1. During the month of December normal receiving, pumping, dispensing and storage operations were maintained within the Danang TAOR. The aviation fuel storage capability of the company at the Marble Mountain Air Facility, Danang, RVN, was replaced by permanent fuel storage tanks operated by the Navy. The beach unloading station (Red Beach #1, Danang, RVN) was turned over to the operational control of the Navy.
