1st Battalion, 5th Marines continued to participate in Operation "TAYLOR COMMON". During this period, the Battalion conducted aggressive offensive operations to seek and destroy and capture enemy forces, weapons, material, and positions; secured and protected routes of ingress and egress for the movement of friendly logistical support and supported and protected US and RVN installations and convoys.

PART IIISEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTSA. TOPICS1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

a. Strength. The Battalion's strength at the beginning of the month was 35 officers and 1156 enlisted. On 15 March, the strength had changed to 35 officers and 1097 enlisted. By the end of March, the strength was 36 officers and 1133 enlisted. At this time, there are no officers and 31 enlisted hospitalized. Joinings during the month were 12 officers and 169 enlisted.

b. Discipline, Law and Legal. 4 Summary Courts-Martial and 4 Special Courts-Martial were convened during March. There are 3 Summary Courts-Martial and 4 Special Courts-Martial still to be processed. During March, 6 informal investigations were completed. There are 3 informal investigations pending.

c. POW/Detainees. There were 48 detainees processed during the month.

d. Morale. Morale and fighting spirit continued to be excellent. Personnel who captured POW'S received in-country R.R.

e. Postal. Postal service continued at the same degree of excellence.

f. Awards. During March, there were 1 Navy Cross, 4 Silver Stars, 4 Bronze Stars, 6 Navy Commendations, and 32 Navy Achievements submitted for heroism and meritorious service.

g. Interior Management. Administrative procedures and proficiency continued to be excellent.

~~CONFIDENTIAL~~**2. ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN**

a. Enemy. During this reporting period, the enemy continued his probing and harrassing tactics with a limited offensive attack occurring at 0130H, on 19 March 1969, in which he conducted a sapper assault supported by flames and rockets upon the Battalion CP/Fire Base at Phu Loc (6). This action resulted in 72 NVA KIA and 1 NVA POW along with numerous individual and crew served weapons captured. A continued decrease in the number of mine and booby trap incidents during this period was noted. The Battalion had 36 mine and booby trap incidents compared to 47 such incidents from last month.

b. Weather. During this period, the weather was warm to hot during daylight hours, and mild to cool at night. Air operations were hampered by heavy mist and ground fog, which occurred during 2200-0700 hours.

c. Terrain. No change.

**3. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS**

a. Organization. The organization of the Battalion consisted of the following units under the operational control of the 1st Battalion during the following periods:

(1) Company A, 1st Battalion, 5th Marines OPCON to 5th Marines from February through 312400H March 1969.

(2) Company C, 1st Battalion, 5th Marines OPCON to 5th Marines from February through 251200H March 1969.

b. Operations. Operation "TAYLOR COMMON" (Search and Destroy Operation) in the eastern part of Duc Duc and the Duy Xuyen District in the Quang Nam Province of RVN terminated on 080800H March 1969, (See Tab "B" Combat After Action Report, "TAYLOR COMMON"). During the period of 8-31 March, the Battalion participated in an unnamed operation which continues into the month of April. The area of Operations, Mission and Concept remains the same as that of Operation "TAYLOR COMMON".

c. Supporting Arms.

(1) Air. The Battalion continued to receive outstanding air support from both 1st MAW and USAF squadrons. There was an overall increase in fixed wing support as compared to previous months primarily due to an increase in A-6A availability for Beacon Hops. A detailed breakdown of air support rendered during the month is as follows:

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(a) Fixed Wing. A total of 176 flights of fixed wing were flown in support of this Battalion. 28 AO/TACA aircraft provided 17.0 hours of on station coverage, controlling 6 flights of fixed wing close air support as well as providing protective cover and conducting visual reconnaissance. Additionally, 11 flights of fixed wing were controlled by Battalion FAC's. Further close air support consisted of 143 A-6, recon hops, and 16 USAF "Nite Owls". 2 Spooky Gunships provided 3.3 hours of target coverage and 1 flareship provided 3.7 hours of illumination. Of the total number of flights, bomb damage assessment is available for only 73 flights and is listed below:

(b) Rotary Wing. Helicopter operations consisted of daily resupply missions and Medevac's. 46 MEDEVAC missions extracted 85 Marines (20 of whom were classified as emergencies) and 45 indigenous personnel.

