PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of January the Fifth Communication Battalion filled its standing commitments to the III Marine Amphibious Force Headquarters, the First Marine Division, the Third Marine Division, the First Marine Air Wing, and the 2nd Republic of Korea Marine Brigade. In addition the Battalion Reaction Platoon conducted ambushes and patrols for the security of our compound. No significant events occurred during these operations.

2. Weekly MedCaps have been conducted at Damon Hamlet on Saturday afternoons. A dental assistant from the First Engineer Battalion Accompanies the MedCap Team twice monthly. 80 persons have received medical care and 30 children dental care during the month.

3. Communication Support Company remains in cadre.

a. Communication Center processed a total of 59,651 messages, and Combat Operation Center 15,019 messages for a total of 74,690 messages processed during the period.

b. Motor Transport Section dispatched 1,823 runs which transported 23 tons of cargo and 6,494 passengers a total of 46,611 miles.

c. Battalion Supply processed 1,147 requisitions of which 569 were completed.

d. The Construction Platoon expended 43,000 feet of 25 pair cable, 22,740 feet of 50 pair cable, 1,045 feet of 300 pair cable and 2,660 feet of 100 pair cable during the month, maintaining and expanding the III MAF Cable System. 24 work orders were completed during this period.
