PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of December 928 small unit patrol activities were conducted. These activities resulted in 67 contacts, of which 35 were initiated by friendly forces and 32 by enemy forces. Enemy casualties are listed in Part III.
2. There were no major, named operations conducted by the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines during the month of December. All four rifle companies conducted sweep operations in their respective AO's for approximately 3-5 days to familiarize themselves with the new AO. Company A was involved with Operation Meade River 1-9 December and were attached to 2/5 the first two days and 3/26 the remaining seven days.

3. Training for the battalion during the month of December continued to place emphasis on small unit leadership. Also covered were med-evacs, spot reports, fan firing, personal response.

PART III

1. FMF ORGANIZATION COMMITTED TO COMBAT

a. Combat Mission Assigned. Occupy and defend assigned TAOR. Maintain a saturation level of patrol activity within TAOR. On order be prepared to conduct offensive operations outside the TAOR. Interdict and deny the use of waterways and other routes of egress or ingress to the enemy. Provide security for the road net and traffic within the TAOR. Conduct a pacification program in support of the GVN. Assist in the RD program. Provide Bridge security for 4 Bridges in TAOR.

c. Equipment. No major shortage.

d. Command Relations. Normal

e. Logistics.

(1) Maintenance of all bunkers on Hill #37 are in need of close police call each morning. The overall upkeep of all bunkers is fair. However they need continuous maintenance due to the heavy rain fall.

(2) The Battalion Ammunition Bunker is in a good state of police and control of all ammunition is in accordance with current Battalion and Division Orders. In the past month we have re-sand bagged and waterproffed the bunkers and put the necessary drainage facilities that are needed for the up coming monsoon season. They now meet the requirements set forth by the Division Ordnance Officer.

(3) The messhall is in a good state of police and is continually making improvements.

(4) All Grade III turn in ammunition is being inspected for safety before leaving this combat base, however there are improvements to be made by the using unit, on turning in Grade III ammunition.

(5) At the present time, there are no late reports.

(6) The overall transportation capabilities of the Battalion is excellent, but vehicle maintenance is at present a problem due to the lack of spare parts and the adverse road conditions.

(7) The Battalion Embarkation is in excellent condition at the present time.

f. Civic Action.

(1) Held periodic Medcaps and Dentscaps through coordination B.A.S. and Army Advisors.

(2) Distributed school kits and notebooks to schools in the Dai Loc District.

(3) Distributed medicine and health and sanitation aids to the Vietnamese at District to be used in treating the populace in this area.

(4) Procured wood and tin for Protestant and Catholic Schools.

(5) Secured transportation to carry lumber and cement to Vietnamese Chaplain's church.

(6) Distributed five (5) truckloads of ammo boxes to Protestant School.

(7) Provided passes for civilians working on this hill.

(8) Aided the concession workers in the establishment of their Concession Stand.

(9) Secured help from Engineers in repairing road East of bridge. (Coordinates 913577)

(10) Coordinated with 7th Engineers in getting the land leveled for the building of a Catholic School. (Coordinates 917580)

(11) Made Goodwill Solatium Payments to Ho Thi TRAP and Tham thi KHI for death of their relatives who were killed hostile mortar fire.

(12) Turned in all required reports due to Regiment.

g. Administration. No problems have been encountered.

h. Personnel. The battalion is presently at C2 manning level. Total strength is 32 Marine Corps Officers, 1044 Marine Corps Enlisted, 3 Naval Officers, and 53 Naval Enlisted.

i. Communications.

