2. Commander's Narrative Summary of Significant Events

During September Company "A" continued under Opcon 7th Engineer Battalion. The remainder of the Battalion continued exerting most of its effort in support of the 1st Marine Division. Tactical bridging support was provided to 1st Marine Division units during Operations FRESNO, NAPA, and GOLDEN FLEECE. Principal projects were:

- a. Improvement and maintenance of Route # 1 road and bridges
- b. 1st Marine Division Cantonment Assistance
- c. Operation of three ferries
- d. Operation of six water points
- e. Improvement of the 2nd LAAM Battalion's launcher sites and access road.
- f. Assistance to FLSG-Bravo to operate Material Storage Yard
- g. Work on the Battalion cantonment
- h. Operation of the Rock Crusher
- i. Provided engineer assistance in the construction of the Republic of the Korean Marines CP
- j. Construction of five observation towers for Chu Lai Defense Command
- k. Maintenance of FLSG-B ASP
- l. Maintenance of FLSG-B CP Area

| 15 Sept 1966 | Capt WILLIAMS and elements of "D" Co. constructed bridge bypass in support of Operation NAPA. |
| 16 Sept 1966 | SgtMaj J. B. CRANSTON assumed duties as 9th Engineer Battalion SgtMaj. |
| 19 Sept 1966 | Chaplain BURCH reported aboard for duty. |
| 26 Sept 1966 | MajGen DAVIS (HQMC) gave briefing to SNCO's and Officers of the 9th Engineer Battalion. |
| 26 Sept 1966 | Provided Chu Lai Defense Command with 19 mine sweep teams. |
