2. LOCATION. During the month of March, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines operated with a split CP. The rear CP and Company M (OPCON 5th Marines) are located at An Hoa Combat Base (AT 875475). The forward CP and Company L CP remained at Hill 65 (AT 880580), while Company K with its CP at Hill 52 (ZC 216552) conducted combat operations from the operational bases located at Hill 52 and Hill 25 (AT 839568). Company M CUPP Company (3rd Battalion, 1st Marines), was passed OPCON/ADCON to 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines on 6 March 1970 with CP remaining at Hill 55 (AT 964603). The 5th Marines CUPP Platoon CP remained at Hill 25 (AT 839568).

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of March 1970 the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines, conducted numerous securing/pacification as well as combat operations within an expanded TAOR in Quang Nam Province, I Comps Electical Zone. Phase III redeployment dictated a realignment of forces throughout the Division TAOR. As a result of this adjustment the 3rd Battalion was assigned responsibility for a TAOR that stretched from the western edge of Dia Loc District 27000 meters to the east into Dien Ban District (east of National Route #1). The TAOR is 11000 meters at its widest point. It is significant that the Battalion AO was designated as a combined AO to be mutually shared with the 51st ARVN Regiment. The 51st ARVN established their GP at Hill 55 (AF970621) with 3rd Battalion, 51st ARVN occupying Hill 37 (AT916582). Elements of these units conducted unilateral and combined operations with forces of the 5th Marines.

lst Marines Combined Unit Pacification Program Company, Company M, lay within the confines of the expanded TACR. On 6 March 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines assumed command of Company M, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines. The CUPP Company combined pacification operations within their assigned AO's in the vicinity of Hill 37 (Dia Loc District) and Hill 55 (Dien Ban District) in support of the Province 1970 Pacification and Development plan.

In addition to being tasked with conducting combined operations with GVN forces, the Battalion performed security missions for engineer mine sweeps along Route #540 north to the 5th Marines boundary and south to 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines TAOR. The Battalion was relieved of the responsibility for relief/reinforcement of the Thuong Duc and Nong Son CIDG Camps.

Enemy movement was continuously interdicted by extensive combat patrolling and ambushes. Emphasis was placed on screening the periphery of secure or pacified areas within the TAOR. Increased attention was placed on patrolling and ambushing along Route #540 in order to negate the enemy attempts to interdict the MSR from the combat service support activities in the An Hoa Combat Base.

Considerable coordination was effected with GVN forces during the month so that combined operations could be initiated. Combined operations were conducted; however, district and ARVN forces concentrated on preparing defenses in anticipation of the enemys Winter Spring Offensive.

Combined Unit Pacification Program (CUPP) units, Mike CUPP Company and 5th Marines CUPP Platoon, enjoyed a high degree of success during the period by accounting for a large number of the Battalion kills during the period. Efforts at disrupting the pacification program by discrediting GVN attempts to secure the populace were obviously increasing.



Rice protection operations performed not only by Dai Loc District were closely monitored with the Battalion alert to provide assistance if called upon by the District Chief. These operations are 100% complete and incident free.



PART III

SECURITIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. TOPICS.

a. Personnel and Administration

- (1) Strength. The Eattalian began the month with a total strength of 37 Marine Officers, 1090 Marine Enlisted, 2 Navy Officers and 57 Navy Enlisted. 3rd Battalian; 5th Marines now has a total an board strength of 50 Marine Officers, 1445 Marine Enlisted. The primary reason for the increase in strength was the redistribution of personnel due to Phase III Redeployment and the addition of the CUPP Company from the 1st Marines.
- (2) Morale and fighting spirit continued to be excellent, even with a lack of Battalion size and larger operations.
- (3) Postal. Postal service was hampered due to the mail strike in CONUS. However, the overall service during the month was excellent, especially considering the widely nature of company units within the Battalion TAOR.
- (4) <u>Discipline</u>. During the month there were three (3) special and two (2) summary court martials held.
- (5) Awards. There was one (1) Bronze Star, three (3) Navy Commendation Medals, and six (6) Purple Heart Medals awarded to the Battalion during the reporting period.
- (6) <u>Internal Management</u>. Administration procedures and proficiency continued to be excellent.

b. Enemy, Weather, and Terrain

(1) Enemy

- (a) During the reporting period, enemy activity increased by comparison with the preceding month. Enemy activity was initially directed at satisfying his logistical needs. Significant enemy activities throughout the TAOR occurring toward the end of the month indicated the enemy was successful, to a degree, in obtaining badly needed food supplies. His efforts during the latter part of the month appeared to be orientated at disrupting GVN pacification efforts.
- (b) There were a total of sixty-six (66) contacts with the enemy during March. Twenty-nine (29) of these contacts were enemy initiated. Most enemy initiated contacts were either harassing or terroristic in nature. These tactics combined with efforts towards discrediting





the pacification program were in keeping with the enemy's expected offensive. Phase III of the enemy's Winter/Spring offensive appeared to have begun on 27 March when several stand off mortar/small arms attacks occurred at approximately 2400H. Marine units involved included the Battalion CP at Hill 65, India Company CP at Hill 37, and a squad position in the M 3/1 AO (AN 969614). In addition to these attacks there was evidence of Province wide activity by the enemy.

