~~SECRET~~NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During November 1968, an increase in requirements levied on the battalion by higher headquarters and an increase in local ground action gave the battalion an opportunity to utilize more fully the assets and personnel of the battalion. Extensive training in general military subjects, specialist training, use of infantry weapons, and upgrading of preventive maintenance was continued. The additional requirements provided the opportunity to determine if our training and preventive maintenance programs were adequate, as they proved to be.

The Communication Company, which returned from a 9 month deployment from the parent headquarters during September, deployed personnel and equipment for Operation Meade River. Personnel of the company continued to provide support to the 1st Marine Division Comm Center. Uncommitted personnel of the company received extensive training and were integrated into the security system of the cantonment. In addition to providing personnel for internal security, 14 men joined the Hill 34 patrol force which gave them additional training and experience.

The Radio Relay and Construction Company maintained existing commitments as well as deploying AN/TRC-27's and AN/MRC-62's with personnel to Operation Meade River. The Construction Platoon experienced an increase in their work schedule in both new construction and the upgrading of the existing cable system. Operation Meade River also required additional cable construction.

The Communication Support Company continued with existing support requirements throughout the I Corps Area and provided additional personnel and equipment for Operation Meade River.

A problem with tactical engine generators is continuing to effect the battalion's capability to deploy additional multi-channel radio equipment. This problem has been alleviated to a degree by the use of camp power whenever possible. No relief to the problem is anticipated in the near future.

4. Significant Problem Areas, Supply

a. Class II. The lead time on requisitions for General Supply items has continued to improve and now is at an acceptable level. The one exception continues to be typewriters which still have not been received. There is a shortage of typewriters in the Battalion and those on hand are generally in poor condition because of the constant use they receive. Supply support for generators continues to be unsatisfactory. Specifically the lack of PE-75's, PU-278's and PU-463's and spare part support has seriously reduced operational use of multichannel radio sets. The long lead time on 100 pair and 50 pair cable and messenger has hampered construction projects. Overall Class II supply support is considered to be satisfactory at present.

b. Class IV. At present there are no significant problems in this area.

3. Maintenance Situation

a. Generators continue to present the largest maintenance time. There are 33 generators deadlined, 23 of which have been evacuated to 1st FSR for maintenance. Work orders on deadlined generators date from December 1967. To better accomplish organizational maintenance, one man has been sent TAD to 1st FSR for On-The-Job training to gain experience. The high deadline rate coupled with shortages resulting from generators being coded, Code H, seriously impairs the radio relay capability of the Battalion.

b. Third Echelon Motor Transport and Electronic support continues to be excellent. Long turnaround time for Direct Exchange items, regulators and water pumps for all M-series vehicles and carburetors for the M-151A1, AN/MRC-109/110 and M-37, has caused the second echelon deadline to increase.

A primary cause of the high NORS deadline is due to the shortage of (5) AN/TRC-75's destroyed by enemy action in May 1968. Three AN/MRC-83's are deadlined at 3d FSR awaiting engines.

7. Significant Problem Areas (Maintenance)

a. Maintenance of small engine generators as mentioned in paragraph 5.a. is the most significant problem areas. The PE-75, 60Hz 2.5KW, is a continuing trouble primarily due to the age of the equipment. Seven of eight generators used with the AN/TRC-97 are deadlined.

b. Difficulty has been experienced in obtaining repair parts for the AN/PCC-1, AN/VCC-1 and VCC-2. AN/VCC-2's were received with the wrong type filter units. The correct filters have been requested from the manufacturer. Although no known factory support agreement is available, the manufacturer through its technical representatives has, in the past, supplied the parts requested. Recently, however, the requests have gone unanswered. A partial FSN listing has been obtained but no parts have been received through the Marine Corps Supply System.

c. The AN/TRC-97E were received without the necessary technical manuals. Proper maintenance cannot be accomplished without the manuals. Necessary maintenance publications will be ordered.