(1) General. The move from Hill 10 to Hill 37 was accomplished. Extensive rewiring is required and is being accomplished,

by a wireman 2511 and a generator repairman 1141, as material is made available. Communications' regular electrician, a radio telegraph operator 2533, was medevac as a result of the mortar attack. Five communicators, a Corporal 5931, Lance Corporal 2542, PFC 2511, Corporal 2533 and PFC 2531 were medevac due to the mortar attack. One lance Corporal 2511 was medevac due to nonhostile accident. Regiment is acting to replace these personnel. One field radio operator was attached to S-4, for maintenance of two 100 KW Generators acquired in the move. A power line was run to MACV using material supplied by MACV. The Communications office and Message center were expanded to afford operating area. The space existed but was not used by the previous tenants. A Division material and maintenance inspection was held 30 December. Initial verbal reports show satisfactory with minor discrepancies, noteworthy. A formal report is pending.

(2) Radio. An electronics contact team was requested and arrived 11 December. The team stayed one day and then came back the following day to stay overnight and check company equipment. Two directional AS-2236 antennas were installed in our new location, three additional AS-2236 antennas were drawn from Headquarters Battalion Supply.

(3) Wire. Switchboards and terminal strips were exchanged in the move to avoid extensive rewiring. Additional wiring has been installed where deficiencies exist.

(4) Repair. A repair area was established for classified equipment in the Message Center similar to the one we had established at Hill 10. The Battery Shop was moved to a more suitable location in the Communication Platoon area.

l. Intelligence.

(1) Low level agent reports indicate elements of the 31st NVA Regiment, the Q-83 Bn, 368B Arty Regiment, at least one Battalion of the 36th NVA Regiment are presently operating in the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines TAOR. Also there is a possibility that elements of the 141st NVA Regiment has moved north across the SONG VU GIA River and are harboring in the Mountains north of LOC PHU-O-C (3) coordinates (AT805567).

(2) Significant trends noted during the reporting period:

(a) Sharp increase in A/P and A/T mines were noted, especially in the TICH PHU area, coordinates (AT930592) and the area around LOC BINH (AT943559) and TUY LA (AT946554).

(b) Contact has been more numerous and much more aggressiveness has been noted from the enemy. Concentrated efforts have been made to destroy the DAI LOC Bridge (AT913577) and the POPULAR FORCE GARRISON (AT912577), the latter being overrun and destroyed the night of 20 December 1968. Numerous daylight incidents such as sniping, engaging in squad and platoon size patrols and command detonation of anti-tank mines have been occurring recently. Sightings of 5-7 enemy moving east through the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines TAOR. In the examination of items of equipment, clothing, and firearms, it has been noted much newer gear is now being found on the dead enemy.

(c) Local Populus: Are now starting to contribute information freely. Stating at numerous times where booby traps, ambushes and unsafe areas are.

o. Medical.

(1) General. Early in December, the BAS moved from hill 10, to Hill 37. This move was accomplished without difficulty. The quarters and facilities are quite satisfactory. There is adequate protection for the injured and BAS personnel in case of incoming rounds. There has been no difficulty securing transportation to get the wounded to the landing zone.

During the month of December, over 300 patients were seen and treated at the BAS. Of these 26 men were treated for shrapnel wounds sustained in enemy contact, 12 men were treated for fevers (none of which proved to be Malaria), 21 men were treated for diarrhea, 11 for gonorrhea and 8 for nonspecific urethritis.

(2) Evacuation. The Med Evacs from both the field and the BAS are more quickly accomplished than heretofore. The weather has been fair and perhaps this accounts for it.

(3) Supply. We are still waiting delivery of a refrigerator for our drugs (4 months) and an autoclave (6 Months). The remainder of our stock and supplies are in good condition for replenishment.

(4) Other

(a) We inherited a poor situation as far as sanitation was concerned. There were not enough urinoils and those present didn't work well and had to be replaced. There were not enough heads and those present were in poor condition and state of repair. There were no hand washing facilities outside each head. The mess hall was poorly laid out and not enough preparation room and storage facilities were present.

(b) These defects were all noted and are slowly being corrected.

(c) Hill 65, still needs much work on sanitation and this is in the process of being done.

(d) At present, for the first time in several months the corpsman are up to T.O.
