





1. On Tuesday, 21 April 1970, a sweep of "Dogpatch" was conducted. The following units participated: Hoa Vang District Headquarters, National Police Field Forces, 1st MP Battalion, 1st Marine Division MP's, 5th Communications Battalion, Marine Wing Headquarters Group - 18, and Marine Wing Service Group - 17. 



PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of April 1970, Construction Platoon completed thirteen operational commitments. Two operational commitments consisting of burying 15,000 feet of 25 pair cable and providing a crew to 1972nd Comm. Sqdn. are still in progress.

Major construction completed during the month involved the installation of 19 poles, 14,100 feet of multi-pair cable, and 10,100 feet of messenger. Total man hours were 2,044 hours.

During the month of April 1970, Radio Relay Platoon completed three operational commitments. Temporary loaned one PU-278 generator to 1st MARDIV, temporary loaned two AN/TCC-3 with spiral 4 cables to 2nd ROK Marine Brigade, established MRC-62 ship to shore circuit at FLC, deactivated MRC-62 ship to shore circuit at Camp Horn Water Tower, and deactivated AN/TRC-27 link from Camp Horn to FLC.

Radio Relay Platoon man hours involved in new commitments were 28 hours. Total materials utilized were one PU-278, two AN/TCC-3 and one AN/MRC-62. Radio Relay Platoon is now maintaining eight AN/TRC-97E, five AN/MRC-62 in support of III MAF, XXIV Army Corps, 1st MAW, 1st Marine Division, FLC, 1st Radio Bn, and Americal Division.






