PART II  
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Resulting periods of rain hampered the progress of improving the Company defenses in Bravo Sector. Repair and reconstruction of existing positions was necessitated due to the weathering effect of the rain. The Bravo Sector defenses were improved by the addition of concertina wire, in depth, to the front of the sector lines.

A reassignment of the internal security posts was effected during the month. The security consists entirely of walking posts, rather than fixed positions. The reassignment of the guard was necessitated as a result of decreases in personnel strength of the company and assistance rendered by personnel of Company "B", 1st Engineer Battalion.

The replacement of 10 urinoils in the Company area and the addition of an enclosed head on Bravo Sector lines improved the units sanitation facilities and offers increased convenience.

On 23 May 70, one 120mm rocket exploded, harmlessly, to the rear of Bravo Sector lines. Three more landed approximately 500 meters to the right front of the sector. The incident materially aided in illustrating the reason why helmets and flak jackets are of value while standing guard on Bravo Sector.
