During the month of October 1969, Construction Platoon completed numerous work orders. Trouble-shooting crew spent many hours locating and repairing bullet holes and cuts in cables through-out the Danang Area. Some of the major construction completed was;

- a. Replaced 300 feet of 50 pair cable and put in 2 new poles at 1st MAW Compound.
- b. Installed a new 50 pair cable and two terminals in the III MAF Compound.
- c. Set poles for foot bridge in 5th Comm. Cantonment.
- d. Installed two 50 foot poles for MARS Station at 37th Signal Bn.
- e. Installed two 25 pair cables from Hill 327 to DASC at 1st DIV Headquarters.
- f. Started construction of poles and cable for Fire Alert System at Asp #1.
- g. Started construction of new 25 pair cable from 7th Eng. Bn. to Northern Artillery Cantonment.

Total man hours for Construction Platoon for the month of October 1969, were; 930 hours, total materials used for the month were; 220 feet 50 pair 19 AWG cable, 15,000 feet 25 pair 19 AWG cable, 5,000 feet of 6M messenger, 88 poles, & large quantities of expendable splicing materials used in repairing and splicing cable.

During the month of October 1969, Radio Relay Platoon completed the following commitments;

- a. Replaced PCC-1 equipment presently employed on ROKMC shot with VCC-1 equipment.
- b. LT I and turned into Bn. Supply two generators (PU-278) for further issue to CEO of 1st MARDIV.
