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PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

Company "A" (Rein), 7th Engineer Battalion, continued support of the III Marine Amphibious Force within the Danang area. The Company continued maintenance responsibility of 32.3 miles of road and conducted daily mine sweeps of 24.6 miles of road. The company maintained anywhere from five (5) down to three (3) water points in the Danang area producing 1,950,000 gallons of water.

(2) Operations: 1-15 August 1970

(a) Horizontal Construction - During the first 15 days of August, the company hauled 2,555 cubic yards of earth products. A total of 2,044 cubic yards of asphalt were delivered to MCB 62 on route QL-1S. CBR in the amount of 511 cubic yards was hauled from Camp Love to Company "A" heavy equipment lot. Company "A" assumed the responsibility of completing the Area 4 (Barrier Island) land clearing and cleared 1,060 acres toward this goal. The company had an average of six (6) tractors working on this project.

(b) Vertical Construction - During this period Company "A" completed construction of its new CP in the Maintenance Battalion area of FLC. In addition, a dispatcher's office was constructed. Engineer assistance to 3/5 on Hill 37 was begun with the rehabilitation of the OOC bunker and the construction of a 20' by 32' FDC bunker. The electrical system in 3/5's cantonment is also being upgraded. Work began again on the five (5) CH 54 revetments for the 478th Aviation Company at the Viking Compound. A 30' observation tower is being constructed at the Northern Artillery Cantonment. Finally, a 20' water tower with tanks is being constructed for the 2nd ROK Marine Brigade.

(c) Engineer Comments

(1) 7 August 1970 - The Company "A" (Rein) CP was completed in the Maintenance Battalion, FLC, area.

(2) 8 August 1970 - A 60' by 100' LZ for 3/5 on Hill 37 was completed.

(3) 12 August 1970 - The repair of the telephone test facility for 5th Communications Battalion was completed.

(4) 14 August 1970 - Six SEA huts on Hill 10 have been completed.

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(3) Operations: 16-31 August 1970

(a) Horizontal Construction - During the last 16 days of August, 3,781 cubic yards of earth products were hauled by the company. A total of 1,949 cubic yards of asphalt were hauled for MCB 62 on route QL-15, and 871 cubic yards of CBR were delivered to MCB 62's stockpile on Hill 55. CBR in the amount of 756 cubic yards was delivered to Camp Perdue for the road upgrade project. The ASP at LZ Baldy received 170 cubic yards of CBR, and Camp Love received 35 cubic yards of CBR. FLC trucks hauled 490 cubic yards of CBR to the S-Lot at Camp Books for our drainage improvement project. The Vietnamese rock contract delivered 1,228 cubic yards of CBR to the Hill 37 stockpile. The Area 4 land clearing had 575 acres cleared. The roads in the Camp Perdue compound are being upgraded and the drainage improved. The "S" Lot at Camp Books is receiving improved drainage and the low spots are being filled with rock.

(b) Vertical Construction - Work continued on the CH54 revetments at the Viking Compound and the 20' water tower with tanks for the 2nd Marine ROK Brigade in Dien Ban. Ten (10) SEA huts are being rehabilitated for 3/5 on Hill 37.

(c) Engineer Comments

(1) 18 August 1970 - One (1) 30' observation tower completed at the Northern Artillery Cantonment.

(2) 19 August 1970 - The 20' by 32' FDC bunker for 3/5 on Hill 37 is completed.

(3) 24 August 1970 - The Area 4 (Barrier Island) land clearing is completed, have cleared a total of 3375 acres.

(4) 28 August 1970 - A 60' by 50' extension on the LZ on Hill 37 for 3/5 has been completed.

(5) 29 August 1970 - The road between the east and west villes on Go Noi Island has been upgraded and land cleared on either side of the road.

(6) 29 August 1970 - The upgrade of the electrical system on Hill 37 for 3/5 has been completed.

(7) 31 August 1970 - The rehabilitation of ten (10) SEA huts for 3/5 on Hill 37 has been accomplished.

f. Logistics, Equipment and Supply

(1) Administration

(a) 27 August 1970 - Placed one (1) M151 in maintenance float.

(b) Company Supply processed 133 requisitions of which 35 were completed. A total of 12 items were submitted for direct exchange. Of these 12 items, 9 were exchanged and 3 were placed on a back order.

(2) Motor Transport: A total of 83,347 miles were logged by the Company Motor Transport vehicles. There were 10,062 tons of earth products, 2,893 tons of general cargo, and 5,398 passengers transported during this period.

(3) Maintenance

(a) The Company Maintenance Platoon received 171 work orders, of which 132 were completed. The 39 work orders open at this time are awaiting parts. None of the work orders awaiting parts have caused our vehicles to be combat deadlined.

(b) Problem Areas: The lack of speed in the supply system has delayed the Maintenance Platoon in putting its vehicles in top mechanical shape. Items such as tires, tubes, and batteries, require a very long lead time. These items have a very high usage factor in this company.
