PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of June 1157 small unit patrol activities were conducted. These activities resulted in 37 contacts, of which 19 were initiated by friendly forces and 19 by enemy forces. Enemy casualties are listed in Part III.
2. Intensive saturation patrol activity utilizing small-unit, long range patrols were conducted throughout the month to deny the enemy access to the rocket belt and rocket launching sites.
3. First Battalion, 7th Marines terminated their mission in Operation Memeluke Thrust on 13 June 1968. See Special enclosure.
4. Training for the month was greatly reduced, due to operational commitments. Training was conducted in small unit leadership, fire discipline and employment of the M-16.

PART III

1. THE ORGANIZATION COMMITTED TO COMBAT

a. Combat Mission Assigned. Occupy and defend assigned TAOR. Maintain a saturation level of patrol activity within TAOR. On order, be prepared to conduct offensive operations outside the TAOR. Interdict and deny the use of waterways and other routes of egress or ingress to

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the enemy. Provide security for the food net and traffic within the TAOR. Locate, capture or destroy enemy forces attempting to move material or rockets into the rocket belt. Conduct a pacification program in support of the GVN. Assist in the RD program.

b. Significant Operations Conducted. First Battalion, Seventh Marines participated in Operation Hameluke Thrust from 1-13 June. No other significant operations were conducted in 1/7's TAOR.

e. Equipment. No major shortage

f. Command Relations. Normal

g. Logistics

(1) There is still a requirement for covered bunkers on Hill 10. The overall upkeep of the present bunkers is fair.

(2) A 16' X 32' underground bunker is being constructed by the 1st Engineer Battalion at the LZ. This bunker will be utilized for the BAS and will be a big improvement for the battalion.

(3) The messhall has seen a great improvement both in food preparation and police. Water coolers have been installed along with a new generator.

(4) The overall transportation capabilities for the battalion are excellent.

h. Civic Action. A total of 41 Vietnamese civilians were treated by the battalion corpsmen and the battalion dentist. The battalion acted in the support of a school construction project and swine raising project at An Tam in conjunction with the 29th Civil Affairs Company.

i. Administration. No problem areas have been encountered.

j. Personnel. The battalion is presently at C-2 level. The total strength is 32 Marine Corps Officers, 908 Marine Corps Enlisted, 3 Naval Officers, and 42 Naval Enlisted.

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k. Communications. During the first part of June, communications platoon supported the battalion and Headquarters, 26th Marines on Operation Mameluke Thrust. The 100 KW generator supplying power for Hill 10 was damaged by lightning and was replaced by NSA with a rebuilt 100 KW. An addition was made in the Comm Center to provide a separate restricted area for Crypto Repair. All areas of the alternate COC were painted and new lighting installed.

(1) Radio. Four new AN/PRC-25's were received through supply.

(2) Wire. Telescopic metal poles were acquired and used to improve the wire to Hill 41.

l. Special Services. No special services equipment was drawn by the battalion due to annual inventory.

m. Weather

- (1) Maximum Temperature: 102 degrees
- (2) Minimum Temperature: 83 degrees
- (3) Mean Temperature: 88 degrees
- (4) Average Humidity: 79 per cent

n. Intelligence

(1) Low level agent reports indicate a reduction in size of enemy units within 1/7's TAOR. The only previously known major force reported was the 402nd MF Sapper Battalion. Contact during this period has been light, and consists mainly of mining, booby traps, and grenading of friendly units. The lack of actual unit to unit contact and the small size of units reported on (i.e. mainly VC Companies and Platoon) tends to confirm two reports received on 21 June 68, that claim NVA units are being pulled back for retraining. Another factor that can be accredited to lack of heavy contacts is operation Mameluke Thrust. The enemy apparently consolidated his forces in the south western Charlie Ridge area. This is confirmed by APD's in late May and early June, also by a Chieu Moi, and POW's taken during Operation Mameluke Thrust.

(2) A report was received that one battalion of the 308th Division is located within 1/7's TAOR. This report is still unconfirmed and no identifiable contact with the unit has been made.

(3) Significant Trends Noted

(a) There is still a definite trend toward lack of contact with units of this battalion.

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b. The incidence of minings and booby-traps has lessened, but it should also be noted that the majority of the battalion was out of the TAOR for June.

q. Psychological Operations. Leaflet drops and aerial broadcasts were made in support of the battalion's operational commitments.

r. Activation/Deactivation/Redesignation. None.

s. Medical

(1) General. Following Operation Mameluke Thrust the general health of battalion personnel has returned to normal. Many of the diarrhea cases were amoebiasis, and many fevers of unknown origin were malaria, the falciparum variety predominately, but a few cases of vivax are present. More stringent measures requiring Company Commanders to supervise and report on the malaria pill consumption are now in operation and should bring control measures up to proper level. Individual mosquito control measures are the biggest factor remaining in control of this disease.