- (c) During March there were two (2) reported "lob" bomb incidents, one of which was directed at the Battalion CP, and two (2) enomy initiated fires on flying aircraft, On 29 March 1970, a CUPP squad (AT 969614) reported meceiving two (2) (possible) 122nm rockets. There were no other rocket incidents in the TACR during March.
- (d) Significant enemy contacts during the month included: (1) On 11 March 1970 an India Company unit engaged six (6) NVA/WC at AT9339592. Four (4) enemy were killed and four (4) weapons captured. (2) On the same day H&S CUPP 3/5 unit engaged ten (10) NVA/VC at AT351558. The results were four (4) enemy killed and two (2) weapons captured.
- (e) Significant findings during March included: (1) On 1 March 1970 a Kilo Company unit found a base camp consisting of six (6) caves able to accomodate fifteen (15) persons each at AT832579. In one of the caves a 122mm rocket was found. (2) On 4 March 1970, a Lima Company unit found a freshly dug mortar position with aiming stakes surrounded by eight (8) fighting positions at AT884608. The mortar position was located so that it could fire on the long axis of Hill 65, (3) On 5 March 1970, a Kilo Company unit found two (2) caves at AT829585. Inside the caves were one hundred eighty (180) AX rounds, one (1) ChiCom grenade, and one (1) 106mm round. (4) On 14 March 1970, a Kilo Company unit found a cave located at AT815588. The cave entrance was booby trapped. Inside the cave four (4) weapons were found including a Chinese light machine gun. In addition, thirty six (36) ChiCom grenades were found. (5) On 16 March 1970, a Kilo Company unit found a base camp at AT798573. The base camp consisted of three (3) thatched living shelters.

(2) Weather.

- Terrain. During this reporting period, the predominant terrain feature encountered was flat lowlands and small hills. However, some patrols went into the foothills of Charlie Ridge (AT7958 to AT9164) area which is steep mountainous terrain and heavily vegitated. With the cessation of rains the Song Vu Gia River was at a lower level. INCLASSIFIED



This fact uncovered more crossing sites for the enemy operating from the "Arizona" area. Dried up stream beds provided additional avenues of approach for the enemy to deploy from Charlie Ridge into the lowlands. Increased temperatures will begin to have more of an effect on USMC patrols, particularly those in the foothills of "Charlie Ridge".

c. Operations. Initially, operations were oriented toward interdicting enemy movement into the Da Nang Vital Area via the Thuong Duc Couridor. As the month progressed and the Battalian assumed responsibility for an expanded TAOR, combined operations with GVN forces at platoon and squad level were effected as well as continued category II operations to provide periphery security to the populated areas.





d. Supporting Units/Agencies

- (1) Engineers. 2nd Platoca, Coupany B, 1ct Engineer Bettalian supported 3/5 during the reporting period of March 1970.
- (2) Shore Party. Est support was provided by Company B, 1st Shore Party Battalion.
- (3) Socot Dogs. 3/5 employed 2 Scout Dog Teams during March 1970. In addition, 5 Mine/Booky Trap Dog Teams were employed.
- (4) Reterpreters. Three (3) interpreters were employed during the reporting period.
- (5) Snipers. Nine (9) sniper teams were suplayed during the reporting period.
- (6) Ground Surveillance. Two (2) strings of combination of mini-sids and magna-sids were employed by ground surveillance personnel on likely avenues of approach leading from "Charlie Ridge" into the Throng Puc Corridor. These strings were monitered by ground surveillance personnel in the COC at Hill 65,

e. Supporting Arms

- (1) Air. Air support for 3rd Battalian, 5th Marines was considered excellent during the reporting period. Helicopters (CH-46) flew one hundred seventeen (117) medevac missions, thirty four (34) of which were emergency in nature. Two (2) CH-53's were utilized on 25 March to transport Company "A" from Ah Hoa Combat Base to Hill 52 and Company "F" from Hill 52 to An Hoa Combat Base. There were a total of fourty seven (47) OV-10 supporting flights utilized during the month to control fixed wing and artillary supporting arms. There were a total of 43 beacons and 47 tactical air strikes controlled during the period.
- f. Artillery. Artillery support for the month of Mozech 1970 was provided by 2nd Battalien, 11th Marines. The total number of rounds expended for the month totalled 10,755 rounds fired at 883 targets: 93 observed, 27 unobserved, and 763 harassing or interdictory.

g. Training

- (1) Regimental Indoctrination School. During the month of March 1970 all new personnel reporting to 3/5 attended Troop Indoctrination School, held by 5th Farine Regiment Personnel, for a five (5) day period.

h. Logistics

(1) General. During the month of March 1970 logistics problems in the Battalion increased significantly. This was mainly due to Phase III Redeployment. During Phase III the Battalion AO was almost doubled and an extra company was added to the Battalion. In addition, the Battalion is operating with a split CP which compounds the logistics problems. The rear CP is located at the An Hoa Combat Pase and includes the S-4, supply, and motor transport. The forward CP is located at Hill 65 and has representatives attached from the



above mentioned sections.

(2) Resupply. Resupply of 3/5 is accomplished in the following manner:



Resupply by helicopter depends mainly on weather and availability of helicopters. Once during the month helo resupply was cancelled due to inclement weather. This should pose no problem during the summer months. Resupply by truck requires that roads are swept by engineer/mine sweep beams.

- (3) Phase III Redeployment. As a result of Phase III Redeployment 3/5 received a substantial amount of equipment from units leaving RVN. Included in this equipment were ordnance, committens, and motor transport items.
- (4) Supply. During March, supply has concerned itself with excess and unserviceable equipment in addition to preparing mount-out boxes for embarkation. During the week of 22 March 1970, two (2) 12 ton trailer-loads of unserviceable and excess equipment were turned into FUG Da Nang. During this period, Battalion Supply has shown a marked external improvement.
- (5) Ordnance, Hill 65 recently turned in two (2) truck-leads of excess 81mm, 60mm, and small arms ammunition. In addition, all Grade III ammunition is continually turned in to LSU at An Hoa and directly to ASP2 from Hill 65.
- (6) <u>Motor Transport</u>. During March several vehicles were turned in and received new vehicles from departing units involved in Plass III Redeployment.

During March, a mobile contact team was formed from within the Pattolian to visit the various unit positions, inspect all vehicles, and ensure that proper jet Echelon maintenance was being performed.

The Battalion also received a special allowerses of twelve (12) M151A1s with trailers for the two (2) COPP units operating

within AO. Operationally speaking the S/A will be of great help to the Battalion. However this new addition will strain the maintenance capabilities of the motor transport section.

- (7) Embarkation, Embarkation has been continually stressed during Harch 1970 all mount-out boxes not on hand have been placed on order and all units are updating their manifest roster. Excess and unserviceable equipment are being turned in on a continuing basis.
- (8) Improvements and Construction. The rear area of An Hea has worked on realigning the camp area in that 1st Battalion has moved to SSDC. Two (2) new 16x32 burkers have been built by engineers and will be taken over by Kilo Company rear and S-1 respectively. Two (2) former 1/5 bunkers have been taken over and the Seabees are installing running water into these bunkers in order to facilitate the move of BAS within the Battalion area. At Hill 65 a water point has been established by engineers. This was accomplished by running pipe from the Song Vn Gia River, which is approximately 500 meters from the base of Hill 65, to the water tower on top of Hill 65. In addition, three (3) ammunition bunkers have been rehabilitated and three (3) have been torm down. Fighting positions have been constantly improved with an increased emphasis on wire laying and clearing of fields of fire. A new trash dump has also been established at Hill 65.
- (9) <u>Miscellaneous</u>. A CMA inspection was conducted on 23 March 1970. The unofficial results of the inspection were as follows:

Supply - Satisfactory with major discrepancies.

Motor transport - Satisfactory with discrepancies.

Crdnance - Satisfactory with discrepancies.





i. Commications

- a. Battalion operations were supported primarily by the use of MI radic communications (AN/PRC 25, AN/PRC 77, and KY 38). AN/PRO-41 and AN/PRC 95 equipment were employed by TACP personnel. PRC-88 and various wire communication equipment were employed for base defense of both Hill 65 and Delta Sector of the An Hoa Combat Base.
- b. There were no soute personnel shortages during the month. However, two (2) men (radio operator and wiremen) were transferred to 5th Harines CUMP Platoon. Also one (1) radio operator with an AN/PRO 77 and a MY-33 was attached to the senior advisor Pai Loc District and two (2) operators with an AN/PRO 77, MY 38, AN/PRO 25, and a MS-292 were attached to the senior advisor Dien Ban District for liadson duty between the Battalian and the two districts.
