PART II

7 NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the period of 1-15 June, 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines continued aggressive patrolling in the TAOR with emphasis placed on saturation of the Rocket Belt. The battalion maintained a defensive posture at Nam O Bridge, White Bridge, and Lieu Cheiu Esso Plant, and conducted daily security patrols along sections of Route One in the Battalion's TAOR.

2. Company E and Company H (-) were OPCON to 1st Battalion, 7th Marines from 1-14 June.

3. Contact was made on (6) occasions during this reporting period. The most significant contacts with the enemy were as follows:

(a) On 2 June H&S Co road sweep security hit a 40 lb pressure mine at AT 900806, resulting in (1) USMC KIA and (1) USMC WIA both of which were from 7th Engineers. The mine also caused major damage to the truck.

(b) On 11 June 7F22 patrol initiated contact with an estimated ten (10) NVA/VC, resulting in (2) VC KIA and (2) USMC WIA. Enemy broke contact and entered village at AT 922840. Patrol swept area of contact and captured 2 AK-47's, 4 Chicom Grenades, 2 Ponchos, 2 Cartridge Belts and 1 Jungle Kit.

The most significant occurrence was on the 11th of June. Elements of Co "F" engaged 10 VC, AT 917843, killing 2 VC and capturing 2 AK-47's, 4 Chicom Grenades, and 5 AK-47 magazines. On the same date, elements of Co "F" engaged 4 VC AT 906856, resulting in 1 VC KIA.

(2) Fire Support

(a) During the reporting period, 79 fire missions were fired with a total of 637 HE, 13 illumination, 40 WP, and 85 "firecracker" rounds expended.

(b) During the same period 2,622 H&I missions were fired with a total of 6,815 rounds expended.

(3) Air Support

(a) This battalion submitted a total of 14 helicopter requests during the period of 1-15 June with 13 of these being completed. One of the requests was for a medevac.

(b) During the same period 0 CAS missions were flown, 36 TPQ-10 were flown, and 28 observation missions were flown.

d. Plans. The 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines continues to occupy and defend positions within the assigned TAOR, so as to contribute to the defense of the base area, airfield and artillery positions near DaNang, and to con-

duct aggressive offensive operations to include day and night patrolling within the TAOR. The Battalion continues to prepare for embarkation and conducts Phase I, pre-embarkation training as shown in TAB A to enclosure(1). On 15 June 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines was relieved by 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, and 9th MAB assumed command of 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines. The Battalion is prepared for embarkation on 16 June.

1. PURPOSE. To publish information pertaining to the BLT 2/7 training program during the shipboard and ashore phases of initial deployment.

2. CONCEPT. All phases of BLT 2/7 training will be directed toward preparing the BLT to perform its mission as the ground combat element of the SLF. The training program will be governed by directives of higher headquarters and operational commitments. The implementation of the training program will be in accordance with references (a) and (b) and other appropriate references.

3. DISCUSSION. The afloat and ashore phases of the training program must possess a high degree of flexibility which will ensure the responsiveness of the BLT to the REHAB program, availability of training facilities and the requirement to respond to operational recall. All subject matter will be geared to the needs of the particular unit based on each unit leader's knowledge of his personnel. Instructional periods, both in classroom and in the field, will focus on tactical unit integrity. That is, each commanding officer or officer-in-charge will directly conduct or supervise respective parts of the REHAB and training programs. Particular areas of emphasis will be:

- a. Maintenance and rehabilitation of equipment and weapons.
- b. Preparation for and conduct of the amphibious assault.
- c. Employment and coordination of all supporting arms.
- d. Offensive combined arms operations ashore.
- e. Field firing of all weapons.

