

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of April the Fifth Communication Battalion continued to perform its mission of providing communication support to the III Marine Amphibious Force Headquarters, the First Marine Division, the First Marine Air Wing and the Second Republic of Korea Marine Brigade.
2. On 15 April the 5th and 7th Communication Battalions were combined under the command of LtCol C. L. BRADY. Both battalions will maintain their separate identities but will be controlled by one Commanding Officer and his staff. At the time of the merger both battalions were placed under the administrative and operational control of the Commanding General, III Marine Amphibious Force. Limited administrative support will continue to be supplied by Force Logistics Command.
3. Movement of 7th Communication Battalion from Hill 34 into Camp Hoa Long commenced during the latter part of April with the move scheduled to be completed early in May.
4. Weekly MEDCAPS were conducted at the Damon Hamlet. 167 persons, predominately children, received medical treatment and 15 received dental care during these visits. In addition, 127 orphans received medical attention during the weekly visits to the Con Dien Orphanage.
5. Communication Support Company, 5th Communication Battalion remains in cadre.

DECLASSIFIEDPART IIISEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS1. Routine Operations

a. The III MAF Communications Center and Combat Operations Center, both operated by 5th Communication Battalion personnel, processed a grand total of 73,039 messages during the month of April.

b. 348,380 telephone calls were completed during the month by the III MAF TCC-28 switchboard.

c. Construction Platoon of Radio Relay and Construction Company expended 2614 man hours during April maintaining and expanding the III MAF cable system. Approximately 4 miles of cable was installed during the period.

d. Radio Relay Platoon is currently operating 17 pieces of equipment supporting III MAF, 3rd Marine Division, XXIV Corps, and 1st Marine Division.

e. Camp Maintenance began construction on an auxiliary 3,000 gallon water system and a Recreation Building. Plans for a 100,000 gallon water system with infiltration gallery were submitted to Force Engineers.

f. Inspection of each company was conducted by Staff Sections during the month.

2. Personnel/Equipment Deployments

a. Twelve men are manning five AN/MRC-62's and one AN/TRC-97 in support of the Third Marine Division.

b. Three men and one AN/TRC-97 are in support of the First Marine Division.

c. Three men and one AN/TRC-27 are deployed to Force Logistics Command.

d. Eight men, one AN/TRC-97, one AN/MRC-83, two RT-524, and supporting equipment are at Phu Bai in support of the XXIV Corps.

e. Five cable splicers are on TAD orders to the 45th GEEIA, in the DaNang area, to assist in cable repair.

f. Three Marines are assigned to the III MAF Headquarters to operate four AN/TRC-27's and one AN/MRC-62.

g. The First Marine Air Wing Communications Center is augmented by eighteen men from this battalion.

h. Five men are TAD to Vandergrift Combat Base.

i. Three Wiremen are assisting the 37th Signal Battalion in the DaNang area.

During the month of April 1969 Construction Platoon completed the following commitments: Installed a pole line at I Corps Headquarters and moved old lines to new poles and installed a 200 pair cable.

Installed phones and drop lines for MAG-11 and MWSG-17, repaired the M-52 and M-45 cables, installed two (2) 55 ft. poles in 212 ARVN battalion. Transported four (4) telephone poles at Tien Sha to ARVN 611 Signal battalion. Installed a 50 pair cable on existing pole line from MAG-16 to Beach house, replaced 750 ft. of 800 cable at FLC. Trouble shot and repaired 50 pair cable between MACS-4 and 620 TCS. Installed two (2) 25 ft poles in 5th Comm Bn. motor transport parking area, installed four (4) 20 ft poles at 3rd AMTRAC Bn, issued 6000 ft of 100 pair 19 AWG cable to 1st MARDIV. Issued 3015 ft of 100 pair 22 AWG cable to NSA, replaced seven (7) 40 ft poles at the Golden Gate USO, provided five (5) cable splicers on a TAD basis to GEEIA for a period in excess of 30 days, dug 66 post holes for 1st Engineer Battalion, moved one (1) telephone pole for I Corps Headquarters, provided 10 pair from M-52 cable for 1st M.P. battalion, issued 3000 ft. of 100 pair 22 AWG and repaired M-26 and M-35 cables at bridge ramp area. Installed nine (9) ten ft. poles behind the Mess Hall to mount gas tank. Established MRC-62 link between 5th and 7th Comm., all other Radio Relay circuits were maintained as previously reported.
