#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- l. During the month of January the Fifth Communication Battalion filled its standing commitments to the III Marine Amphibious Force Headquarters, the First Marine Division, the Third Marine Division, the First Marine Air Wing, and the 2nd Republic of Korea Marine Brigade. In addition the Battalion Reaction Platoon conducted ambushes and patrols for the security of our compound. No significant events occured during these operations.
