PART II: GENERAL CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS
DURING REPORTING PERIOD

During the reporting period the Battalion has executed the mission of Air Base Defense Battalion under the operational control of III MAF. Three reinforced rifle companies have been assigned the defense of the perimeter of the DANANG Air Base, while the fourth reinforced rifle company was assigned the mission of defense of Zones BRAVO and CHARLIE, which encompass the Marble Mountain Military Complex and the MON KY Mountain area. Additionally, the Battalion coordinated and regulated the defense activities of all the U. S. tenant units within its area of responsibility. All companies conducted aggressive patrols and ambushes throughout assigned sectors, saturating the area 24 hours a day. These patrols were closely coordinated with the Battalion's civil affairs activities and the patrols of the Combined Action Company whose six platoons were located in separate hamlets in the TAOR under the operational control of this Battalion. In addition to the continual improvement of the defensive positions, the Battalion also placed a great deal of emphasis on the integration and training of the large number of newly joined personnel in preparation for the Battalion's future employment in the 9th Marines zone of action. Because of the basic mission tasks and others assigned by higher authority, the formal training effort was necessarily very limited.

PART III: SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel. Detailed personnel data is contained in the S-1 Journal submitted as a supporting document. This Battalion had an increase in strength during this period. During this period there were no Marines WIA or KIA. This Battalion rotated two officers and 82 enlisted Marines to CONUS, reassigned three officers, and transferred 20 enlisted Marines by Service Record. Replacements of seven officers and 183 enlisted Marines were received. Fifty-five Marines were afforded the opportunity of R&R.

a. Seven Navy replacements were received, two were lost due to transfers. Four Navy personnel were afforded opportunity for R&R. During the period there was one Navy WIA.

2. Administration. Nothing significant.

3. Intelligence. This period was extremely quiet in all Defense Zones. Four minor contacts occurred throughout the month (see journal entries for 28 and 29 March). No significant intelligence was received concerning threats to any Defense Zone within the Battalion's TAOR.

a. Psychological Warfare. Psychological warfare activities were conducted through the following media:

(1) The I Corps (U. S. Army) Psy-War Team and the 3d Marine Division Band conducted programs at the HOA PHAT School (BT 033751) on 8 and 12 March, at HOA THO School (BT 002719) on 19 March, and at HOA CUONG School on 22 and 26 March. The I Corps Psy-War Team also conducted operations at HOA PHAT School on 29 March.

(2) Face-to-face persuasion was conducted by the companies' regularly scheduled patrols utilizing interpreters and/or leaflets. Pamphlets, magazines, leaflets, and hamlet bulletin boards were utilized by the companies in support of face-to-face persuasion.

b. Employment of AN/TPS-21. The set was inoperable from 1-8 March because of a defective generator which was evacuated to FLSG and reordered. Two PU-613/G generators were received by the Battalion and the set was employed on the northwest sector of the airfield perimeter on 18, 19, and 20 March. On the latter date, the set became unserviceable due to a faulty frequency converter-transmitter which was evacuated to FLSG on 21 March 1966.

(2) SID/150. The Battalion utilized 19 SID/150's during the month of March. The SID/150's were all employed on the DANANG Air Base perimeter with negative contact.

(3) Infrared Weaponsight. Seven scopes were in use by the Battalion on the perimeter defense. Four are deadlined because they lack cables and one is in FLSG for repair; four are in reserve at the Battalion Armory. There have been no reported contacts during the period.

4. Training. All units received periodic instruction concerning the mission and role of U. S. Forces in the Republic of VIETNAM, the rules of engagement, and treatment of prisoners. Additionally, a training program was conducted for all hands designed to maintain the Battalion at the highest possible state of combat readiness and to rapidly integrate into teams all newly joined personnel. Emphasis in training was placed on scouting and patrolling, familiarization and battlesight firing, and VC mines and booby-traps. Battalion and company level schools were also conducted in supporting arms, FO procedures, communications, motor transport, helicopter support, supply, civil affairs, land navigation, and Vietnamese language and customs. On 16 March the Battalion's training program was inspected as a part of the Commanding General's Inspection and found to be satisfactory in all respects.

5. Special Operations. Nothing significant.

6. Nuclear, Biological, and Chemical Warfare. Nothing significant.

7. Command and Control. During the period 14 March to 19 March, this command underwent the Commanding General's Inspection and was found to be satisfactory. All minor discrepancies noted have since been corrected.

8. Communications-Electronics. Nothing significant.

9. Close Combat. During the reporting period enemy contact has been limited to five instances of light harassing small arms fire and the intensive patrol and ambush activity by the Battalion has resulted in the apprehension of six VCS and three VCC.

10. Fire Support and Fire Support Coordination. Nothing significant.

11. Logistics

a. Significant Events

(1) On 5 March a limited technical inspection team completed an inspection of the organic weapons of this Battalion. All defective weapons were tagged and are being repaired on a scheduled basis.

(2) On 6 March, 19 new M422A1 mighty mites were received by this organization.