(2) Evacuation. Evacuation of casualties continues to be good.

(3) Supply. No major problems

(4) Other. A follow up inspection was made of mess facilities and sanitation at Hill 22. Some conditions which are intolerable still exist but are to be corrected. The sanitation on Hill 10 has been improved.

(1) Direct support was provided by 3d Battalions, 11th Marines. Kilo Battery 155 H(SP), 4th Battalion, 11th Marines was assigned the mission of reinforcing fires to 1st Battalion, 7th Marines. Golf Battery 105 H, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines was given the mission of priority of fires to 1st Battalion, 7th Marines.

(2) At 180900H May 68, Golf Battery 3/11 displaced from Hill 10 to Hill 52 (AF787553). At 191300H May 68, Kilo Battery 4/11 displaced

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from Hill 65 to Hill 52. At 301000H May 68 Golf and Kilo Battery displaced from Hill 52 to Thuong Duc Airfield (30151540).

(3) Adjustment of fire during the 1st half of Operation Hameluke Thrust was not difficult due to light vegetation along the valley floor and surrounding foothills. As the Operation continued, adjustment of fire became difficult due to terrain. The area concerned is characterized by steep hill masses and extremely heavy vegetation. It became necessary to employ high angle fire techniques frequently to ensure effective delivery of fire. Also in the late afternoon and early evening it became difficult to adjust fire due to fog and clouds closing in around the area.

(4) The table below reflects the type of missions and artillery ordnance expended in support of 1/7 Operation Hameluke Thrust.

b. Air

(1) General. Close and direct air support missions, both fixed and rotary wing were accomplished on a frogged and on call basis. Requests for air support were made through the Regimental TAC Net. Additional needs for fixed wing support were requested through DaNang DASC by the aerial observers who were working in support of the operation.

(2) Fixed Wing. A total of 84 sorties were flown in support of the operation. Due to heavy jungle canopy, only 36 of these sorties were controlled by a FAC. Accurate bomb damage assessments were difficult to obtain due to the limited visibility in the target area. During periods of heavy enemy contact fixed wing ordnance delivery was very effectively used against the enemy and the ordnance delivery was observed to be on target for the units in contact. Clear weather permitted the extensive use of aerial observers. F-105's were used to interdict probable routes of enemy egress. Flare ships were used very effectively during enemy night attacks and also as a deterrent to enemy night movement. No fixed wing aircraft were lost during the operation.

(3) Rotary Wing. Helicopter support for troop lifts, logistical support and medical evacuations was accomplished by the use of two CH-46's

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and supporting gun ships that were based at Hill 55. One CH-46 was shot down and destroyed by enemy ground fire. One CH-46 received minor damage due to enemy fire.

c. Fire Support Coordination. Due to lack of communication between Battalion FSCC and Regimental FSCC there was limited use of SAV-82s; instead, observation of the gun-target line was employed and used most effectively due to close coordination between the air and artillery liaison officers.

8. Intelligence

a. Enemy Situation. Prior to the operation enemy forces in the area were estimated to be as follows:

2nd Bn, 31st NVA Regt - ZC2059
368B NVA Arty Regt - ZC2060
Q-14th LF VC Co-Dai Loc District

NVA and LF enemy forces were believed operating in the Thuong Duc Valley area and in the mountains at the western end of Charlie Ridge. Enemy presence was evidenced by usually reliable sources, reporting on 17 May indicating the Headquarters of one battalion from the 31st NVA Regt was located in the vicinity of (ZC207590), one other battalion from this Regt is also located in the general area. The normal operating area for the Q-14th is in the Dai Loc District, as indicated by the 19 May III MAF Perintrep. Intelligence reports have indicated the operational area of the 368B NVA Arty Regt as being in the vicinity of (ZC2060). Lack of mines and booby-traps was a significant indication that the enemy desired to move freely in the area of operation.

b. Enemy Capabilities. The enemy was believed to have been capable of attacking or defending within the operational area with forces up to 2 NVA Battalions, plus a VC local force company and that reinforcements would likely come from the 2nd NVA Division. It was further believed that if the enemy felt he was greatly outnumbered he would probably limit his contact to ambushes and harassment activity. It was assumed the enemy would defend if his base areas or main storage points were threatened.

