PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of February 502 small unit patrol activities were conducted. These activities resulted in 64 contacts, of which 33 were initiated by friendly forces and 31 by enemy forces. Enemy casualties are listed in Part III.

2. There was one major Operation during the month of February (Linn River) which started on 27 January through 7 February. Company D conducted a company size search and clear operation from 13 February to 23 February. Company A was attached to 2nd Bn, 7th Marines from 23 February thru 1 March. Company C was attached to 1st Bn, 5th Marines from 23 January thru 21 February. Company D was attached to 7th Marines from 23 February thru 27 February. Company E from 2nd Bn, 7th Marines was attached to 1st Bn, 7th Marines from 26 January thru 07 February.

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3. Training for the Battalion during the month of February continued to place emphasis on small unit leadership. Also covered were fam firing of the M60 and M-16, personal response and first aid. During the month of February 4 Officers and 25 enlisted men attended formal schools held both in country and out of country. 1st Bn, 7th Marines also conducted a Patrol Leader's School one week in duration and a Ground Servillance Radar School one week in duration.

1. FMF ORGANIZATION COMMITTED TO COMBAT

a. Combat Mission Assigned. Occupy and defend assigned TAOR. Maintain a saturation level of patrol activity within TAOR. On order be prepared to conduct offensive operations outside the TAOR. Interdict and deny the use of waterways and other routes of egress or ingress to the enemy. Provide security for the road net and traffic within the TAOR. Conduct a pacification program in support of the GVN. Assist in the RD Program. Provide Bridge Security for 4 Bridges in the TAOR.

c. Equipment. No major shortage.

d. Command Relations. Normal.

e. Logistics.

(1) The maintenance of the bunkers on Hill #37 has improved. Most of the bunkers have been re-sand bagged or reconstructed to provide better protection. Police of bunker areas is fair. Some new post bunkers are now under construction. The work order for two new battalion watch towers has been approved by division.

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(2) The Battalion Ammunition Bunker is in a good state of police and control of all ammunition is in accordance with current Battalion and Division Orders. The new Battalion HE Bunker has been waterproofed and sand bagged and ammunition has been palletized to meet requirements of the Division Ordnance Officer. Bunkers have been provided to separate tank ammunition from 106 rounds.

(3) The messhall is in a good state of police and is continually making improvements. A new grease trap system is currently being installed and a new 16'x16' garbage house is being constructed to aid in sanitation problems.

(4) All Grade III turn-in ammunition is being inspected for safety before leaving this combat base, however there are improvements to be made by the using units on turning in Grade III ammunition.

(5) Due to a mix up in the guard mail, the only report submitted late during the reporting period was the Phase II Budget.

(6) The overall transportation capabilities of the Battalion are excellent, but vehicle maintenance on mules at the present time is a problem due to the lack of spare parts which are on order.

(7) The Embarkation Records are in order and are constantly updated to correspond with the equipment that is on hand in the Battalion. The Mechanized Embarkation Data System is being updated also so as to effectively change over from the previous system of embarkation due to the new data processing system. Overall the Battalion Embarkation is in excellent condition.

f. Civic Action

(1) Held periodic Medcaps and Dentcaps through coordination with BAS.

(2) 2Feb69 Audio-Visual Team showed movies to villagers in Dai Phu. Favorable response.

(3) 10Feb69 Gave Personal Response and PsyOps to Transients.

(4) 11Feb69 Went to Dai Loc Bridge (AT911576) to evaluate needed materials to reconstruct the bridge.

(5) 11Feb69 1stLt HEUSNER and WO CHUONG attended party given by District Chief. Talked about culvert replacement by PF's near Loc An Village.

(6) 15Feb69 Distributed captured rice to Catholic Church.

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(7) 16 Feb69 Held special Medcap and Dentcap at refugee ville west of hill 65. Distributed approximately 500 toys to children. Also used HB Team to tell the people not to run from Marines. (AT960572)

(8) 17 Feb69 Chaplain distributed 100 ammo boxes to Catholic School.

(9) 18 Feb69 Distributed letters on RD ~~Cables~~ to the Companies. Also sent letters concerning SIR'S.

(10) 20 Feb69 Visited Asst. District Chief and Army Advisors concerning new public School.

(11) 21 Feb69 Coordinated with 7th PsyOps Bn. in the exploitation of Chieu Hoi, Special Aerial Broadcast and Leaflet drop.

(12) Used P.O.E.T. Team to exploit a mortar attack on the villagers near Dai Loc District Hqtrs.

