NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period, the Battery missions remained unchanged:
(a) Battery (-)(Rein) - General support of Americal Division, and reinforcing the fires of the 2nd ROK Marine Brigade Artillery; (b) 1st Platoon - General support of 3rd Marine Division; reinforcing the fires of 12th Marines; (c) 2nd Platoon - General support of the 1st Marine Division; reinforcing the fires of 11th Marines. 1st Platoon remains attached to 1st 8" Howitzer Battery and 2nd Platoon attached to 3rd 155mm Gun Battery.

On 17 November 1967, the 1st Platoon displaced one (1) gun from Cam Lo and moved by road to a prepared position at Gio Linh. Command and control remained with 1st 8" Howitzer Battery. During the reporting period, the Battery (-)(Rein) fired 3148 rounds, in 1399 missions. Damage to the Insurgent Viet Cong forces includes: 26 confirmed KIA, 45 possible KIA, 18 WIA, 37 structures destroyed, 7 sampans destroyed, 1 secondary explosion, 1 rice supply.
