-of-country radio communications were continued using TSC-15 vans, and MRC-83s.

(6) Morale - The morale of this organization is very high and continues to improve.

(7) Disbursing - The Force Logistic Command provided disbursing support to this organization.

c. Intelligence - None

d. Training

(1) Formal training was conducted in Vietnam oriented subjects, selected General Military Subjects, Military Occupational Specialty, Related and Merging MOS subjects.

(2) Familiarization firing was conducted at the Special Forces, East Danang, Training Center for 493 members of the Battalion. Weapons fired included Rifle M-16 and Pistol Caliber .45. In addition, 6 hours of formal instruction was conducted on individual weapons to include care and cleaning of the rifle and magazines.

(3) Seven Marines attended "out of country" formal schools operated by other commands and fifteen Marines attended "in country" formal schools operated by other commands.

(4) The Battalion Command Information Program was conducted throughout the month of December 1967. Specifically, the following Vietnam and professional orientation classes were conducted:

(d) 35 incoming personnel recieved the Battalion initial orientation lecture conducted by the Battalion Sergeant Major.

e. Special Operations. The Battalion continued to provide electronic equipment support to the Headquarters of the Combined Action Group.

f. NBC Warfare. Newly joined personnel of the Battalion participated in a gas chamber exercise. 64 members of the Battalion presently assigned to NBCD Teams are currently enrolled in the MGI 57.5 group study course.

g. Communications. The Battalion continued to provide communication support to the Commanding General, III Marine Amphibious Force, and limited support to the 1st and 3rd Marine Divisions, 1st Marine Aircraft Wing and the Force Logistic Command.

h. Logistics

(1) All Battalion light vehicles were equipped with locking devices and locks. Captain MCLAUGHLIN joined the S-4 as the assistant S-4 Officer. Construction has been 95% completed on the G. I. houses for the mess hall. Construction of side walks in Headquarters Company is under way. FLC conducted Logistics and Embarkation Inspections of the Battalion. One (1) Sea Hut was furnished to house a Camp Library.