(2) Artillery. D battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, with six 105, and two 155 Howitzers. Was in direct support, furnishing accurate and timely supporting fires throughout the Battalion's area of operations. D battery fired 141 missions expending 2602 rounds. The following is the total surveillance on-call missions fired by D battery for units of the Battalion:

The majority of enemy casualties resulted from missions observed from a tower (located at AT925538), which afforded an excellent view of the surrounding terrain. Especially to the West along the Son Thu Bon River, where numerous enemy attempts at crossing were denied by artillery fire called in from the tower.

The Battalion received additional fire support from E battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, F battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, K battery, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines, and B battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines.

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(3) Engineers. Excellent support was again provided by Company B, 1st Engineer Battalion. Engineers were employed primarily to destroy duds, booby traps, captured enemy ammunition, enemy bunkers/fortifications and to conduct daily mine sweeps of the road networks in the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines AO. Numerous mines and booby traps were detected by visual sightings and mine detecting equipment. Loss of lives, wheeled and tracked equipment was considerably reduced by the detailed searching efforts employed by the engineers.

(4) Shore Party (HST). HST's were provided by Company B, 1st Shore Party Battalion. These teams provided satisfactory support in co-ordinating and effecting helicopter resupply and Med-evacs.

(5) Amtrac. A light section of the 4th Platoon, Company A, 3rd Amtrac Battalion was in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines during this period. The LVT's provided satisfactory support in transporting troops.

(6) Tanks. A light section of the 2nd Platoon, Company B, 1st Tank Battalion was in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines. Excellent results were achieved by using tanks to support the daily MSR mine sweeps, providing direct fire support to the daytime Battalion OP's and were also used extensively as convoy security between An Hoa and Liberty Bridge, and at night were employed into the defensive networks of Liberty Bridge.

(7) Scout Snipers. Detachment Scout Sniper Platoon, Headquarters Company, 5th Marines provided outstanding support for the Battalion, which resulted in 21 enemy kills during the month.

#### 4. TRAINING

a. The following training was conducted during the month:

- (1) Weapons Safety
- (2) Weapons Inspection, Care and Cleaning
- (3) Radio PRC 60

b. All companies during their period of bridge defense continued to have instructions and familiarization firing of all individual and crew served weapons, including the LAAW-72, hand grenades and claymore mines.

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c. Replacement personnel received four (4) days training at 5th Marines Headquarters prior to being committed to the field.

d. The Battalion continued to utilize schools provided by higher headquarters. During the month, 29 members of the Battalion attended school in the DaNang area and Okinawa.

5. LOGISTICS. No serious problems have occurred during this period to impair the logistical support of the Battalion.

6. CIVIC ACTION. During the reporting period the Battalion worked with the people of My Son (384471) and limited work with the people in the area surrounding Liberty Bridge.

The Battalion assisted the people of My Son in constructing two homes destroyed by VC. There were seven homes still under construction at the time of departure to Liberty Bridge. A total of 62 asserted boards, 79 sheets of plywood, and 24 sheets of roofing tin were distributed for this purpose. Two trailer loads of firewood was delivered to supplement the shortage in the hamlet.

Very limited work was done in the Liberty Bridge area due to the distance from the camp and the security involved. However, two village chiefs and one hamlet chief from the Xuyen Loc and Xuyen Hoa villages and Cu Ben hamlet were guest of the camp in order to discuss problems of their respective areas. A total of 28 civilians were treated for wounds and/or sores and infections. Two pounds of soap was distributed around the area for sanitation purposes. Eight civilians were killed and eight civilians were injured due to an accident involving a tank on the ferry. The bodies were taken for burial and the injured were medevac to the German Hospital for treatment. The persons involved were thrown into the water and lost their identification cards. 1st Tank Battalion S-5 is hampered by this problem.

7. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS. During the reporting period the Battalion has received little intelligence information from the elders. All intelligence information has been passed on to the Battalion S-2 Section and Counter-intelligence.

In accordance with the rewards program the following pieces of ordnance was turned in to the Battalion: 4-155 mm HE rounds, 9-105 mm HE rounds, 6-81 mm fl. rounds, 2-106 mm HEAT rounds, and 1-4.2" HE round. The 105 mm HE and 155 mm HE rounds were blown outward from the ammo dump to the surrounding area. More rounds are believed to be in the hamlets. A total of 50,200 \$VN will be paid to the people by 2/11 Civil Affairs who will be working in the My Son area.