c. Enemy Contacts. On D-1, B, C, D, and E 3/7 engaged an estimated enemy company in fortified positions, in the vicinity of (ZC198558) resulting in 36 enemy KIA. This force was believed to be an ambush element as evidenced by their extensive use of supporting M-79 fire and automatic weapons plus mortars. On D-7, B Company received heavy small arms and mortar fire from an estimated enemy company in the vicinity of (ZC141462) which resulted in 1 POW and 53 enemy KIA. On D-17 an estimated NVA Platoon guided by Sappers of the T-3 Battalion, infiltrated 1/7's defensive perimeter temporarily resulting in 7 enemy KIA. Among the captured equipment was one document and 1-ARM indicating the enemy presence of elements from the T-3 NVA Sapper Battalion. Other contacts made

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during the operation, (See paragraph 10), indicated the enemy forces in the area totalled approximately 2 Battalions (plus).

d. Terrain Analysis. The terrain encountered, went from flat, cultivated lowlands surrounded by bamboo thickets and treelines to the mountainous area where heavy rain forests of up to 70 feet canopy prevailed. Sparse secondary canopy of about 20 feet was encountered throughout the more elevated mountainous region. Steep slopes hampered movement throughout the mountains, as both have characteristics, affording poor trafficability. Cover in the foothills and mountainous area is excellent from flat trajectory weapons. In the lowlands it is considered fair. Concealment is considered fair to poor in the lowlands area, however, it will be excellent in and around villages, associated bamboo thickets and treelines from the low ground into the mountains.

c. Intelligence Conclusions

(1) Confirmed personnel losses inflicted on the 31st NVA Regiment, T-3 Sapper Battalion and the 368B NVA Artillery Regiment are as follows: NVA KIA (112), VC KIA (94), NVA POW (2), VC POW (1). Due to the actual unknown casualties suffered by enemy forces involved, it is impossible to determine accurately to what extent their combat capabilities have been affected.

(2) Enemy morale is considered low due to hardship's encountered in the mountains, continuous bombing, and shortage of food. POW'S and Chieu Hoi's have established this existing morale problem numerous times.

(3) The enemy was denied the complete freedom of movement and base camp environments that he enjoyed prior to the operation. He was denied the opportunity to attack Thuong Duc Special Forces Camp, due to the pressure imposed by our operating forces.

9. Mission. On order conduct uncovered movement to contact westward along Thuong Duc Valley and ridges to the north to find and destroy the enemy.

10. Concept of Operations. 1/7 attack westward from attack positions vicinity (AT7955) to seize Objective A. Continue attack on order to seize Objectives B thru H making maximum use of air support and fire; base established vicinity (ZC214552). Be prepared to employ CIDG assets when available.

11. Execution

a. 1/7 received 7th Marines FRAG C 6-68 181240Z May 68 and with a major change from helicopter assault to foot movement, adjustments were made in 1/7 Op Order to cross the IOD and seize the initial objectives on schedule.

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b. D-1 18 May 68. 1/7 conducted uncovered movement to contact commencing 191700H from (AT882582) to attack position vicinity (AT7955). While advancing Company C established contact with estimated 8-10 enemy at (AT820560). Exchange of small arms and assault of enemy position resulted in (1) USMC KIA, (2) USMC WIA; (4) VC KIA, (1) machine gun drum of ammunition, (1) AK-47 with magazine, (2) B-40 rocket rounds, (25) rounds 60mm mortar ammunition, (50) grenades, and (1) pack captured. Continued movement to attack position.

c. D-Day 19 May 68. At 190600H commenced attack westward and seized Objective A (ZC205565). While attacking to seize Objective B (ZC192568) Company C received sporadic small arms and mortar from high ground vicinity (ZC195561). Company C maneuvered to assault the enemy and came under heavy small arms and mortar from a well dug-in and concealed enemy, believed to be a reinforced company. Company D attacked to the south toward the enemy and received heavy small arms and mortar fire. Company B supported the attack by fire. Artillery, fixed wing, and HUEY Gunship support was utilized. Company L with tanks was ordered forward to counterattack, mop up and assist with the Med-Evacs. Results of the contact were (13) USMC KIA, (41) USMC WIA, (53) VC KIA, (1) SKS captured. At night, conducted patrols, ambushes, and IP'S.

