

PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The Battalion's Officer shortages are one WO 0130, one Capt 0202, two Capt's and two Lt's 0302, one Capt 0402, one Lt 6707 and one Lt 6708. The Battalion's enlisted shortages are five GySgt's 0369, five SSgt's 0369 and 71 Sgt's. The Battalion has 94% of its M/L strength in Lt's 03, 70% of its M/L strength in SNCO's 03 and 25% of its M/L strength in Sgt's 03.

2. The 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines continues to participate in Operation TAYLOR COMMON which commenced 7 December 1968. One company returned to An Hoa Combat Base on 18 February and a second on 19 February for rehabilitation and to assist in the security of the base. Two companies remained in Base Area 112. One company each provides security to artillery units located on the two operating Fire Support Bases. In addition one platoon is tasked with the security of a Radio Relay Station in the area. On 23 February one company participated in operations in the Goa Noi Island area as part of a blocking force. The Operation terminated on 24 February with the company returning to An Hoa Combat Base. During 27 and 28 February the two companies at An Hoa returned to Base Area 112 to conduct search and destroy operations in the vicinity of the two Fire Support Bases.

PART III
SEQUENTIAL LISTINGS OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

A. Topics

1. Personnel and Administration

a. Strength. The Battalion began the month of February with an on board strength of 32 Marine Officers, 1,057 Marine Enlisted, 3 Navy Officers and 56 Navy Enlisted. The current on board strength of the Battalion is 36 Marine Officers, 1129 Marine Enlisted, 3 Navy Officers and 56 Navy Enlisted.

b. Discipline, Law and Legal. During the reporting period of February, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines had three Summary Courts Martial and three Special Courts Martial. There are five General Courts Martial, three Special Courts Martial and one Summary Court Martial pending.

c. Morale. Morale and fighting spirit continued to be excellent. Personnel who captured POW's received incountry R&R.

d. Postal. Postal service continued at the same degree of excellence.

e. Awards. There were nine Purple Hearts awarded by the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines to men who sustained wounds during enemy contact during the reporting period of February.

f. Interior Management. Administration procedures and proficiency continued to be excellent.

2. Enemy, Weather and Terrain

a. Enemy. During the reporting period, enemy activity consisted of small scale attacks against friendly units, harassment of friendly units by the use of mortars and rockets, continued use of mines and booby traps and recruitment and indoctrination of local populace.

c. Terrain. During the reporting period, steep mountainous terrain was prevalent, with the area covered by a light to medium canopy.

3. Plans

a. Mission. Continue to provide security for Fire Support Bases Tomahawk, Maxwell and Combat Outpost Dagger and continue search and clear operations to find, fix and destroy enemy fortifications and logistic command installations in Base Area 112 in accordance with annex C (concept of operations) to reference (a) Commanding General, Task Force Yankee of Frag Order 14-69.

4. Training

a. Regimental Indoctrination School. During the reporting period of February all new personnel reporting to the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines attended Indoctrination School held by the 5th Marine Regiment. Training included lectures, demonstrations and practical application in the six schools held during February.

b. Division Schools. During the reporting period of February personnel from the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines attended the following schools:

5. Logistics

a. General. The overall logistic status of the Battalion is satisfactory. Battalion S-4 resupplied the Battalion in the field on a daily basis.

6. Civil Affairs/Civic Action

a. During the reporting period of February the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines S-5 Civic Action Team constructed a refugee camp outside An Hoa. The camp consisted of several tents and housed approximately 650 people. Medical aid was given to the people with the help of 3/5 BAS. Films were shown at the camp on irrigation of crops and sanitation methods. Due to the recent attacks on An Hoa the camp was badly damaged and abandoned by the people. At present the Civic Action Team is preparing for the construction of another camp when they receive authority from Regimental S-5.

12. Communications

a. The primary means of communications was the AN/PRC-25 FM radio. The terrain and distances required to communicate across required extensive use of the RC-292 and log periodic antennas.

b. The AN/PRC-77/KY-38 was used during the entire operation and it is noted that the cipher equipment did not always have the ability to transmit through heavy cloud cover-

ings even though the PRC-77 alone would come in loud and clear.

c. AN/PRC-93 and the AN/PRC-41 were used occasionally for UHF ground to air communications while running fixed wing air strikes.

d. At no time was the Battalion without channels of communications to any of its stations for any great length of time.

13. Supporting Arms

a. Air. During the reporting period of February the First Marine Air Wing provided air support for the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines as follows:

1. Helicopters flew 73 Medivac missions to evacuate 28 emergency, 38 priority and 41 routine casualties.

2. Helicopter support was used in four troop lifts. The first two took place on the 15th, the third on the 27th and the fourth on the 28th. Helicopter support was also used in seven Huey gunship strikes.

3. 62 aerial observation missions were flown during the reporting period.

4. Fixed wing air support was used in 46 tactical air strikes which were all TACA controlled. There were also 107 TPQ 10 controlled air strikes.

5. Fixed wing air support was also utilized through the use of three Flareships and two Spooky Gunships.

b. Artillery.

1. During the interval February 1 to February 28 of Operation TAYLOR COMMON, the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines derived artillery support from the 12th and the 11th Marines. From February 1-18 (operationally) 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines received general support from the following units of the 12th Marines: 'A' Battery 1/12 (LZ Tomahawk), 'C' Battery 1/12 (LZ Maxwell), 155's Headquarters Battery 1/12. The 11th Marine units included 'F' Battery 2/11 (LZ Bolo) and 'D' Battery 2/11 (LZ Saber)

2. From 1-18 February only light enemy contact was recorded. The total number of Firing Missions was 25. There were 17 observed and eight unobserved. During the period 81mm mortars fired over 1,000 rounds. Artillery fired 1,500 rounds during this period.

3. Beginning February 18-28 TPQ-10's and Fire Missions increased. The 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines took over complete artillery support for the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines (Feb 18) with 155 Battery Lima Yankee 4/11 being OPCON 'F' Battery 2/11. At this time direct support became effective. During this time there were 74 firing missions. 56 were observed and 16 unobserved and 28 contact.

4. Total rounds fired for the month were 600 rounds for H&I's and 4000 rounds for Firing Missions.

14. Supporting Units

a. Engineers. Excellent support was provided by Company B, 1st Engineer Battalion. They were employed primarily in the construction of Fire Support Bases and Landing Zones. They also were used to destroy enemy bunkers, booby traps and dud ammunition.

b. Shore Party (HST). HST's were provided by Company B, 1st Shore Party Battalion.

c. Scout Snipers. Detachment Scout Sniper Platoon, Headquarters Company, 5th Marines provided sniper fire for the Battalion.

d. Kit Carson Scouts. The Battalion is presently employing four Kit Carson Scouts. They have been attached to the four rifle companies of the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines.

e. Interpreters. The Battalion is presently employing four ARVN Interpreters. Continuing efforts are being made to obtain two additional interpreters in order that each rifle company, the Alpha Command and the S-5, have at least one qualified ARVN Interpreter.

f. Dog Teams. Dog Teams were attached to India Company and Mike Company on the 27th of February.