4. ACTION. All unit commanders and officers-in-charge will familiarize themselves with references (a) and (b) and other appropriate directives pertinent to their areas of cognizance. The BLT S-3 will coordinate the training program with the SLF and the FMFPAC Liaison Officer Subic. The BLT S-4 will coordinate the logistics and transportation support, and the REHAB program. The success of our program depends on direct supervision, displayed interest and enthusiasm, which will be reflected in our combat performance. TAB (A)

1. The BLT shipboard training enroute to Subic Bay will be directed toward the individual Marine, to include the following topics:

- a. Ship's emergency drills
- b. Helo embarking and debarking
- c. Physical conditioning
- d. Unit leaders instruction on conduct ashore
- e. Moral guidance to be presented by Officers or SNCO.
- f. VD control
- g. Dangers of narcotics
- h. Individual responsibility in the event of attempted subversion
- i. OJT in first and second echelon maintenance of Organic T/E Class II Type I equipment
- j. Review of casualty reporting to include update of page 15's.
- k. Orientation on the mission and organization of the SLF

2. Unit leaders may obtain a limited number of lesson plans for the above listed topics. Direct supervision is required to ensure optimum use of existing facilities and areas, non-interference in the ship's operational routine and to occupy the individual Marine's time in a constructive manner.

BLT 2/7 Subic Bay Ashore Training Outline.

1. The BLT ashore training program at Subic Bay will be oriented toward the planning and execution of the ship-to-shore movement by helicopter-borne, waterborne or a combined assault. In support of this training, an SLF, CPX, a BLT LEX and a COMEX will be conducted.

2. Specific training topics are as follows:

- (a) Physical conditioning.
- (b) Wet net training.
- (c) Movement to contact.
- (d) Company tactics.
- (e) LVT embark/debark training.
- (f) OJT first and second echelon maintenance of organic equipment.
- (g) Ship-to-shore movement.
- (h) HST control of HIZ.
- (i) Loading and movement of artillery batteries by helo, LVT and landing craft.
- (k) Coordination and employment of supporting arms.
- (l) Jungle environmental and survival training.
- (m) Field firing of individual and crew-served weapons.
- (n) Shore Fire Control Party training to include Firax.
- (o) FAC training to include live ordnance drop where available.
- (p) Communications training to include:
 - (1) Communications procedures.
 - (2) Communications security.
 - (3) Use of KAC-QAG and KAC-PAG codes.
 - (4) Helo land and movement of radio jeeps and radio relay equipment.
 - (5) COMEX
- (q) SLF administrative requirements.
- (r) Civic Action training.
- (s) Rules of engagement.
- (t) Amphibious staff planning.
- (u) BLT LEX to include rehearsal and withdrawal.

3. Unit leaders may obtain a limited number of lesson plans from the BLT S-3. Most topics will require the preparation of lesson plans, reconnaissance, and liaison on the part of the OIC or instructor. Much of the training program will depend on the REHAB schedule and the availability of helos and other equipment. BE FLEXIBLE.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

PART II

Battalion Landing Team 2/7 passed under the command of 9th Marine Amphibious Brigade on 15 June 1968. The BLT was loaded aboard Amphibious Ready Group 76.5 shipping on 16 June 1968. The BLT Command Post was aboard the U.S.S. Valley Forge, LPH-8. On 18 June 1968 the BLT debarked from ARG shipping and established its headquarters at the Special Landing Force Camp, Subic Bay, Republic of the Philippines. From 18-30 June 1968, the BLT underwent a period of equipment rehabilitation and intensive training. The Provisional Service Battalion, 9th MAB provided maintenance and supply support.

When possible, training was conducted so as not to interfere with maintenance and rehabilitation of equipment. Training stressed all aspects of amphibious operations and included live firing of all organic and supporting weapons. While ashore at Subic Bay, from 20 to 28 June 1968, a total of 99 hours of training was completed. Nineteen hours were devoted to General Military Subjects and 80 hours were devoted to Tactics. During the same period through the REHAB/Turn Around Program the BLT turned in a total of 2,759 items. Of these items 1,858 were repaired and returned. The other 901 items were submitted for "turn around", replacements totaled 869 items. The 32 items that could not be replaced were requisitioned. In addition, to compensate for the BLT's T/E deficiencies the Provisional Service Battalion, 9th MAB issued a total of 68 line items and 12,653 end items to the BLT.