d. D-1 20 May 68. Assumed OPCON Company L 3/7 plus (1) platoon of tanks at 200800H May 1968. AC spotted 3 enemy in green uniforms at (ZC175536). Called in air strikes resulting in (1) VC KIA, and (2) bunkers destroyed. Company L on Hill 52 (ZC213553) at 201010 received (8) rounds 82mm mortar fire. Returned counter mortar and 105mm HE on suspected mortar sites. No casualties were sustained and the attack continued to seize the high ground vicinity (ZC189560). Company C with (1) platoon of tanks chopped to OPCON 7th Marines at 201330H May 1968. Company L observed sniper at (ZC183559). Opened fire resulting in (1) NVA KIA, (1) AK-47 and (2) AK-47 magazines captured. Established night positions and conducted patrols, ambushes, and IP'S..

e. D-2 21 May 68. Company L discovered 10 fighting holes and (2) two man fighting holes and destroyed same. At (ZC185556) Company L found (1) enemy KIA with (1) SKS and fighting gear. Company D found enemy trenchline 15'x4'x9' which appeared to have taken direct hits from air strikes. An AC observed an unknown number of enemy at (ZC182525) and a subsequent air strike resulted in 5 enemy KIA. Secured Objective C at 211900H May 1968. Company L secured Objective D at 211940H May 1968. Set up night positions and conducted patrols, ambushes, and IP'S.

f. D-3 22 May 68. Company D reinforced with a platoon of tanks conducted a river crossing and secured the area vicinity (ZC175540). Found 36 recently dug fighting holes and destroyed same. Also found (1) CIDG from Thuong Due. KIA in previous days contact with the enemy. Further search of area revealed (29) 82mm mortar rounds vicinity (ZC169537). During sweep Company D received 18 incoming mortar rounds resulting in (9) USMC WIA. Called in artillery and air strikes on suspected positions resulting in 2 secondary explosions. Company L conducted offensive sweep to vicinity (ZC175540). Set up night positions and continued patrols, ambushes, and IP'S. 1/7 received several 82mm mortar rounds resulting in (1) USMC WIA during the night.

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g. D-4 23 May 68. Company D commenced attack toward Objective E securing same at 1000H. Company B and L commenced attack along assigned axes toward Objective F. Company D, supported by air strikes, secured Objective F at 1910 and established night positions. 1/7 conducted patrols, ambushes, and LP'S throughout the night.

h. D-5 24 May 68. Company D with tanks continued attack south of Song Vu Gia on assigned axis. Company B continued search of draws to northwest and then south toward Objective G. Company L conducted search of draws to the north. Objective G was secured by Company B. Assumed CORDOZ Company CIDG (-) forces for use as blocking forces vicinity (ZC 155539) and (ZC165545). Company D observed Company C in contact at (ZC202548) and supported Company C with fire from tanks. One flight of fixed wing was utilized and Company D swept through area and found 200 meters of trenchline and 10 bunkers which were destroyed by the tanks and air strikes. Contact resulted in (1) VC KIA. Conducted night patrols, ambushes, and LP'S.

i. D-6 25 May 68. Company D continued attack along axis of advance south of Son Vu Gia. Company L and CIDG Company (-) established blocking position vicinity (ZC144566). Company B conducted offensive sweep of the area engaging an unknown number of enemy in fighting holes and bunkers with snipers in spider holes vicinity (ZC141562). Utilizing small arms, artillery and fixed wing. Company L and Company B cleared area. Med-Evac helicopter took sniper fire and was forced to land at Special Forces camp vicinity (ZC140532). VLA's moved to more secure location for evacuation. Results of contact were (7) USMC KIA, (14) USMC VLA, (52) NVA KIA, (1) NVA PW. Meanwhile Company D vicinity (ZC174538) received (2) incoming mortar rounds of unknown type from vicinity (ZC178523). Tanks opened fire and a search of the area revealed (1) VC KIA. Company D then conducted river crossing with tanks and moved to support Companies B and L. Companies B, D and L consolidated for resupply and set up night positions. CIDG Company returned to Special Forces Camp for resupply.

j. D-7 26 May 68. Company D commenced attack toward Objective G. Company L supported attack while CIDG Company (-) moved into a flank screening position vicinity (ZC121543). Company D secured Objective G, resupplied and remained in position for the night. Company L continued to block at (ZC121558) while Company B and 1/7 CP attacked northwest. Company B and 1/7 CP linked up with Company L, setting in night positions and conducting patrols, ambushes and LP'S.

k. D-8 27 May 68. At first light Company B began attack on Objective H and secured it without incident. Company L commenced attack along axis of advance to vicinity (ZC109561). At this point the CIDG forces refused to advance and deserted the Special Forces advisor, radio operator and interpreters, who proceeded back to Thuong Duc independently. Company D detonated one unknown type AP device resulting in (1) USMC KIA. On objective G, Company D received sporadic small arms fire from 3-4 enemy. Air strikes were conducted and subsequent search of the area revealed the remains of 2 enemy KIA. All units established night positions and conducted night patrols, ambushes and LP'S.