(13) 27 Feb69 Installed culvert in the road (AT907575). Vietnamese workers were very enthusiastic.

(14) 28 Feb69 Submitted Phan Thi NGO'S resignation to Division I.R.C

(15) Picked up payroll for the four (4) girls that work in the MESSHALL.

(16) Turned in all required reports due to Division and to Regiment.

g. Administration. No problems have been encountered.

h. Personnel. The Battalion is presently at C1 manning level. Total strength is 35 Marine Corps Officers, 1112 Marine Corps Enlisted 3 Naval Officers and 49 Naval Enlisted.

i. Communications.

(1) General Communications platoon is continuing to replace the wooden flooring in the bunker with cement flooring as the cement becomes available. The walls and overheads are being painted to allow for better light reflection in the working areas. Fluorescent lights are also being added as they become available. Communications platoon is continuing to provide personnel for roadsweep, guard, bridge security, and reaction squad, besides providing radio operators as required and regular watches.

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(2) Radio. 180 AN/PRC-88 radio sets were received through supply. Each company is being issued 35 and the 81MM mortar platoon was issued eleven. Although the battalion has not received their issue of fifteen AN/PRC-77's, one was drawn from regiment for the interim period. This gives us the capability of having a portable covered circuit. This equipment is compatible with the non-portable covered circuit equipment, KY-8. One Pvt., 2531 was KIA on Operation LINN RIVER.

(3) Wire. The battalion wire chief rotated this month and there is no prospect for a replacement as yet. The battalion message center chief, Sgt Ragsdale, is doubling up as wire chief for the time being. The wiremen are continuing the replacement of worn wiring and maintenance of equipment.

(4) Tech Shop. Three technicians were transferred. One Cpl 2841, was transferred to 1st Tank Battalion due to the fact that 2841's are not T/O for an infantry battalion. All the infantry battalions are losing their 2841's as they are being reassigned to T/O billets. A Cpl 2847 was transferred to regiment and one Cpl 2815 rotated. Two 1D-1189, Channel Alignment Indicators were received for the AN/PRC-88 radios and a new tool set, AN/USM-15 were received in Tech Shop through supply. A radar operator school is being held by the radar technicians for two men from Charlie company.

(5) Message Center. One PFC 2541, was transferred to the Third Battalion, Seventh Marines.

j. Special Services

(1) Special Services picked up and issued 320 cases of beer and 160 cases of soda for the month of February.

(2) It provided three Special Services shows two for Hill 37 and one for Hill 65.

(3) A reorganization of the Special Services tent has begun.

(2) Significant Trends

(a) AP and AT mining incidents remain high during the reporting period; the majority of which were in the "LINN RIVER" operational area and also along Liberty Road.

(b) Sniper incidents have also been relatively high during the reporting period in the 1/7 TAOR. The enemy succeeded in destroying the bridge on Route 4 west of Hill 65 (AT867573) and launched several attacks against Dai Loc District Hdq. (AT9157), the RF outpost in that area, the refugee village west of Hill 65 and attempted (2) assaults on Hill 65 with Sappers, using mortars and RPG Fire for support.

(c) Numerous incidents of the raising of NLF flags were noted along Liberty Road and in the adjacent village areas during the Post TET period.

(d) Excessive movement of enemy forces up to Battalion size occurred in the southeastern portion of the TAOR. This increase in enemy activity is largely attributed to the TET period and may decrease significantly in the coming month.

(e) The enemy is utilizing terror and propaganda tactics to attempt to influence the inhabitants of Dai Loc District to move westward. Forced coolie labor has increased noticeably during the reporting period also, with a route established by the interrogation of a number of Chieu Hoi's laborers, to be from the Arizona Area North to a pick-up point in the vicinity of (AT920620).

(1) Artillery. Battery K, 4th Bn, 11th Marines continues in general support of 7th Marines. Battery I, 3d Bn, 11th Marines continues in direct support of the 7th Marines with priority of fires to 1st Bn, 7th Marines.

o. Medical

(1) General. During the Tet season, the BAS bunkers were adequately set up to handle mass casualties. These will remain in such a state of readiness so that the wounded can be treated in relative safety.

(2) A review of the records for the month reveals: a total of 690 patients treated (military) and 79 civilians were treated. This total includes 30 gonorrhea, 81 gastro-intestinal disturbances (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and cramps), 46 shrapnel wounds, 11 gun shot wounds, 37 fevers, (of all types) 4 acute psychiatric disturbances. Not listed are headaches, colds, sore ears, immersion foot, fungal infections, fractures, sprains, other VD, and the many jungle ulcers.