ENCLOSURE

The attitude of the people toward this Battalion remains in excellent standing.

**8. COMMUNICATIONS.** During the month of March, all communications within the Battalion were maintained in a satisfactory manner. The PRC-88 radios were issued to all letter companies and are presently in use in the field. A PPS-6 radar unit is going to be used in the Alpha defense sector, which will enable the Battalion to maintain a radar watch of the approach routes in our sector.

## 7. Supporting Arms

( ) Air. This operation showed an increase in the tempo, as well as the scope, of air operations flown in support of this Battalion. During this period, the 1st MAW and USAF rendered excellent fixed and rotary wing support, a summary of which is as follows:

( ) Fixed Wing. This support consisted of 41 flare ships for 603 hours; 35 CH-47 gunships for 46.4 hours; 252 TACA/AO Teams provided 322.9 hours of time on station for VR's, protective cover, and controlling Tactical Air Strikes (TAS). 451 TAS missions were flown in support of the Battalion, providing close and deep air support for contact missions, as well as against S-2 targets and targets of opportunity detected by AO's and ground units. TACA/AO Teams controlled 198 airstrikes. 73 missions were FAC controlled and the remaining 180 TAS missions were A-6 Beacon strikes.

Of the total TAS missions flown during this operation, definitive bomb damage assessment is available for only 234 flights and is listed below:

( ) Rotary Wing. Helicopter operations, exclusive of daily resupply missions, consisted of 5 troop lifts; 3 visual recon missions; 3 Gunships, and Med-Evac missions for 464 USMC/USN (210 of whom were emergency category) and 92 indigenous personnel.

( ) Night Owl. During the month of January, 1st Battalion, 5th Marines initiated a new concept, "Night Owl" (Close air support at night). These air strikes were controlled by the FAC which consisted of marking the targets at night with artillery and 81mm mortar illumination, timed to burst at ground level. Experience proved a string of four covering an area of 100-150 meters marked the target best and provided the pilot a good ground reference for this attack. Each flight carried napalm and 500 pound bombs. Napalm was dropped first to further mark the target. The results were excellent and this system proved to be accurate. Excessive damage and numerous KBA's were observed through a starlight scope. This in close co-ordination with Spooky Gunships and A-6 Beacon strikes provided the Battalion with a 24 hour air strike capability and has denied the enemy the safe cover of darkness for his operations.

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(b) Artillery. Delta Battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines provided direct support for the Battalion during the operation from 7 December 1968 to 2 January 1969, and from 20 February to 8 March. Direct support for the period 3 January to 19 February was provided by Tango Battery and a platoon from Whiskey Battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. 1014 missions were fired with a total expenditure of 24,362 rounds.

In addition to the close and continuous fire support provided by the direct support batteries, the Battalion received general support and reinforcing fires from the units of 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and the 1st Field Artillery Group. Their support permitted massing of fires on targets throughout the Battalion's area of operations.

(c) Engineers. Excellent support was provided by Company B, 1st Engineer Battalion. Engineers were employed to destroy duds, booby traps, captured ammunition, enemy bunkers/fortifications and to conduct daily mine sweeps of the road networks in the 1st Battalion's AO. Numerous mines and booby traps were detected by visual sightings and mine detecting equipment. Loss of lives, wheeled vehicles and track equipment was considerably reduced by the detailed searching efforts employed by the engineers.

(d) Shore Party (HST). HST's were provided by Company B, 1st Shore Party Battalion. These attachments provided satisfactory support in coordinating and effecting helicopter resupply and Med-Evacs.

(e) Amtracs. A light section of the 4th Platoon, Company A, 3rd Amtrac Battalion was in direct support of the Battalion. The LVT's provided satisfactory support in transporting troops and were used occasionally as convoy security between An Hoa and Liberty Bridge.

(f) Tanks. A light section of the 2nd Platoon, Company B, 1st Tank Battalion was in direct support of the 1st Battalion. Excellent results were achieved by using tanks to support the daily MSR mine sweeps, providing direct fire support to the daytime Battalion OP's and on a few occasions supported company size operations on outlying road and trail networks within the AO. Tanks were also used extensively as convoy security between An Hoa and Liberty Bridge, and at night were employed into defensive networks on Liberty Bridge.

