PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of December, Construction Platoon completed the following. Installed two 300 pair Cables and one 100 pair cable between 1st IAAM Battalion and 1st MAW. Installed a 25 pair cable between AFVN and MYM ICS. Installed one 100 pair and one 25 pair cable at FLC. Installed a 12 pair cable at Doc Lop street. Replaced telescopic poles with blackjacks at 5th Communication Battalion. Installed a hot line between 67th MED, 80th Support Group, and 15th Airport. Reinstalled telephone service to III MAF R&R center. Installed lines and phones at Trang Qui GAP. Issued a 50 pair cable to 1st M.P. Battalion. Provided construction and repair assistance to MACS -4. Repaired all circuits

that were reported out during the month of December 1968. Trouble shot the M-8 cable and a 50 pair cable on Monkey Mountain. In completing these commitments, the following materials were used; 9,263 ft. of 300 pair cable; 4,500 ft. of 100 pair figure 8 cable, 480 ft. of 50 pair cable, 8,638 ft. of 25 pair cable, 2,920 ft. of 100 pair cable, 300 ft. of 12 pair cable, 11,055 ft. of messenger, 10 poles and 9 miles of WD-1/TT.
