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## PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of January, 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines continued aggressive patrolling in the TAOR, with emphasis placed on saturation of the rocket belt. Also the Battalion maintained a defensive posture at the Nam O Bridge and continued to provide security and daily patrol sweeps along Route One in Hai Van Pass.

2. Contact was made with the enemy on 26 occasions, and rockets were launched on two separate occasions from positions within the TAOR. The most significant enemy contacts were as follows:

a. On 4 January Co E sent a 33 man reaction force to aid CAP Q2 in HOA VINH. CAP Q2's base was under attack. The reaction force received sporadic automatic weapons fire as the enemy broke contact to the west.

b. On 7 January approximately 48 rockets of unknown size were launched from grid square 8679 against the Force Logistic Command Complex and H Battery, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines. Immediate counter rocket fire was returned. A search of the impact area revealed sundry gear and numerous blood trails.

c. On 18 January while on Operation 1-68, Co E made contact with an unknown number of enemy in Elephant Valley (AT 815849). The ensuing fire fight netted one enemy KIA (C) and two captured assault rifles, AK-47.

d. On 18 January Co G sent a unit, 7G14, to check out a suspected rice cache. 7G14 made contact with an estimated enemy squad and killed two. There were 3 USMC non-medevac casualties.

e. On 26 January Co G made contact on two occasions. The contact resulted in two KIA (C) and two captured assault rifles, AK-47.

f. On 30 January G1 at Nam O Bridge killed 3 enemy swimmers approaching the bridge with an explosive device.

g. On 30 January approximately 29 rockets 140MM/120MM were fired at H Battery, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines. Immediate counter battery fire was returned with good area coverage.

h. On 30 January a squad sized road sweep from Co G encountered approximately 6 enemy attempting to interdict Route One. The contact resulted in 5 USMC WIA, 2 civilian KIA, 2 civilian WIA, 3 enemy KIA (C), and 2 enemy WIA captured. Three AK-47 rifles, 2 B-40 rockets, and 1 launcher were also captured.

i. On 31 January an intelligence report was received that there were approximately 80 enemy in the vicinity of Nam O Village. ARVN troops swept the village and elements of Co E acted as a blocking force west of the village. Air strikes and artillery were used by the Allied

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Forces, and the final results accounted by CO E were: 1 USMC KIA (from CAP Q-3), 3 USMC WIA, 23 enemy KIA (C), 1 enemy WIA captured and numerous weapons captured.

3. Operation 1-68 (See Tab A) and Operation 2-68 (See Tab B) were the only designated operations conducted by the Battalion during the reporting period.

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## PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS1. TOPICSa. Personnel and Administration

(1) During the month of January, this Battalion joined 6 Officers and 92 Enlisted personnel, and 86 Enlisted were processed for rotation.

(2) Promoted by rank were 2 SSgts, 1 Cpl and 1 LCpl.

(3) Recommendations are pending for 1 Silver Star, 4 Bronze Stars and 1 Navy Commendation Medal.

(4) 79 Marines were processed for R&R.

(5) Casualties Sustained.

(a) There were 26 casualties sustained during the reporting period of which 2 were KIA and 19 were WIA.

(b) There were 5 non-battle casualties.

b. Enemy, Weather, and Terrain

(1) During the month of January, 50 incidents occurred in the Battalion TAOR. Of these, 21 were initiated by the enemy as follows:

The most significant contact occurred on the 31st in the vicinity of Nam O Village (AT 933834). Elements of this Battalion, acting as blocking forces during an ARVN sweep of the village, engaged approximately 30 VC, killing 23 (C), 7 (P), and capturing 1 VC WIA and 10 individual weapons.

(4) During the month of January enemy activity showed a heavy increase over last month.

(5) Weather had no adverse effect on operations during the month.

c. Organization and Operations

(1) Command Relations 051200 Chop ADCON/OPODN Co H to 3/7

(2) Fire Support

(a) During the reporting period, 77 observed fire missions were fired with a total of 761 HE, 49 illumination, 10 smoke, and 33 WP rounds expended.

(b) During the same period, 4592 H&I missions were flown with a total of 10,068 rounds expended.

(3) Air Support

(a) This Battalion submitted a total of 56 helicopter requests during the month of January with 43 of these completed. 21 of these requests were med evac.

(b) During the same period 10 CAS missions were flown, numerous TPQ-10 targets were struck, and 12 observation missions were flown.

d. Plans. The 2nd Bn, 7th Marines occupies and defends positions within the assigned TAOR so as to contribute to the defense of the base area, air-field, and artillery facilities at Da Nang, and conducts aggressive day and night patrolling and offensive operations within the TAOR. The Battalion is prepared, on order, to deploy on 12 hour notice as a reserve/reaction force. It assists in training of, and provides support to Regional and Popular Forces and coordinates local security of all organizations and units in the Battalion sector as assigned. The Battalion also conducts pacification and civic action programs as directed.

(2) In addition weekly training schedules were carried out on selected subjects. (Reference Tab G to Enclosure (1)).

f. Logistics, Equipment, and Supply

(1) To improve living conditions and security within the Battalion, the following projects were completed:

- (a) 2 multipurpose barges were received, and one was issued to Co G to aid in the security of Nam O Bridge.
- (b) 700 new M16A1's were issued to troops within the Battalion.
- (c) 100 mount out boxes were received and are presently being constructed and issued out.
- (d) 5 new heads were received and issued.
- (e) 3 hardback buildings were constructed; 1 each at the C.P., Co G and Co E.
- (f) A 12x12 strongback was constructed at the Ammo Dump. It will be used as living quarters for personnel who work at the Ammo Dump.
- (g) Twelve new Starlight Screens were received and issued to the companies to help in the security of their combat bases.
- (i) 22,500 square feet of matting was laid to improve landing zone 460.

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(2) The following projects have been initiated:

(a) A request was submitted to re-grade and resurface the road leading from Route 545 to the Battalion C.P.

(b) A request was submitted for the use of a bulldozer at both Co G and Co E combat bases for improvement of present landing zones, fields of fire, defensive positions and road systems.

(c) Construction has started on the improvement of the Battalion Ammunition Dump.

(d) Present transient barracks are being moved and renovated.

g. Civil Affairs/ Civic Action

(1) The following Civic Action Projects were carried out for this reporting period.

(a) 600 Inoculations were given at Kim Lien (AT 920864).

(b) On 23 January a party was given for the Vietnamese officials in our TAOR. This was given in coordination with their TET holidays.

(c) Total Med Cap for the month of January - 224.

(d) The following Civil Affairs gear was distributed:

a. Enemy Forces. There have been no recent sightings of Enemy Forces in the operational area by ground forces. However, recent aerial recon and A. P. D. information indicate that there are personnel operating in the area of Grid (AT 815847). A great number of reports indicate that the remains of the 335 th VC Battalion are harbored in the area of Grid (AT 850823). Their strength is 113 men. It is probably this unit, in conjunction with Local Forces, that was involved in the Rocket Attack on F. L. C. on the 7 Jan 1968. Trails leading West from the Launch Sites indicate that the enemy is harbored in the Operational Area. A recent low-level report indicates an enemy arms cache located in Grid Square 8680 or 8780 in a deserted church or pagoda.

b. Friendly Forces. Company B maintains present combat base and continues saturation patrolling in the assigned TAOR. All friendly adjacent units remain the same.

(1) Artillery. All supporting units will operate from present positions.

(a) M Bty, 4/11 will be in general support reinforcing 3/11 and will be the primary firing unit for E Company for the first part of the operation.