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l. D-9 28 May 68. At 0300H Company L and 1/7 Command Group moved from night position to vicinity (ZC125565). Company D linked up with Company B vicinity (ZC121575). At 1045H 1/7 Command Group found 2 fresh graves, each containing a dead VC dressed in black. Resupply was accomplished for all units. The attack was continued toward the north with Company L leading. A search of the trail system leading North was conducted and 1/7 established night positions vicinity (ZC123580).

m. D-10 29 May 68. Company L and Company D continued a search of the trail system to the north at first light as far as (ZC125594). Company D found a ChiCom grenade beside the trail at 1115H and destroyed it. 1/7 was ordered to return to the low ground where Company L and Company D would be trucked to the fire base at Thuong Duc and Company B and 1/7 Command Group would be heli-lifted there. Weather prevented the heli-lift and the move was conducted on foot and partially by truck with all units closing on the fire base at 1900H. Positions were established around the south of the fire base in coordination with Company C.

n. D-11 30 May 68. 1/7 remained at the fire base all day, conducted resupply and enjoyed a rest and recuperation period. At 1600H the fire base received approximately 30 rounds of 81mm mortar fire resulting in 13 WIA. Counter mortar fire was delivered by artillery immediately and the fire ceased. At 1900H Company D moved out as advance guard for 1/7 in night movement to an attack position vicinity (AT791568). Company D secured the high ground vicinity (ZC190561) and (ZC195561) to cover the movement of the main body. At 2330H Company D killed 2 enemy who approached their position and captured one AK-47 and one SKS. Company D received two incoming grenades while searching the area resulting in 3 WIA minor.

o. D-12 31 May 68. 1/7 continued movement to the attack position closing all units at 0600H. Company D commenced the attack toward Objective 1 vicinity (AT790573) and secured it at 1100H. Resupply was accomplished on Objective 1 and Company D commenced the attack toward Objective 2, vicinity (ZC206576). Objective 2 was secured by Company D at 1630H and all units closed on that position and established night positions. Link up with recon team Prime Out was effected on Objective 2.

p. D-13 1 June 68. At first light Company B and Company C commenced attack toward objective 3 vicinity (ZC207592). A Chieu Hoi, a former NVA Master Sergeant, was sent to 1/7 with I.T.T. personnel to guide the Battalion to a reported arms cache. The Chieu Hoi could not orient himself and after a helicopter visual reconnaissance admitted that he was lost. He insisted that he must be returned to the valley floor so he could see certain landmarks before he could become oriented. At 0935H Company B discovered a cave along a stream containing several used bandages. At 1125H Company B discovered a grave containing one decomposed body. All units established night positions at (AT792592).

q. D-14 2 June 1968. Company B and Company L conducted combat/recon

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patrols in the vicinity of grid squares (ZC2059, 2058, 2159 and 2158). One platoon from Company D was heli-lifted to vicinity (AE815575) to escort Chieu Hoi in search of a trail. They were unable to locate the trail, however, at 1500H killed one enemy attempting to flee a roadster at (AE814567). The Chieu Hoi and Company D platoon were heli-lifted back to the Battalion and all units established night positions vicinity (AT790597).

r. D-15.3 June 68. Company D and Company B conducted search in AO bounded by (ZC190610), AE900610, AT794600, ZC200594, ZC190600 to (ZC190610). The area had been saturated by an Arolight strike but no evidence of enemy casualties was found. 1/7 was shipped to the operational control of the 26th Marines effective 031130H. Company B established a patrol base on Hill 1062 vicinity (ZC200603) and all other 1/7 units established night positions vicinity (AT790597).

