NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of July, normal receiving, pumping, dispensing and storage operations were maintained within the Danang TAOR. A fuel dispensing site was closed at MAG 16 and a new one opened at An Hoa. The site at An Hoa is being supplied by use of 500 gallon collapsible drums. During the month, the company incurred combat losses totaling \$28,926.14 due to artillery and mortar attacks.
