PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The transfer of Marines completing their RVN tour and the reduction of the number of personnel in Headquarters Company required a reorganization of the defensive and internal security measures. The relative inactivity of enemy forces in the An Hoa area allowed for a reduction in the number of personnel to man the Bravo Sector, An Hoa defense perimeter. Realignment of posts and boundaries of the Internal Security Force allowed for a reduction of the personnel required for internal security. The aforementioned was accomplished with out lessening the defensive, security or safety of the internal security or sector defenses.

A reduction in the number of Headquarters Company personnel and that projected for future months has and shall assist in lessing the administrative load and allow for an enhanced administrative status of the unit.

The duties of the Security Platoon are now directed towards defense and security of the Headquarters Company area. The myriad of concomitant duties of the platoon have been drastically reduced through a more effective manner of utilization of personnel.

An influx of indigenous military forces has presented no additional problems. The indigenous military units contain well disciplined personnel and, through mutual understanding and respect remain within a proximity of their assigned areas.