(3) On 9 March, a limited technical inspection team completed an inspection of the optical equipment of this Battalion. There were two pairs of 6x30 binoculars coded X, 24 pairs of 6x30 and three pairs of 7x50 binoculars turned in for repair and refurbishing.

(4) During the period 14-19 March a Commanding General's Inspection was held at this command. The following areas under the staff cognizance of the S-4 were inspected:

- (a) S-4 Office
- (b) Embarkation
- (c) Ordnance
- (d) Supply and Fiscal
- (e) Food Services
- (f) Motor Transport

Noted discrepancies were few and those within the capabilities of this unit have been corrected.

(5) On 15 March engineers from the 7th Engineer Battalion commenced repair of existing light fixtures in the southwest corner of the DANANG Air Base perimeter. This task was satisfactorily completed by 20 March.

(6) On 18 March construction of 8x8x8 bunkers in the southwest corner of the DANANG Air Base was commenced. To date, the construction of 12 bunkers has been completed.

(7) On 24 March, engineers from the 7th Engineers completed the movement of 11 strongbacks from MAC-11 to the following locations:

12. Air Defense. Nothing Significant.

13. Combat Air Support. Nothing Significant.

14. Medical and Dental Support. On 11 March HM3 B. E. NEILAN was transferred to Station Hospital, DANANG EAST for further transfer to Great Lakes, Illinois. Diagnosis was Hepatitis. On 14 March an administrative inspection was conducted by the Regimental Surgeon. On 16 March 1966 immunizations were given to Company "B". On 17 March an administrative inspection was conducted by the Division Surgeon. On 25 March 1966 the immunization program for the Battalion was revised in accordance with 3d Marine Division Order 6000.7. On 29 March immunizations were given to half of H&S Company and one HMI received for duty. On 30 March immunizations were given to the second half of H&S Company, six HM's were received for duty, and a substitute examination for E-4's was administered at the Division Surgeon's Office. On 31 March immunizations were administered to stragglers from H&S Company.

a. The Battalion Surgeon anticipates losing seven HM's in the month of April. At the present time BAS has 54 enlisted personnel.

15. Chaplain Support

a. Regular Protestant and Catholic services were available to all companies on Sunday during March. Weekday services were also established for all companies except Company "B". The Battalion Chaplain conducted three services each Sunday and three weekday services each week for the Battalion. In addition, the Chaplain conducted a service for RLDS personnel each Sunday. Communion services were held as appropriate. A regular visiting program has been established to company CP areas and perimeter lines.

b. "Operation Mail Call VIETNAM" still continues with several letters and boxes to the troops which have been distributed equally among the companies as much as possible.

c. Counselling on personnel problems was held with 28 men of the Battalion during March. This counselling had characteristics normal to garrison living.

d. Church parties left the Battalion for Jewish, Later Day. Saints, Christian Science, and Roman Catholic Church services.

e. Moral guidance and the first religions of VIETNAM lecture were held with all new personnel on arrival. Except for about 5% stragglers, the entire Battalion has been given the moral guidance lecture and the first religions of VIETNAM lecture.

16. Civil Affairs

a. The civic action effort during the month of March was divided into two programs. The principal effort was focused on the hamlets bordering the DANANG EAST Complex. The pacification and civic action program, initiated in those hamlets during the month of February was continued. Additionally the villages of HOA PHAT, HOA THO, HOA CUONG, and the DANANG suburb, that surround the DANANG Air Base, received a large measure of the civic action effort. These areas, having been government controlled and well organized, presented no major problems to the civic action program.

b. The medical and sanitation assistance program was continued throughout the TAOR by MEDCAP patrols and dental assistance:

(1) MEDCAP patrols brought medical assistance to the villages of HOA THO, HOA CUONG, the DANANG suburb, and the following hamlets of HOA LONG Village: DA MAN (1) (BT 058734), DA MAN (2) (BT 056728), and MY THI (BT 052744).

(2) Dental assistance was provided to the people from the above mentioned hamlets in HOA LONG Village.

(3) Soap was distributed to all persons receiving medical assistance.

(4) Over 400 school children were provided with tooth-brushes.

(5) A number of sick civilians were evacuated from the various villages in the TAOR.

(6) The Battalion Surgeon assisted at the USOM Hospital in the city of DANANG.

(7) Nine Popular Force Medics were trained in basic field medicine by the Battalion Surgeon.

c. The construction of a school in MY THI hamlet (BT 052744) was completed and the school was opened. Repairs were completed on the school in the hamlet of DA MAN (1) (BT 058734). Eighty-five CARE school kits were presented to the pupils of both schools.

d. The Combined Action Company continued to play an important role in the civic action effort in the villages that surround the Air Base.

(1) The company had daily contact with the local people and provided medical assistance for a large number of people.

(2) The Vietnamese members of the company were trained in hygiene and field medicine.

(3) The company initiated the repair of a large foot-bridge, one of the principal lines of communication in HCA PHAT Village, in PHUOC LUCC hamlet (AT 989784).
