

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Construction Platoon assisted MAG-16 for a total of 44 man hours. They made a section throw on M-1 and M-10 cable that were damaged by fire. They cleared troubles on M-9 and FLC 300 cables damaged by a rocket attack. Fifteen foot stubs were set in the 5th Communication Battalion beach for the security platoon. Two 40 foot blackjack wood poles were set in at Camp Monohan. They installed

2000 feet of five pair cable from 5th Communication Battalion to the ROKMC R&R Center at China Beach. Also installed was 4338 feet of 25 pair cable from H&MS-17 to MWSG-17. From Monkey Mountain MACS-4 to Panama CKC was stretched 9220 feet of fifty pair a cable. They installed 3150 feet of 100 pair cable from Marine Air Freight to 31 Test. This job is incomplete. Cable splicers made a section throw on M-9 cable to clear trouble. And 7000 feet of five pair cable was installed from Sea Anchor Communication Center to the 95th Evacuation Hospital. Training on TRC-97's was conducted by our technicians and operators for Army Personnel from the 54th Signal Brigade.
