MAINTENANCE SITUATION AND SIGNIFICANT PROBLEM AREA REPORT

MAINTENANCE PROBLEMS: The overall maintenance situation continues to be good with the exception of small engine generators used to furnish power for the radio relay equipment.

Third echelon maintenance support of electronic equipment and motor transport continues to be excellent.

SIGNIFICANT PROBLEM AREAS: The shortage of small generators due to the lack of third echelon maintenance support is a continuing major problem area. Presently we have 26 generators at FSR. The majority of PE-75's evacuated to FSR are often replaced by Code H letters and presently we have 26 of these generators on order.

Difficulty continues in the obtaining of maintenance publications for AN/TRC-97E, PU-670 and AN/PCO-1.

Another major problem is the lack of AN/TRC-97 series repair parts.

AN/GCC-3

The deadline rate of this item is 33%. Three are on deadline for mechanical adjustments and two are awaiting minor parts which are on order. This item is not critical at this time as we have 7 operational and uncommitted.

AN/MC-62

The deadline rate of this item is 25%. Four are deadline awaiting parts for the modem. Six units have had TA-102's but these are temporarily replaced by separate T. E. 102's so this actually does not affect the unit.

AN/MC-63

The deadline rate of this item is 16%. The one set that is deadline is missing (3) transmitters T-235. These sets are on order but no status has been received. There are five other sets available and uncommitted at this time.

AN/MC-65

The deadline rate of this item is 32%. Four sets are awaiting parts which are on order on Bu Doc # 8142-4441. Two sets have had power supplies, one does not tune properly, one loads continually and one transmits garbled. This is not a critical item due to the large number we have operational and uncommitted.

AN/MC-27

There are a total of 12 AN/MC-27's of which 9 are on deadline. One has a PU-101 on order and the other 8 are awaiting the PU-270's to be repaired. Twelve of the generators are at 1st ESC. This is a critical item as we have the 3 remaining committed.

Narrative Summary

Radio Relay and Construction Company continued to provide radio relay support throughout the III MAF TAOR, and continued to install, maintain and repair the telephone cable system within the 1st Marine Division TAOR and adjacent areas. Work and maintenance throughout the company progressed at a satisfactory rate, due in large part to an improved and stabilized personnel situation. The company completed 1st MarDiv CEO Work Orders 38-68, 53-68, and 11-69; and 7th CommBn Work Orders 27-69 and 29-69.

Personnel and equipment remained deployed in support of 2nd ROK Marine Brigade (Hoi An), Task Force Hotel (Vandergrift Combat Base), and contingency communications systems (Hill 34, Hill 244, and Da Nang). Additional personnel and equipment were deployed in support of Task Force Hotel (Vandergrift Combat Base) and 3rd MarDiv (Dong Ha). Personnel and equipment returned from An Hoa and Hill 244, following the completion of Operation TAYLOR COMMON. Radio relay operation continued to be hampered by a shortage of operational generators and AN/TBC-3 terminals, and a high electronic failure rate in AN/TRC-97E multichannel radio sets. A UER is being written on the AN/TRC-97E; another UER on the related PU-670 generator's design deficiencies has been written and is presently being staffed.

Cable construction and maintenance activities proceeded at a satisfactory rate. The lack of a flasher; however, has delayed completion of one work order and several maintenance tasks. Six separate incidents of cable damage occurred during the month; these required emergency repairs and delayed normal construction/maintenance work significantly. Four of these incidents would have been avoided if the cable involved had been buried; a study recommending burial of much of the 1st MarDiv outside plant was submitted during the month. One construction crew was deployed for a week in support of Operation DUFFEL BAG. A minefield re-discovered during the month north of ASP-1 precludes working on a segment of the B-2 cable until the area beneath the cable has been swept clear. Finally, the buried replacement cable for the B-6 cable had to be abandoned when it was discovered during the month that an RMK-BRJ watermain project was to be installed along the route of this cable; efforts to retrieve the cable were unsuccessful, and another replacement cable is being buried adjacent to the watermain.
