

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During this period 1-31 May 1967, this battalion continued in the defense of Camp J. J. CARROLL and the CUA VALLEY area (YD 095515). Emphasis was placed on aggressive patrolling within the respective company sectors to counter and minimize enemy activity in these areas. The battalion established outposts, listening posts, and ambushes throughout the assigned TAOR.

From 18-28 May 1967, this battalion was engaged in a search and destroy operation (Operation Hickory) in the Quan Cam Lo District and Quan Gio Linh District, Quang Tri Province, Republic of Vietnam. During this operation emphasis was placed on saturation patrolling of assigned objective areas to deny the enemy any use of the area and destroy any enemy encountered.

Change of Command was effected on 29 May when Major V. J. WOODRING, Jr. relieved Lieutenant Colonel J. S. WILSON.



In addition, the Chaplain conducted troop indoctrination lectures, counseled 42 people, wrote six letters, and accompanied the Civil ffairs Officer for £ village dedication.