On 29 June 1968 the BLT reembarked aboard ARG shipping for the conduct of a landing exercise (HILLTOP XX). A ten hour rehearsal of the landing exercise was conducted on 30 June 1968 in the Zambales Training Area, adjacent to Subic Bay.

c. Religious Services(1) Divine Services

Four Protestant Services were held for the BLT aboard ship and at the SLF Camp, with 163 attending. Four Catholic Services were conducted with 103 attending.

(2) Personal Response

Thirty-eight Marines were present for indoctrination lectures at the SLF Camp.

(3) Counseling

Seventeen individual counseling sessions were held aboard the U. S. S. Valley Forge and at the SLF Camp. Pastoral calls were made regularly at the U. S. Naval Hospital, Subic Bay and at hospital facilities aboard the U. S. S. Valley Forge. One visit was made to the Clark Air Force Base Hospital. A visit was made and a lecture given at the Naval Station Brig, Subic Bay. Twenty-nine American Red Cross messages have been processed by the BLT Chaplain.

d. Command Relations

BLT 2/7 remained under command of 9th Marine Amphibious Brigade and under OPCON of SLF BRAVO CTG 79.5 during the reporting period.

e. Logistics

- (1) Upon arrival at Subic Bay on 18 June 1968, debarkation of the BLT went as scheduled with very few problems.
- (2) Serialized equipment was listed on TERO form and submitted for rehabilitation. Repair work of outstanding quality was performed, when considering the limited period of time involved and the large quantity of equipment submitted.
- (3) Minor transportation problems were encountered while at Subic Bay due to the fact that all BLT vehicles were turned in for rehabilitation. Organic vehicles that were released early were augmented by vehicles from 9th MAB and Naval Station, Subic Bay, as available.

f. Equipment

- a. The majority of the replacement items for the equipment requiring replacement were either available at Subic Bay or flown in from 3rd FSR, Okinawa. Individual issue items, (e.g., 782 gear) were readily available for replacement and issue. Repair of body armor, accomplished in Okinawa, produced items of excellent quality.

TRAINING

1. Battalion Landing Team 2/7 (BLT) training was directed toward preparing the BLT to perform its mission as the ground combat element of the Special Landing Force (SLF). The Training program encompassed three phases:

- Phase I, Pre-embarkation
- Phase II, Enroute to Subic Bay
- Phase III, Ashore at Subic Bay

All phases of the training program possessed a high degree of flexibility to ensure the responsiveness of the BLT to possible operational commitments, the REHAB program, and availability of training facilities.

2. Training during Phase I, Pre-embarkation, was somewhat limited by the operational requirements and commitments within 2nd Battalion, 7th Marine's Tactical Area of Responsibility (TAOR). The training accomplished during this phase centered on preparation for embarkation, familiarization firing of T/O Weapons, and orientation for life aboard ship.

3. Training during Phase II, Enroute to Subic Bay, was limited due to the requirement that all organic T/E class II type I equipment be turned in for Limited Technical Inspection (LTI). Consequently, training during this phase was directed toward instruction on conduct ashore, ship emergency drills, and individual responsibility.

Report Required: I. Report of training completed aboard ship enroute to Subic Bay (Refer to par. 2 encl. (1), (Report Symbol 2 BN. 1500)._____.

1. Purpose. To publish information pertaining to the BLT 2/7 training program during the shipboard and ashore phases of initial deployment.

2. Concept.

(a) All phases of the BLT 2/7 training will be directed toward preparing the BLT to perform its mission as the ground combat element of the SLF. The training program will be governed by directives of higher headquarters and operational commitments.

(b) The implementation of the training program will be in accordance with references (a) and (b) and other appropriate references.

3. Discussion.

(a) The afloat and ashore phases of the training program must possess a high degree of flexibility which will ensure the responsiveness of the BLT to the REHAB program, availability of training facilities and the requirement to respond to operational recall.

(b) All subject matter will be geared to the needs of the particular unit based on each unit leaders knowledge of his personnel, their state of training and proficiency. Instructional periods, both in the classroom and in the field, will focus on employment as tactical units. That is, each commanding officer or officer-in-charge will directly conduct or supervise those parts of the REHAB and training program in which his unit (a) are involved. Particular areas of emphasis will be:

- a. Maintenance and rehabilitation of equipment and weapons.
- b. Preparation for and conduct of the amphibious assault.
- c. Employment and coordination of all supporting arms.
- d. Offensive combined arms operations ashore.
- e. Field firing of all weapons.