(g) Scout Snipers. Detachment Scout Sniper Platoon, Headquarters Company, 5th Marines provided excellent sniper fire for the Battalion, which resulted in 26 enemy kills during this operation.

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8. Intelligence

a. Estimate of NVA/VC strength and disposition in the objective area. See Annex B (Intelligence) to 5th Marines Operation Order 7-68.

b. Enemy strength and disposition actually determined during the operation. Based on contacts, POW/Detainees, and intelligence reports received from higher headquarters, enemy strength is estimated at one regiment and two separate battalions with local force VC units deployed within the Battalion AO/R.

c. NVA/VC units identified. Interrogation of enemy POW/Detainees and enemy documents recovered revealed the following enemy units identified:

- (1) Front 4
- (2) R20 Bn
- (3) Q82 Bn
- (4) 36th NVA Regt

d. Significant intelligence gained. During the 7Dec68-22Feb69 portion of the operation, the enemy forces avoided major contacts and offensive actions within the Battalion AO. They continued to rely on harrassing types of actions, sniping, night probes and a heavy emphasis being placed on utilization of mines and booby traps placed on the MSR and close to road observation posts. On 23Feb69, the enemy launched his post-Tet offensive, at which time he mortared the Battalion fire base at Phu Loc (6) with 30 rounds of 82mm fire and probed the lines with small arms and B40 rocket fire. The enemy has continued to harrass the fire base since this time by 60mm mortar fires.

(1) Local VC Operations within Liberty Road AO. Local VC normally start at the small sub-hamlet levels in groups of 5-10 in a sub-hamlet. The sub-hamlets meet on order and form platoon size units from the village. In the La Thap (1) AT947517, Am Tam (2) AT956508, and Ton Bon (2) AT 975517, there is a local platoon operating in each of these areas. Each platoon is assigned missions as follows: population control, observing U.S. Marine positions and operations, resupply rice runs, booby trapping the MSR and selected areas. The local force VC use OP's (sometimes children on water bulls), surprize firing devices, and runners for early warning of approaching friendly forces. They deploy their units to the southeast and north to avoid contact with friendly forces.

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(2) Routes utilized. Local Force, Main Force and NVA units enter the AO and travel from the Nui Duong Thong Mountains from AT 910457 northeast to AT 946480, north into the Chau Phong area (which is a major staging area for food and supplies) at AT 945500, then follow the railroad east/northeast to AT 996516, and continue north into Goi Nai Island, which is a staging and training area for these units and also a southern approach area into the Dai Loc District and the DaNang Vital area.

(3) River Crossings. The VC/NVA continue to cross the Song Thu Bong river in both northern and southern directions between grids AT875508 north to AT912529. Crossing attempts occur just after sunset between 1800-2030 hours. During the operation, over 40 enemy were killed by preplanned fires while attempting river crossings.

(4) Caches. Numerous rice caches were discovered which total over 137 tons. Weapons and ammunition caches were also uncovered, which hampered the enemy effort to store and resupply his unit operations. Stream beds have been the lucrative areas; in general, caches discovered were buried 4-6 inches under loose sand, where a probe would penetrate easily.

e. Terrain. No change.

f. Weather. During this operation, the weather was warm to hot during daylight hours and mild to cool at night. During this period, low ceilings and heavy ground mist hampered some air operations to a small degree.

9. Mission. 1st Battalion, 5th Marines conducted in assigned AO aggressive offensive operations to seek and destroy or capture enemy forces, weapons, material and positions. Secured and protected US and RVN installations, units and convoys.

10. Concept. 1st Battalion, 5th Marines with one company and Battalion Command Group established a holding position at Liberty Bridge ferry landings to protect that installation and to provide security for daily mine sweeps to clear Liberty Road from Liberty Bridge to the An Hoa Combat Base. One company to keep Liberty Road open and to protect friendly convoys by constant surveillance and interdiction of enemy threat to the road by daily OP's and night ambushes and patrols along the axis of the road. Remaining companies conducted aggressive offensive operations in the An Hoa area to destroy enemy forces, and were prepared to provide reaction forces to assist the An Hoa Combat Base and local US and RVN installations and units, and were prepared to deploy to any portion of the Regimental AO to conduct offensive operations.

i. Destroyed Fortifications. See Section 7., Paragraph (a), (1).13. Administrative Matters

a. Supply. Resupply was accomplished by both helicopter and wheeled vehicle. The Command Post and units near the MSR were resupplied by wheeled vehicles, while units off the MSR were resupplied by helicopter. No serious supply problems have occurred during this operation to impair the logistical support of this Battalion.

