

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of May normal receiving, pumping, dispensing and shuttling operations were carried out. A new dispensing point was established at hill 55 in the Da Nang TAOR. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd Platoons were dropped from the 7th Separate Bulk Fuel Co. The first Platoon was transferred to FLSG-Bravo and the 2nd and 3rd Platoons were transferred to FLSG-Alpha.