s. D-16.4 June 68. Company B conducted combat/recon patrols vicinity of Hill 1062. Company D, Company L and 1/7 Command Group conducted move to link up with Company B closing at 1300H. Work was begun on an LZ and a patrol base established. Company D and Company L conducted combat/recon patrols in the vicinity of Hill 1062. At 1020H an estimated NVA squad was observed by a Company L platoon patrol. The patrol killed one enemy and found pith helmets, (5) pair of sandals and (1) S&W rifle upon searching the area. Night positions were established with Company L on objective 1 and 1/7 Command Group, Company B and Company D on Hill 1062. At 2035H Company B's perimeter received numerous frag and concussion grenades and a heavy volume of small arms fire. Company B returned fire on the enemy and a sporadic fire fight continued for almost 45 minutes. Friendly casualties were 6 KIA, 21 MIA crew, and 2 LRM. A search of the area revealed 7 enemy KIA in green utilities, 8 grenades, 3 AK-47's, 1SKS, assorted web gear and documents. The enemy unit was identified as part of the E-3 Sapper Battalion and estimated to be reinforced platoon size.

t. D-17.5 June 68. Company L commenced attacks at first light toward objective 1 vicinity (ZC199608). Company D and Company B conducted combat/recon patrols in AO's. Work was continued on the patrol base and LZ. Company L seized objective 1 and supported the attack by 3/26 on objective 36, Hill 1235, vicinity (ZC199620). Company L conducted combat patrols around objective 1. At 1200H Company L found an enemy Company size base camp with dwelling, beds, tables and bamboo plumbing system. Further search revealed a gallery and a meeting house with benches. Also found were numerous packs, khaki and green uniforms, medical kits, batteries, rice, eating utensils, numerous documents and personnel items. Night positions remained the same and at 2230H Company L received 3 rounds of small arms resulting in one USMC KIA.

u. D-18.6 June 68. Company B conducted combat/recon patrols to the west of Hill 1062. Company D conducted combat/recon patrols to the south and southeast of Hill 1062. Company L continued patrol base operations around objective 1. Improvements on the LZ and Battalion

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patrol base were continued. At 1330H a Company B platoon patrol observed 3 NVA in brown uniforms moving south. The patrol fired on the unit killing 2 and capturing 2 AK-47's, 5 Magazines, 1 Canteen, 2 Cartridge belts, 2 ChiCom Grenades, one compass and a hand drawn map. At 1400H a CH-46 resupply helicopter received ground fire after departing the LZ and crashed. All reaction force evacuated the crew but the helicopter was completely destroyed. Friendly casualties were 4 WIA evac. At 2115H Company B's perimeter observed 3 enemy on a trail and fired on them. A search of the area revealed one NVA in green utilities. The NVA was badly wounded. Also found was one AK-47, 1 magazine, 2 ChiCom grenades and assorted web gear. At 2120H Company B heard movement near their perimeter and a trip flare was activated. Company B threw grenades and fired small arms resulting in 2 enemy KIA, and the capture of 1 AK-47, 5 ChiCom grenades, several used battle dressings. Night positions remained the same.

v. D-19 7 June 68. Company B conducted combat/recon patrols to the north and northwest. Company D conducted combat/recon patrols to the northeast, east and south. At 1030H a Company D platoon patrol found one enemy KIA in a cave. The enemy was dressed in green and possessed a wallet and lighter. The body was killed about 2 days previously by small arms. At 1140H a Company D patrol received sniper fire resulting in 1 friendly KIA. At 1330H an H&S Company patrol found 2 bunkers and 3 tunnels along a stream bed. At 1405H a Company B patrol found an enemy KIA in green uniform, 2 AK-47 magazines and 5 ChiCom grenades. The body was covered by leaves and brush and had been killed by small arms fire. At 1700H a Company D platoon patrol received about 9 ChiCom grenades and 50 rounds of small arms from the high ground to their north. They returned fire and searched area finding a 1 day old squad sized harbor site with fighting holes and 8 small caves. Night positions remained the same for all units.

w. D-20 8 June 68. 1/7 received the mission to conduct a Battalion sweep east along Charlie Ridge toward the An Hoa basin to the fix and destroy the enemy. 26th Marines assigned objectives along an axis of advance and the attack was commenced. At first light with Company D as the lead element. The patrol base destroyed and all excess gear lifted out prior to the movement of the main body. Company D secured Objective 1 vicinity (AT790597) at 0930H and all units closed on that position by 1300H. Company D continued the attack eastward toward Objective 174 vicinity (AT809602), secured the Objective at 1830H and received a resupply. 1/7 Command Group, Company B and Company L moved to (AT803600) and established night positions. At 1400H Company D point observed one male in black fleeing to the southeast. Company D found one bamboo dwelling in the area, but no other signs of enemy activity. Company B reported that 3 men were missing after halting for the night. The night position had been occupied after dark and they were thought to be stragglers who were close by or mixed with H&S Company.

