

#### PART II NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines took part on the defense of An Hoa from 15 June 1969 until 20 July 1969. During the period the Companies rotated through the following: 72 hours of in-Country R&R at "Stack Arms" Danang, Regimental Training Course (Kilo and India), Liberty Road Security and Road Sweep, and the Golf Defense Sector. The Companies provided working parties for the rehabilitation of Delta Sector. From 20 July to 31 July 1969 the 3rd Battal ion, 5th Marines, under the operational control of 5th Marines, participated in Operation DURHAM PEAK. This consisted of search and destroy operations in the Que Son Mountains.



PART III SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

#### l. Topics

#### A. Personnel and Administration

- l. Strength. The Battalion began the month with an average strength of 39 Marine Officers, 1,141 Marine Enlisted, 3 Navy Officers and 48 Navy Enlisted. The current on board strength of the Battalian is 33 Marine Officer, 1,136, 3 Navy Officers and 55 Navy Enlisted.
- 2. Morale and fighting spirit continues to be excellent.
- 3. <u>Postal</u>. Postal service continued at the same degree of excellence.
- 4. <u>Disipline</u>. Law and Legal. During the reporting period of July, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines held 5 Special Courts Martials.
- 5. Awards. There were seven Bronze Star Medals, 1 Silver Star Medal, nine Navy Commendation Medals, 1 Navy Achievement Medal, five Vietnamese Crosses of Gallantry, and 100 Purple Heart Medals awarded to the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines during the month of July 1969.
- 5. Interior Management. Administration procedures and proficiency continued to be excellent.

#### B. Logistics.

1. General. The overall logistic status of the Battalion is satisfactory at the present time. The Battalion S-4 has resupplied the Battalion in the field on a daily basis.

#### C. Training.

1. Regimental Indoctrination School. During the reporting period all new personnel reporting to the 3rd Battalion, 5th Exines attended Troop Indoctrination School held by the 5th Marine Regiment for a five day period.

l. Enemy. During the reporting period, enemy activity consisted of small scale attacks against friendly units, harassment of friendly units by the use of mortars, continued use of mines and booby traps, and recruitment and indoctrination of the local people.

6. Dog Teams. The Eattalion started the month of July with 4 Dog Teams. One was killed while on a patrol.

7. Others. Ther was one Regional Force Vietnamese who was held captive by the NVA for 1 year. He was used by 3/5 because of his knowledge of the mountainous area.

#### L. Civil Affairs

1. Med Caps. There were 482 people treated during the reporting period. 20 people received dental care.

2. Contributions. 4,520 pounds of wood was distributed to the Villagers for building purposes.

3. Solatium Payments. \$251.26 was paid to the people of My San Hamlet, Muyen Phu Village, Duc Duc District of Quang Nam Province.

#### M. Communications.

1. The Communications Platoon supported the Battalion with primary use of HM Radio Communication (AN/PRC-25, AN/PRC-88 AN/PRC-77, and KY-36) AN/PRC-41 and AN/PRC-93's were also used.

#### M. Supporting Arms

l. Air. During the reporting period the 1st MAW provided air support for the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines as follows:

a. Helicopters flew 25 Medivac missions to evacuate flergency, 30 Priority, and 11 Routine Casualties.

b. Helicopter support was used in one troop lift on 20 July 1969.

c. Fixed wing support was used in 25 tactical air strikes. Three were Ground controlled and 22 were TACA controlled.
