NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During this reporting period, 7th Motor Transport Battalion remained under the operational and administrative control of Force Logistic Command, DaNang. During this period Company "B", Company "C" (-) and Transport Company were used in support of the following operations: Mameluke Thrust, Owen Mesa and Commanchee Falls. Company "A" and a detachment of Company "C" remained in the Dong Ha TAOR in support of Force Logistic Support Group Bravo. Company "A" and a detachment of Company "C" both were used in support of the following operations: Napoleon/ Saline, Kentucky, Lancaster II and Scotland II.
2. The Operational Summary shown herein includes all elements of the 7th Motor Transport Battalion during the reporting period.

In the DaNang TAOR:

- a. Miles Traveled - 34,175
- b. Personnel Transported - 6,153
- c. Cargo Transported - 12,133 S/T

In the Dong Ha TAOR:

- a. Miles Traveled - 65,154
- b. Personnel Transported - 2,775
- c. Cargo Transported - 16,171

In addition to these TAOR runs, the Battalion conducted Rough Rider Operations between DaNang and An Hoa, Dong Ha and Vandegrift Combat Base. Summary:
