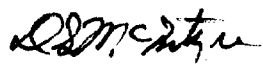

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PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of May 1st Lt. W. A. AUSTIN was transferred to 1st M. P. Bn. 2nd Lt. J. A. ALERIGHT joined the company the 26th of May and assumed the duties of Wire Plt Commander.

During the month of May nineteen commitments were maintained, four were initiated and one was terminated. The existing commitments of the company are as follows: (1) A 23 man detachment at the 2nd ROK Marine Brigade in Hoi An, providing multi-channel radio and telephone service for U. S. liason personnel; (2) A 2 man team operating a MRC-62 at 2nd CAG in Hoi An; (3) A 2 man team operating a PCC-1 at the MACV compound in Hoi An; (4) Components of one MRC-62 are being supplied for support of Comm. Nav. For. Vietnam at Longs Xuyen; (5) One C-7827 and TH-81 are being supplied for Comm. Nav. For. Vietnam operations in the Mekong Delta; (6) One man and two TRC-27's on Hill 327 are supporting 11th Marines; (7) Seven men and one SB-22/PT at 1st M. P. Bn. are augmenting the organic communication personnel; (8) One TT-187 C/UG, one MRC-109 and one PRC-25 supplied to III MAF; (9) One AS-2236 and one PRC-25 supplied to III MAF FMO; (10) One man, four RC-292's and one AN/GRC-125 supporting CAF; (11) Radio Plt. is maintaining one PRC-47 and one PP-3240 at 95th Evac. hospital; (12) One AN/GIC-1 on loan to 1st CAP; (13) One TA-312 supplied to NSA hospital; (14) Two TA-312's supplied to 80th Spt. Group; (15) Five TA-312's supplied to East Danang Orphanage; (16) Two TA-312's supplied to the Danang Hospital; (17) One MRC-109 (Minus radio) on loan to 1st Force Recon Co; (18) Wire Plt. is maintaining one SB-86/PT at MAG-16 for the Zulu Ground Defense Wire System; (19) Wire Plt is maintaining and operating the 5th Comm. Bn. switchboard and alert speaker system.

The following commitments were initiated during the month of May: (1) Temp loan through supply (Bn) two AN/TCC-3's to 2nd ROK Brigade; (2) Temp loan through Bn Supply one AM-682 to 2nd ROK Brigade; (3) Turned into Bn Supply two PP-3240 battery chargers for issue to CAF; (4) Temp loan to Comm Co one air conditioner for use at III MAF COC (Terminated 24 May 1970).
