

- a. The beach unloading station at Cua Viet was used to refuel a ship rather than the normal procedure of the ship filling the beach unloading. The ship was the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers ocean going dredge, the 'Hyde'. The 'Hyde' took approximately 9,000 gallons on two occasions.
- b. A storage and dispensing station was established to support the Tam Ky area.

- a. The undersea line at Cua Viet was inoperative for a period of 4 days due to the flexable connecting line being torn off by an improperly anchored ship.
