





### PART II

# NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The Battalion maintained a high level of communications support throughout the I Corps Area during the month of June. By direction of the III Marine Amphibious Force, 7th Communication Battalion relieved the 5th Communication Battalion of all Marine Multi-channel equipment at the Republic of Korea Marine Brigade at Hoi An. With the accomplishment of this task, the Battalion now provides radio, communication center, radio relay and telephone support to the Brigade.

Personnel and equipment shortage caused some degradation to the Battalion's capability to support future operations. Of particular concern was the excessive loss of generator equipment due to parts shortages and general wearing out of equipment. However no commitments currently being supported had to be canceled.

The Communication Company continued attached to Task Force X-RAY providing communications and logistics support to that organization. In addition to the company being at Phu Bai, detachments from the Company were sent to Quang Tri in support of the 1st Marine Air Wing and to Hue in support of the 1st ARVN Division.

The Communication Support Company remained in a heavily committed condition with detachments throughout the I Corps Area. An added commitment was levied on the Company to provide telephone and telephone switching support to the U. S. Advisor Team assigned to the Korean Marine Brigade.

The Radio Relay and Construction Company provided additional multi-channel Radio Relay support to the Korean Marine Brigade and to Task Force X-RAY. The Construction platoon completed laying underground cable from the 7th Marines CP to the 26th Marines CP thereby re-establishing land line communication to the 7th Marines for the first time since the Tet Offensive.

The Battalion continued encountering enemy resistance to both the ground security mission and the Battalion Civic Action program. Two Marines of the Battalion Patrol Force were killed and one wounded in a sharp engagement with Viet Cong trying to cross the Song Cau Do River in the Battalion's AOR. One V. C. was confirmed killed in this engagement. Another Marine was slightly wounded by an enemy grenade during a fire-fight in Yen Bac Hamlet. In order to prevent further enemy infiltration across the Song Cau Do, a land clearing project was begun along the North river bank with scheduled completion in July 1968.

#### Narrative Summary

Radio Relay and Construction Company continued to furnish personnel and equipment for radio relay shots previously established. In addition, the Company deployed one AN/MRC-62 with operators to Phu Bai and two AN/ MRC-62's to replace 5th Comm. Bn. gear at KMB, also had two AN/TRC-27's with operators return from standby at Phu Bai.
