NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During February 1968, the battery under the command of Major E. B. BEALL, Jr. continues to support the Army's 1st Air Cavalry Division in the Northern I Corps area. The battery headquarters, 4 155 Guns and the attached 8 inch platoon are located at landing Zone SHARON, Quang Tri City, in general support of the 1st Brigade, 1st Air Cavalry Division, reinforcing the fires of the 2nd Battalion, 19th Artillery, the Brigade's direct support battalion. Battery operations consist of numerous daytime missions for aerial observers in support of "OPERATION JEB STUART" and nightly TOT missions and H&I's.

The 2nd Flatoon, under the command of 2d Lieutenant G. A. NEAL, is located at Landing Zone EVANS (formerly Camp EVANS) and is assigned the mission of general support/reinforcing the fires of the 2nd Brigade, 1st Air Cavalry Division. The entire battery is under the operational control of the 1st Battalion, 30th Artillery located at Landing Zone EVANS.

The battery supply rear, the last battery elements to depart from Ch u Lai, under the command of Captain R. B. CASSIDY, debarked 10 February 1968 from IST shipping and arrived at Dong Ha via the Cua Viet River. The battery rear area has been established in Dong Ha and includes the supply facility and motor transport maintenance.

Problem areas include serious personnel shortages in certain critical ranks and MOS's and the deadlining of 3 M53 155 Guns and 1 M110 8 inch Howitzer.

Primary emphasis in the new position continues to be the preparation of positions, defensive bunkers, and the establishment of local security. The battery has received occasional incoming rockets and mortars in three locations, one attack on the Dong Ha Supply rear damaged beyond repair 2 MRC 83 radio vehicles, 1 M109 Shop Van, 2 BC scopes and 2 pair of binoculars. No personnel casualties have been sustained.
