PART II <u>Warrative</u> summary

During the month of September, the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines conducted offensive operations in the I Corps Tactical Zone (ICTZ), specifically from 1 September to 13 September conducting search and clear operations in the Southern Arizona Area. The Battalion accounted for 31 NVA/VC killed and various amounts of captured munitions and supplies. The Battalion received an inordinate amount of enemy fire to include small arms, mortars (60, 82, and 120mm), and rocket fire (B-10 and 120mm). Most of the enemy kills were inflicted while in a night defensive position. One head-on clash between India Co. and the enemy on 11 September resulted in 12 NVA KIA and 16 weapons captured. Also, on 11 September 1967, the Battalion S-3, Major M. J. DAHLOUTST, tripped a booky true resulting in the loss of his right leg. From I September through 6 September the Eattalion conducted independent search and clear operations. On 6 September 3/5 established a blocking position in the Central Arizona in cooperation and coordination with the ARVM Rangers. On 11 September the Battalion moved to the Southeastern Aricona, near the Song Thu Bong River and set up another blocking position. In conjunction with this. the 39th and 21st Eattellions of the ARVM Rangers moved on 11 September from the Northern Arizona to the Southern Arizona to conduct a sweep operation. During the first

half of the month one company from 3/5 had the mission of An Hoa Base Defense. On 13 September 3/5 was relieved by 1/5 with Kilo Co. OpCon to 1/5 for a 24 hour period. Mike Co., Battalion CP, and H&S Co. were helclifted to Phu Lac (6) where assumption of responsibility for the security of Liberty Bridge and Liberty Road was effected. Lima Co. departed An Hoa and set up in the Phu Nhuans for road security. On 14 September Kilo Co. was helclifted from the Arizona to An Hoa and returned OpCon to 3/5. On 15 September Kilo Co. was trucked overland to Phu Lac (6). From 12 September until 30 September 3/5 remained at Liberty Bridge with one Company as the Regimental Reserve.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Topics

- A. Strength. The Battalion began the month with a total strength of 33 Marine Off, 1.041 Enl, 3 USN Off, and 53 USN Enl. 3/5 now has a total on board strength of 33 Marine Off, 1,136 Enl, 3 USN Off, and 53 USN Enl.
- B. Moral and fighting spirit continued to be exection.
- G. Postal Service continued at the same degree of excellence.
- D. <u>Discipling</u>. During the reporting period, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines held I General Court Martial and I Special Court Martial.
- E. Awards. There was I Silver Star Medal, 6 Bronze Star Medals, 7 Navy Commendation Medals, 9 Navy Achievement Medals, and Jah Purple Heart Medals awarded to the Battalion during the wouth of September.
- F. Internal Management: Adminstrative procedures and profictioney months described for the article A Coming to the English on 21-23 September and the Enttalion was reported to be satisfactory with minor discrepancies. Attention to the ungatisfactory areas is being given with improving results.





G. Logistics. The overall status of the Battalion is satisfactory at the present time. The S-4 resupplied the Battalion in the field on a daily basis, and tracked vehicles resupplied the units operating in the Phu Nhuans on a day to day basis.

H. Training,

- 1. Regimental Indoctrination School. During the month all new personnel reporting to 3/5 attended Troop Indoctrination School held by the 5th Marine Regiment for a five day period.
- 2. Division Schools. Personnel attended the following schools during September.

NGO Leadership School--7 Officer Leadership School--2 Staff NGO Leadership School--3 Land Wine Warfare School--56 Cable Splicing School--1 I Corps Generator School--4 HST School--2 Embarkation School--1

I. Operations.

- 1. There were no named operations during the reporting period. However, the Battalien conducted search and clear operations in the Southern Arizona from 1 September through 13 September.
- 2. On 13 September 3/5 assumed responsibility for security of Liberty Bridge and Liberty Road. One Company (Ries) conducted outposts and ambushes along Liberty Road during the day and aight. In addition to normal counter booky-trap measures from 15 September through 30 September 3/5 conducted extensive operations to eliminate casualties from Surprise Firles Devloss (SFD's). These consisted of extensive use of LYES-1's with line charges. This, coupled with application of SFD counter measures, resulted in the discovery and destruction of ever 50 SFD's this month.
- 3. From 27 through 29 September the Battalion was involved in election security operations in which screening activities of local indigenous personnel were conducted north of Am Boa.
- u. On 29 through 30 September the Battalion conducted rice deal and rice destruction within the A.O. resulting in over 27,000 square maters of rice destroyed.

l. Enemy. During the reporting period, enemy activity consisted of small scale attacks against friendly units, harassment of friendly units by the use of rockets and mortars, continued use of SFD's, and recruitment and indoctrination of the local populace.