x. D-21 9 June 68. A search of the area for the 3 MIA's was conducted but they were not found. Company B sent a platoon to retrace

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the move of the previous day and the remainder of the Company conducted patrols in the area. Company D (-) commenced the attack toward the north and secured Objective 175 (AT812617) at 1300H. Company L and the 1/7 Command Group continued combat/recon patrols to the south and east of Objective 174. A report was received that the 3 MIA's had made their way to Hill 52 (AT98552) and were safe. Company B had moved to the valley floor in search of the MIA's and established night positions at (AT810575). The remainder of 1/7 established night positions around Objective 174.

y. D+22-20 June 68. At first light Company D and Company L commenced an attack toward the east and secured Objective 176 vicinity (AT823605) at 1200H. Company B conducted patrols in the valley and stood ready for a heli-lift to Objective 177 vicinity (AT840713). Company L and Company D continued the attack toward Objective 177, secured it and established night positions. Company B moved to (AT861588) and established night positions.

z. D+23-11 June 68. Company L commenced the attack at first light toward the east and secured Objective 178 (AT856621) at 1000H. Company D commenced an attack toward Objective 181 (AT860642) and secured it at 1800H. Company B was heli-lifted to Objective 177 and conducted a combat sweep through Objectives 177 to 180. Company L and 1/7 Command Group secured Objectives 177 and 180, prepared an LZ and received a resupply on the latter. Night positions were established with Company D on Objective 181 and 1/7 Command Group, Company B and Company L on Objective 180.

aa. D+24-12 June 68. Company D commenced the attack toward the east and conducted a search of the valley for rocket firing sites. Company L commenced the attack toward Objective 182 vicinity (AT887696) securing it at 1100H. Company D closed on Objective 184 vicinity (AT905663) at 1200H and continued the movement to its combat base on Hill 41 (AT934663). Company L conducted a combat sweep of Charlie Ridge south of Hill 41 to MSR 5 for vehicle pickup and return to 3/7. 1/7 Command Group and Company B conducted a combat sweep from Objective 180 to Hill 10 (AT925691). Operational control of 1/7 was passed to the 7th Marines at 1315H and the operation was terminated.

13. Administrative Matters

a. Supply. A logistical support area (LSA) was established at Hill #55 (AT967615) through D+20 and was moved to Hill #10 (AT925690) on D+21 through D+27. Class I supplies were furnished by HST from Hill #55 LSA and 1/7 on Hill #10 LSA. All class II supplies were furnished by the Battalion with the exception of some Medical supplies and clothing from the FLC supply block and some Class II items from Headquarters Battalion Supply. Any items requested which were not available at the LSA or Battalion Supply were sought by priority 02 walk through requisitions. There was a small amount of Class III supplied by 1st Engineers to keep the power saws also furnished by 1st Engineers in operation. All Class V was furnished by Ammo Supply Point number one, (ASP-1).

b. Maintenance. A Maintenance Contact Team from Maintenance Battalion, 1st Force Service Regiment was attached to the LSA. This contact team had ordnance and communication field repair capability and a limited "float" capability. Equipment which could be repaired in the field was normally repaired in less than four (4) hours.

c. Transportation. Primary method of resupply was by helicopters. An air Delivery Team was attached to the LSA to provide the capability of air dropping supplies where helicopters could not land. Two (2) trucks, Platform M274A2 (Mules) and drivers were provided from this Battalion to the LSA for transportation of supplies within the LSA. This greatly increased the efficiency of staging supplies within the LSA.

d. Communication. All resupply requests were processed through the HST not to the LSA. Med-evac communications were initially processed through the Med-evac net to the LSA and from the LSA land line to the Air Liaison Officer (ALO). Med-evacs were called in directly to the ALO who immediately requested the med-evac helicopter.

e. Medical. Most medical supplies were furnished by the Battalion Aid Station (BAS). Although there were some medical supplies furnished from the FLC supply block. Emergency and priority med-evacs were taken directly to 1st Medical Battalion and LSA. Routine med-evacs, with the exception of KIA's, were processed through the dispensary set up at Hill #55, and through BAS on Hill #10.

f. Engineers. "C" Company, 1st Engineers Battalion was attached

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to this organization to provide Engineer support. The primary employment of this unit was for the destruction of "duds", enemy emplacements, and clearing of landing zones.

g. Problem Areas. Problems encountered were as follows:

(1) Supply. Some supply shortages did exist at the LSA. These items were primarily communications items such as H-189 hand sets, whip antennas, tape antennas, and bases. Various sized of jungle boots and jungle utilities were also not in stock. These items were put on priority O2 walk through requisitions on a daily basis, but were usually met with negative results.

