

3. THE BATTALION WAS NOTIFIED OF THE NEED TO MEET THE GROWING REQUIREMENT FOR MARINE COMMUNICATIONS BATTALION ELEMENTS FROM THE 7TH COMMUNICATION BN ... AND ... OF PERSONNEL AS IT WAS BEING ORGANIZED.
4. BY 13 MARCH 1968, 5TH COMMUNICATION BN HAD REACHED COMBAT STRENGTH. IT THEN MOVED INTO ITS BASE CAMP AT BANG THANG, RVN. FROM THIS BASE, ELEMENTS OF THE BATTALION RANGED FROM THE BOKONG DELTA TO THE DMZ SUPPORTING MARINE AND OTHER FREE WORLD FORCES ENGAGED IN COMBAT. THIS COMMUNICATIONS SUPPORT RAN THE GANT FROM LOCAL TELEPHONE LINES TO WORLD WIDE RADIO AND TELETYPE COMMUNICATIONS.
5. DURING ITS RVN SERVICE, THE BATTALION PARTICIPATED IN SUCH OPERATIONS AS DOUBLE EAGLE I, DOUBLE EAGLE II, AND HASTINGS. HUE, DONG HAI, THE ROCKPILE, KHE SANH, AND FSB VANDERGRIFT WERE AMONG THE PLACES WHERE 5TH COMMUNICATION BN MARINES SERVED IN THE THICK OF BATTLE.
6. AS MARINE UNITS BEGAN REDEPLOYING FROM RVN FOLLOWING A DECREASE IN THE INTENSITY OF THE WAR, THE BATTALION BROADENED ITS MISSION FROM ONE OF PROVIDING SUPPORT TO III MAF AND THE 3D MARDIV UNTIL IT ENCOMPASSED ALL MARINE UNITS IN I CORPS (INC. MR 1). IT ALSO SUPPORTED THE 2D MARINE BRIGADE, XXIV CORPS HQ AND OTHER ARMY AND AIR FORCE UNITS IN


