NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During this reporting period, 7th Motor Transport Battalion remained under the operational and administrative control of Force Logistic Command, DaNang, RVN. Company "C" remained in the Phu Bai TAOR in support of Force Logistic Support Group Alpha.
2. The Operational Summary shown herein includes all elements of the 7th Motor Transport Battalion during the reporting period.

In the DaNang TAOR:

- a. Number of Trips - 2,701
- b. Miles Travelled - 112,869
- c. Personnel Transported - 10,208
- d. Cargo Transported - 24,972 S/T

In the Phu Bai TAOR:

- a. Miles Travelled - 25,760
- b. Personnel Transported - 2,729
- c. Cargo Transported - 5,166 S/T