(2) Maintenance. Due to the availability of the Ordnance and Comm-Elect Contact teams, there were no problems in this area.

(3) Communications. There were no problem areas in communications.

(4) Medical. Although there were at times some shortages in the medical field, no major problems were encountered.

(5) Engineers. Engineer problems encountered were primarily in felling trees while clearing Landing Zones. It is recommended that about 300 permits of demolitions be requested for clearing purposes. These demolitions would be used for the initial clearing of an LZ, and the power saws should be limited to small branches and trees no larger than twelve (12) inches in diameter.

14. Communications

a. FM radio utilizing radio set AN/PRC-25 was the primary means of communications. An AN/PRC-17 SSB radio was taken out to monitor the Regimental Command Net; however, due to bulkiness and ineffectiveness, it was returned to the CP after 10 days. In addition to this battalion's tactical net, this battalion guarded 7th Marines tactical net and then 26th Marines tactical net as the tactical situation dictated. In both cases, relay stations were available to communicate with either regimental CP if any trouble with direct communications arose. Generally, communications was very good and hardly any difficulties were encountered. If problems developed with direct communications, they were usually alleviated by the relay stations. Both relay stations were from regiments--Seventh Marines on hill 65 and 26th Marines on hill 1025 North.

b. No significant problems were encountered in communications with the rifle companies.

c. The LSA provided adequate support in resupply of communications. Normal equipment such as batteries posed no problem, however, some equipment such as tape antenna bases, AB-591's, tape antennas and

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handsets were difficult to obtain, though request frequently. Nine radios were evacuated for repair to the LSA communication contact team and then returned to the field as requested.

d. Some difficulty in radio communications was experienced when operating in thick vegetation or when masked by hill masses. Also, atmospheric conditions and operating over great distances occasionally presented problems. In most cases, erecting a RC-292 in a static position or utilizing a whip antenna overcame such difficulties. Batteries, particularly Japanese batteries made by the Crown Corporation posed a problem. Their life was very short and caused frequent changes. However, batteries were never a major problem.

e. Some frequency interference posed a minor problem. Because of the altitude this organization was operating at, it was easy to pick up interfering signals from probably the U. S. Army in the Southern I Corps area. This problem was usually alleviated by changing frequencies or just communicating through slight interference.

f. Telephones TA-1/PT were used in a static situation primarily as communications between defensive positions and the H&S Company CP. These were used only occasionally, but proved to be worthwhile. However, one difficulty is that this telephone is completely inoperable when wet. During conditions of rain and damp weather, telephone communications would be marginal. Due to the tactical situation, TA-1/PT telephones and wire was evacuated back to Hill 10 after 14 days.

g. Generally, the communications for Operation Mameluke Thrust were very good with only a few minor discrepancies. Radio communications can never be counted as being completely reliable, but on this operation it performed quite satisfactorily.

15. Special Equipment and Techniques. The three gallon disposable water bladders used on this operation proved to be invaluable, although it is recommended they be lowered to the ground gently to prevent them from bursting. The 250 gallon water bladders introduced to this battalion for the first time, proved to come in very handy if the battalion was in a static situation. The dispensing of this water was a very slow process, and it is recommended that 5 gallon cans be sent out with the water bladders to speed up water distribution.

16. Commanders Analysis

a. Operation Mameluke Thrust was designed to permit a thorough search of the Thuong Dun Valley and the rugged mountainous area to the north identified as the headquarters and logistic base of the

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386B Artillery Regiment and the 31st NVA Regiment.

b. Intelligence reports indicated there were several large arms caches and enemy installations located in the area of operation.

c. Although significant enemy forces were encountered only two times, the maneuver elements did locate tunnels, caves, and base camps which obviously served enemy forces in the area.

d. The size of the operational area and the time available precluded a more thorough search. The Battalion traversed many potentially good harbor sites in the area of operation. These areas could provide adequate cover, concealment and water for large enemy units.

e. Enemy contact and evidence of enemy activity made it obvious that the area is frequently used by enemy units and provided them with excellent base areas. There is little doubt that the enemy intends to operate in this area from time to time, and that unless additional operations are conducted they will be able to do so with relative impunity.

17. Recommendations. That additional operations be conducted in the area to fix and destroy the enemy forces operating therein to interdict enemy supply and troop movement, and to destroy or capture enemy supply caches.
