NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The company continued support of United States Marine and Korean Marine units in the Danang TAOR with POL products. There has been no significant changes in usage during the month. The company remained in a reduced readiness category due to supplies and equipment not on hand as a result of combat losses and losses from the Ammunition Supply Point One explosion. Response from the supply system is slow in spite of priority 62 requisitions and Mares GA cards. The company is capable of maintaining current commitments, but is unable to handle any significant increase in fuel handling commitments.
