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### Part II Narrative Summary

During the reporting period 1 - 30 November 1969, the 5th 175mm Gun Battery (SP)(REIN) commanded by Major James c. ATKINS Jr., remained under operational control of the 108th Artillery Group and continues its mission of reinforcing the fires of the 108th Artillery Group. At 0800, 5 November 1969 the battery came under direct control of the 108th Artillery Group. The battery remains under administrative control of the 11th Marine Regiment.

On 6 November 1969, the battery rear at Dong Ha West closed and displaced to Dong Ha. The Battery Fire Direction Center displaced to Camp J. J. Carroll this date also. The 175mm Gun Battery displaced from Dong Ha on 8 November 1969 to Camp J. J. Carroll. As of this date the six 175mm Guns are all together at Camp Carroll.

On 8 November 1969 2ndLt A. C. WHIDDON, Oll 00 54/0801, joined the battery and joined the firing battery at Camp Carroll.

Colonel D. D. EZELL, Commanding Officer, 11th Marine Regiment visited the battery on 14 November 1969. After discussing the overall situation with Major James C. ATKINS Jr., he returned to the 11th Marine Regiment at DaNang.

On 25 November 1969, Colonel R. HIXON from XXIV Corps visited our position at Camp Carroll and Alpha-2. Two days later Colonel HIXON once again visited our two firing positions to wish the troops a holiday greeting.

The battery fired support of the following unnamed operations, lst Bde/5th Mech, 2nd ARVN and lOlst Abn. Rounds expended for the battery during the reporting period were Alpha Platoon 2062 rounds and the 175mm Gun Battery fired 2452 rounds.

Camp J. J. Carroll received eight 140mm incoming rockets on 8 November 1969 with negative damage to personnel and material.

On 30 November 1969, 1stLt W. E. CROFT, 010 01 54/0802 joined the battery and will relieve 1stLt R. L. BAILEY when he returns to CONUS.

The battery personnel status is C-1 through the reporting period with critical MOS shortages in the 2151 field.

The battery continues to support AO's within Northern I Corps.
