B. Listing of Significant Events

(1) Personnel

- (a) There were 83 Lance Corporals, and 122 Privates First Class promoted during April 1966.
- (b) Rotatees. There were 2 Officers, 126 enlisted personnel (includes 10 USN enlisted) transferred to CONUS during the reporting period. The percentage transferred: 12%
- (c) Casualties. There were 12 KIAs, 116 WIAs, 2 DOWs and 16 non-battle casualties during the reporting period.
- (d) The percentage of T/O strength on 30 April 1966 was: 89%.

- (2) Administration. A total of 66 personnel were sent on R&R during the reporting period.

(3) Intelligence.

- (a) During the period 1-3 April, the battalion had light to moderate contact with VC forces.
- (b) During the period 3-10 April, the battalion had moderate to heavy contact with VC forces.
- (c) During the period 10-14 April, the battalion had moderate contact with VC forces.
- (d) During the period 14-30 April, the battalion had moderate to heavy contact with VC forces.

- (e) At 160400H April 1966, Company H vicinity AT 976585 was attacked by a large VC ground force including 81mm and 60mm mortars and 57mm Recoilless Rifles. The ground and mortar attacks started simultaneously. The VC took heavy casualties. At one point 22 bodies were counted; VC kept returning to drag off the dead and wounded. Company H received a total of 150 to 160 incoming 60mm and 81mm mortars. After the failure of the VC main assault, they proceeded to break up into small units and continued with probing attacks.

The USMC casualties were 7 KIA, 37 WIA's while VC casualties came to 12 KIA (body count) and 63 possible KIA's.

- (f) The majority of contact with the VC forces during the reporting period ranged from platoon to company size search and destroy missions in which light to heavy small arms fire, 81mm mortars and 57mm RR fire was received from the VC forces. The fire was generally from tree lines and across the rice paddies. The VC continue to have excellent preplanned routes of escape and remain proficient in the art of camouflage. Battlefield police remains outstanding. The VC still refuse to engage in fire fights unless they feel they have an overwhelming number of personnel and superior fire power.
- (g) The boobytraps and contacts continue to be on the increase. The mines and boobytraps usually are found in the hedgerows, treelines and on the trails. The M-26 fragmentation grenade is the most common boobytrap used. The bamboo and steel punji traps are still used by the VC forces throughout the area.

(4) Training. During this reporting period, the following training was conducted:

- (a) All personnel were instructed on Rules of Engagement and safety of individual weapons.
- (b) A training program consisting of 4 days of classes and instruction has been established and carried out for replacement Marines.
- (c) Rifle companies conducted varied numbers of hours of instructions dependent upon operational commitments, emphasizing gun drill, scouting and patrolling, small unit tactics, first aid, FO procedures, and demolitions. The Claymore mine and M-72 were taught to selected personnel.

(7') In addition to the general training, approximately one hundred hours were utilized in care and cleaning on individual and crew served weapons, radio maintenance and voice procedure for communications personnel and 30 hours of employment of the 106mm recoilless rifle for the 106mm RR Plt.

(8') The 81mm Mortar Platoon conducted 120 hours of training on the basic functioning and utilization of the 81mm mortar. Approximately 65 hrs were utilized on preventive maintenance

- (5) Operational Summary. During the period 1-30 April, 2d Bn, 9th Marines continued to defend their sector of 9th Marines TAOR. During this period, mobile platoons from the forward companies were continuously moving and numerous company size search and destroy or clearing operations were conducted in the southern portion of our TAOR.

ROUGH RIDERS were conducted to Phu Bai by Co E on 4-6 April and by Co H on 10-11 April. Both ROUGH RIDERS proceeded without opposition except an occasional harrassing small arms round.

COUNTY FAIR Operations were conducted in coordination with ARVN in Ha Dong (AT 9964), An Tu (1) (BT 0263) and Thanh Quit (3) (BT 057635). The COUNTY FAIRS in Ha Dong and Thanh Quit were extremely successful in terms of VC KIA and the destruction of the VC infrastructure..

On 25 April a combined action platoon consisting of 19 Popular Force, 1 ARVN Warrant Officer and 10 Marines was activated in Phong Le (1) (AT 9969).

On 20 April, Co F departed on Operation GEORGIA under OPCON 3/9.

On 14-15 April, 2/9 assumed OPCON of Co C, 1st Bn, 4th Marines and Co G, 2d Bn, 9th Marines. These two companies occupied and operated in the northern (rear) part of 2/9's TAOR.

Companies E and H and the battalion command group were helilifted to Da Nang on 9 April to provide security and supervision for the evacuation of U.S. civilian and military personnel. Companies G and H and the battalion command group conducted a clearing operation in the southern portion of the 2/9 TAOR from 16-18 April and a search and destroy mission on 29 April along the southern edge of of the 2/9 TAOR. The latter operation was converted into a blocking force in support of Operation GEORGIA.

During the month of April, twelve company size clearing or search and destroy operations were conducted and were marked by scattered physical or visual contact with the VC but increasing contact with VC mines and booby traps. On 15 April Co H engaged 3 companies of VC in a 3 hour battle. The VC utilized an intensive mortar preparation fire then assaulted Co H's defense perimeter. This constituted the only heavy engagement during April.

- (14) Medical Support. The Battalion Aid Station treated approximately 1324 Vietnamese civilians in the people to people sick call. At the same time 1427 Marines were treated and 2700 immunizations administered to men of this battalion. The battalion aid station also participated in classes administered to replacement Marines.
- (15) Chaplain Support. Mass was offered and Protestant coverage for the battalion CP and rifle companies at the convenience of each unit. Memorial services were held, Catholic and Protestant in the respective companies concerned.

Visits to the village of An Trach were made weekly, serving the needs of the villagers there with confessions and Mass. Lectures were initiated on the Religions of Vietnam giving them to new replacements as they report to the battalion.

- (16) Civil Affairs. During the month of April a total of 1,323 Vietnamese civilians were treated. Also during the month the following items were distributed: 750 lbs of bulgar, 200 lbs of wheat, 64 canisters of slat, 225 sewing kits, 160 lbs of clothing, 150 lbs of rice, 75 boxes of bubble bath, 3,201 pieces of candy, 1,675 bars of unwrapped soap, 1 baby blanket, 48 cans of soup, 259 school kits, 5 physical education kits, 2 masonry kits, 25 VN comic books and 50 Vietnamese literature pamphlets.
