PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of May 1970, Construction Platoon completed nine operational commitments. Work is in progress on two additional commitments.

Major construction completed during the month involved installation of 10 poles, 29,662 feet of multi-pair cable and 3,350 feet of messenger cable, totaling 1,673 man hours.

During the month of May 1970, Radio Relay Plt. completed two operational commitments. Temporary loaned two PU-278 generators to 1st Regt. 1st Mar. Div. May 1,6,7, and 8 completed training on PCC-1, VCC-1 and VCC-2 operations for 1st Division personnel. School commenced on 15 April 1970.