4. Action.

(a) All unit commanders and officers-in-charge will familiarize themselves with references (a) and (b) and other appropriate directives pertaining to their areas of cognizance.

(b) The BLT S-3 will coordinate the training program with the SLE and the FMF PAC Liaison Officer, Subic.

(c) The BLT S-4 will take those coordination and supervisory actions necessary to ensure accomplishment of the KANAB program and coordinate and provide all logistics and transportation support necessary to ensure accomplishment of the BLT training program.

5. Effective Date: This directive is effective for planning upon receipt and becomes regulatory on 7 June 1968.

6. Self Cancellation. This bulletin is cancelled on 30 September 1968.

BLT SHIPBOARD TRAINING

1. The BLT shipboard training enroute to Subic Bay will be directed toward the individual Marine. The Commanding Officer of Troops aboard each ship will conduct training for embarked personnel as prescribed below.

- a. Ship's emergency drills.
- b. Helo enplaning and deplaning procedure.
- c. Physical conditioning.
- d. Familiarization firing of individual weapons.
- e. Care, cleaning and safety precautions for the M-16 rifle.
- f. Unit leaders instruction on conduct ashore.
- g. Moral guidance - to be conducted by BLT Chaplain.
- h. VD control.
- i. Dangers of Narcotics.
- j. First aid, self, Buddy aid.
- k. Individual responsibility in the event of attempted subversion.
- l. Handling POW's and captured documents and equipment.
- m. CBT in first and second echelon maintenance of T/S class II type III equipment.
- n. Review of casualty reporting.
- o. Orientation on the mission and organization of the SLF.

2. A limited number of lesson plans are available at the BLT S-3. Upon arrival at Subic Bay, a report will be submitted to this HQ (Attn: S-3) summarizing training accomplished citing time involved and personnel participating.

3. Direct supervision is required to ensure optimum utilization of available facilities, non-interference in the ship's operational routine, and to constructively occupy the individual Marine's time.

BLT 2/7 SUBIC BAY ASHORE TRAINING OUTLINE.

1. The BLT ashore training program at Subic Bay will be oriented toward the planning and execution of the ship-to-shore movement by helicopterborne, waterborne or a combined assault. In support of this training, an SLF CPX, a BLT LEX and a COMEX will be conducted.

2. Specific training topics are as follows:

- (a) Physical conditioning.
- (b) wet net training.
- (c) Movement to contact.
- (d) Company tactics.
- (e) LVT embark/debark training.
- (f) OJT first and second echelon maintenance of organic equipment.
- (g) Ship-to-shore movement.
- (h) RST control of ELZ.
- (i) Loading and movement of artillery batteries by helo, LVT and landing craft.
- (j) Coordination and employment of supporting arms.
- (k) Jungle environmental and survival training.
- (l) Field firing of individual and crew-served weapons.
- (m) Shore Fire Control Party training to include Firex.
- (n) FAC training to include live ordnance drop where available.
- (o) Communications training to include:
 - (1) Communications procedures.
 - (2) Communications security.
 - (3) Use of KAC-JAG and KAC-PAG codes.
 - (4) Helo land and movement of radio jeeps and radio relay equipment.
 - (5) COMEX
- (p) SLF administrative requirements.
- (q) Civic action training.
- (r) Rules of engagement.
- (s) Amphibious staff planning.
- (t) BLT LEX to include rehearsal and withdrawal.

3. Commanding Officers/Officers-in-Charge will be directly responsible for the conduct, supervision and preparation of each period of instruction. Particular emphasis should be placed on the integration of all components of the air-ground team.

4. Unit leaders may obtain a limited number of lesson plans from the BLT S-3. Most topics will require the preparation of lesson plans, reconnaissance, and liaison on the part of the OIC or instructor. Much of the training program will depend on the REMAB schedule and the availability of helos and other equipment. RE FLEXIBLE.
