



PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During December 1968 the mission of the 5th 155mm Gun Battery (SP) (Rein) remained the same reinforcing the 12th Marines. The opcon commander is the 108th Artillery Group (USA). On 1 December the battery came under the direct administrative command of the Commanding General, 9th Marine Amphibious Brigade (CG 9thMAB 190744Z DEC68). By 5 December the battery command post had been displaced from Camp Carroll to Dong Ha West. (YD 20705957). Firing positions were maintained at Fire Support Base Elliott (Rockpile) and Ca Lu. Fire direction remains centralized from the FDC at Dong Ha West. On 26 December the battery instituted a complete secondary check of all fire direction data from a separate check/alternate FDC at Ca Lu. Maximum use of directional antennas (AS-2236) insures reliable communications the 15 miles between positions. By 14 December the equipment readiness of the battery had deteriorated to C-4 with only one gun operational. The status improved slightly, from 15-26 December, but by the months end the equipment status was again C-4 with one 8" howitzer and one 155 gun operational.


From Fire Support Base Elliott (Rockpile) a total of 1178 rounds of 155 gum ammunition were fired on numerous unobserved TCT/artillery/rocket suppression fires. Construction of tropical huts and incoming bunkers was begun in a new 4 gun position 500 meters from the present 2 gun position. By 26 December the Seabees had completed the construction of 4 heavy gun pads.

Firing from the Ca Lu position totaled 745 155 gun rounds and 692 8" Howitzer rounds. Targets were mostly unobserved TOT/artillery/rocket suppression fires and long range support of recon units. Construction of a new 4 gun position at Vandegrift. Combat Base was begun to include tropical huts, an FDC and personnel bunkers. The Seabees by the month's end had completed one of four gun pads.

The high weapons deadline rate was caused by engine, transmission, sight mount, elevating mechanism repairs; several tube changes; and the non-availability of needed repair parts (ie. oil cooler fan). During most of the month only 2 155 guns and 1 8" howitzer were operational. One 8" howitzer is deadlined for a M15 sight (M21257-8334-0032); one 155 T/E deficiency exists (M21257-8332-0016). The VTR (M51) remains on deadline since 1 October 1968 for a transmission. Personnel readiness continues C-2 with 88% of essential ranks and MOS on hand.

On 10 December a training program on the 175 guns was initiated in conjunction ith A battery, 2nd Battalion, 94th Arty. Training includes firing battery, fire direction procedures and maintenance classes followed by periods of OJT.

The battery continues to support Operations SCOTIAND, HIRISE, KENTUCKY and the newly initiated operation DAWSON RIVER (281200 NOV68)