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(3) A repeated and continuing effort was and is being made to insure the weekly ingestion of the malaria (Chloroquin-Primaquin) tablets.

(4) A more adequate and satisfactory Med Cap program has been instituted through the S-5.

(5) Evacuation. Medevacs were in all cases completed rapidly there continues to be no problem in transporting the ill and wounded to the LZ.

(6) Supply. A refrigerator is still to be delivered although we have been waiting 6 months. The rest of our drug supplies and field supplies are in sufficient quantities.

(7) Sanitation. Daily inspections by the assigned corpsman of the excreta disposal facilities and the Messhall have been accomplished. Once to twice weekly contentment inspection by a M.O. have also been done.

(8) We are still awaiting completion of the new GI house and baffle type grease trap for the Messhall.

(9) Re-inspection of Hill 65 revealed again a too fully inadequate refuse dump. Remedial measures are reportedly in progress (a sanitary landfill).

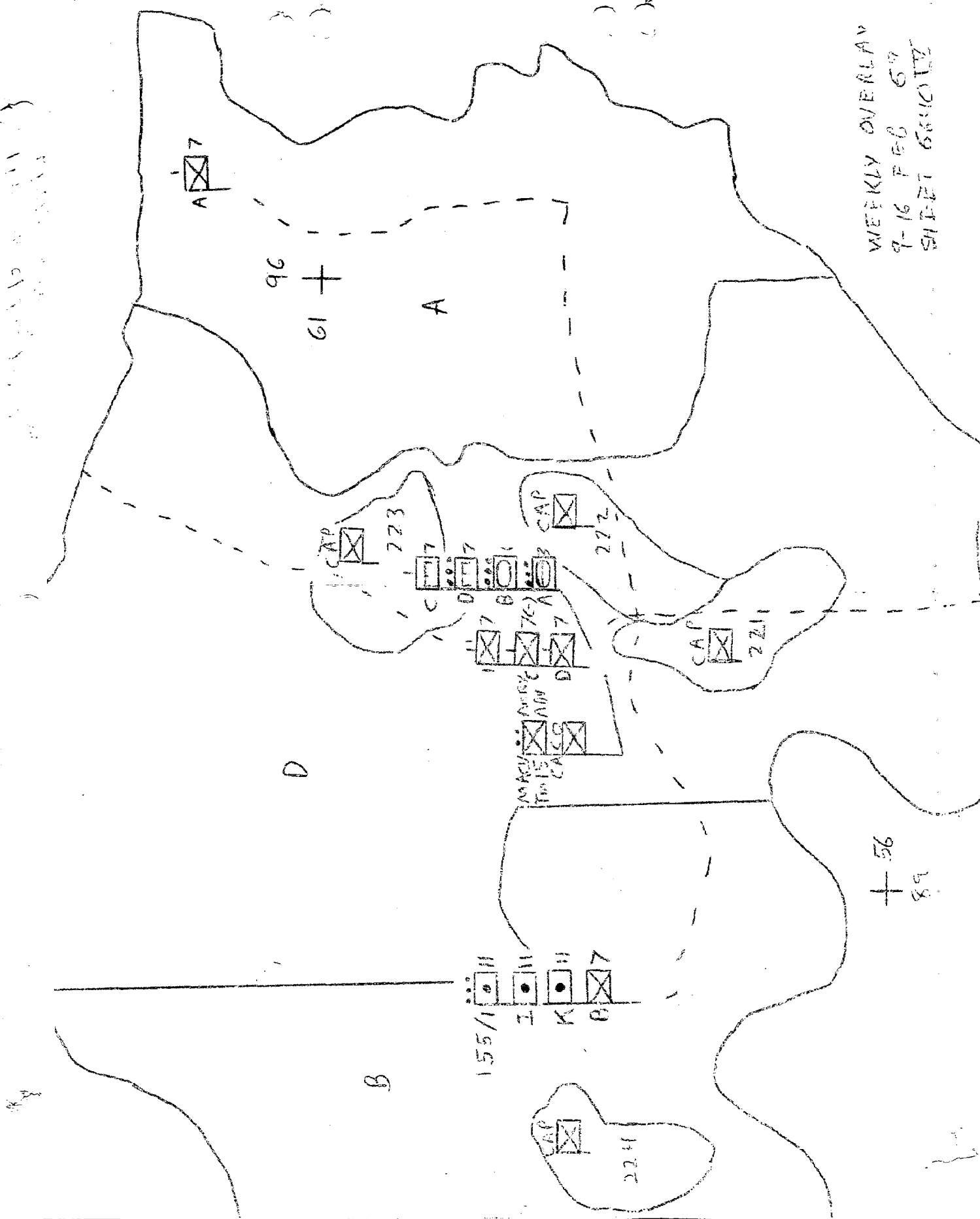

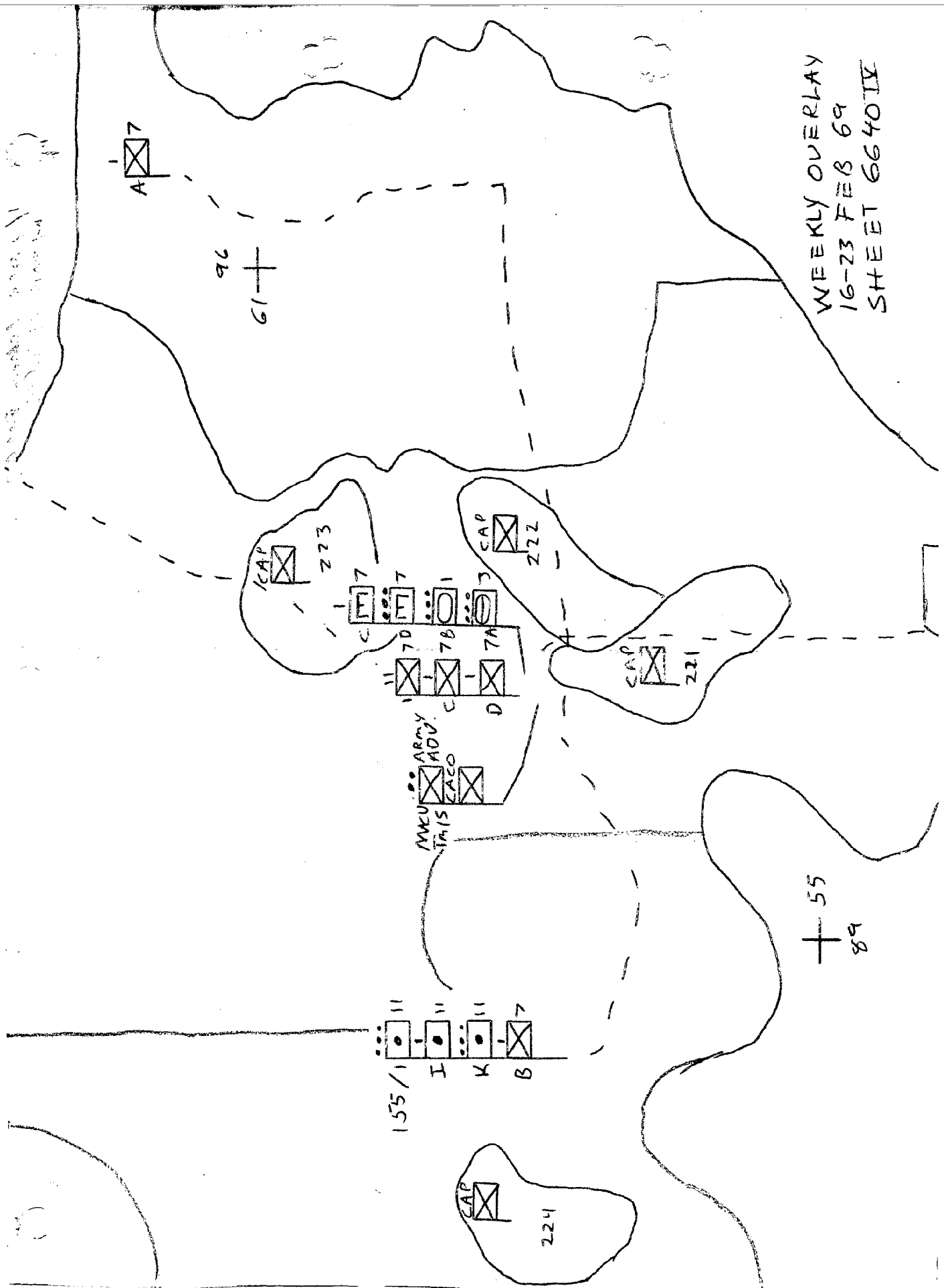