SECRET

b. Maintenance. No serious maintenance problems were encountered with weapons or equipment during the operation.

c. Transportation. Both helicopters and wheeled vehicles were the primary means of transportation, supplemented by LVT's. There were no significant problems encountered with transportation.

d. Communications. During the period covered by Operation "TAYLOR COMMON", the communications within the Battalion were maintained in a satisfactory manner with no significant difficulties encountered.

During this operation, the AN/PRC-77, KY-38 voice cypher unit was carried in the field with the Command Group. This equipment proved itself to be highly dependable and functional under all conditions encountered. A new antenna system, the AS-2236, was also employed. This antenna gives the Battalion a much greater directivity and range when using the AN/PRC-25. In order to avoid the compromise of frequency changes, a new system was devised to transmit the frequencies over the air. In addition, continuous briefings along with communications improvement memos have decreased the security violations of the Battalion during this operation.

e. Treatment of Casualties, Evacuation, Hospitalization and Medical Evaluation. Two permanent BAS's were in use during Operation "TAYLOR COMMON", one at the An Hoa Combat Base and the other with the Forward CP at Phu Lac (6). Minor injuries incurred in the field were sent to one of the BAS's, while more serious injuries were evacuated directly to either Alpha Co, 1st Med Bn at An Hoa, or to medical facilities in DaNang. Malaria was a considerable problem during the month of January, but its incidence decreased considerably by the end of the operation. Suspected malaria cases were sent to the BAS, An Hoa for initial examination, and were then evacuated to medical facilities in DaNang for hospitalization and treatment.

f. Special Equipment and Techniques. During Operation "TAYLOR COMMON", the Battalion effectively utilized bulldozers in extensive ground clearing operations adjacent to defensive positions on the north and south of the Song Thu Bon River at Liberty Bridge and along the MSR. Numerous attempts had been made to clear the ground using flame throwers and flame tanks, but such attempts were not successful. The use of bulldozers proved to be the solution. An area of approximately 1500-2000 meters was cleared around Phu Lac (6) in three days. Additional ground adjacent to the MSR was cleared as required. Numerous caves, bunkers, and fighting holes were uncovered and destroyed. In addition, an 82mm mortar pit that had been used as a gun site for the 22 February attack on Phu Lac (6) was discovered and destroyed by bulldozers.

15. Commander's Analysis. The enemy continued to employ harrassing tactics throughout the operation, utilizing snipers and conducting probing attacks at night against friendly positions. The enemy significantly increased his efforts in employment of mines and booby traps along the MSR and on the trails and high ground throughout the AO. The employment of large numbers of squad-sized night ambushes, hunter-killer teams, and the extensive use of H&I fires using A-6 Beacons, artillery, and 81mm mortars significantly reduced the enemy's capability to interdict the MSR and to set booby traps in large numbers.

The number of mortar attacks on friendly units increased during Operation "TAYLOR COMMON", reaching its peak during the current "Post-Tet Offensive" when an 82mm mortar attack was launched against the Battalion Fire Base at Phu Lac (6). The effectiveness of such attacks was drastically reduced by the effectiveness of counter-mortar fires by 81's and artillery based at Phu Lac (6).

The enemy did not attempt large scale ground attacks during Operation "TAYLOR COMMON", but on several occasions enemy units in strength of up to 300 were engaged as they attempted to travel through the Battalion AO. In each case, massive casualties were inflicted on the enemy through the employment of aggressive sweep and block maneuvers, ambushes, and the employment of heavy combined supporting arms.

The employment of a variety of offensive tactics stressing mobile, fast-reaction forces of up to three companies at a time, permitted the Battalion to engage the enemy almost at will, and to entrap large numbers attempting to escape. Aggressive pursuit of contact coupled with the liberal use of supporting arms allowed the Battalion continued success in battle against the enemy. The use of night maneuver and pre-dawn attacks on known enemy positions proved very successful on each occasion this tactic was employed.

Extensive, detailed searches of areas adjacent to streams, rivers, and villages proved tremendously productive and resulted in the discovery of massive quantities of milled rice, and ammunition. One cache of rice in excess of 50 tons was discovered during Operation "TAYLOR COMMON".
