ORGANIZATIONAL DATA

A. The period covered by this report extends from 1 November 1967 to 30 November 1967.

B. Location: On 30 November 1967, the 11th Motor Transport Battalion was in general support of the 1st Marine Division from its base camp at AT948762.

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. During November the Battalion's main efforts were in support of the 11th Marine Regiment with particular emphasis on India Battery at Hill #65. At the end of the month this Battalion offloaded BLT 2/3 and moved it to the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines camp. It then moved BLT 3/1 from its old camp to the Tien Sha LST Ramp. The Battalion conducted four "ROUGH RIDER" convoys during the month; three were to Phu Bai and one to Quang Tri. In addition, the Battalion participated in "ROUGH RIDER" convoys conducted by the 1st and 3rd Motor Transport Battalions.

B. Special monsoon requirements are being met by the maintenance section. The theater is being enclosed to permit the showing of movies during inclement weather. Monsoon items including rain clothing, fighting hole covers, and shower shoes have been received and distributed. In accordance with establishing a Real Property account, all buildings in the Battalion compound have been numbered. The Battalion also conducted an operators school to train personnel on the M-76 Amphibious Cargo Carrier. The Battalion is now prepared to provide marginal terrain support to the 1st Marine Division during the monsoon season. The Battalion has received its issue of M-16 rifles and is now in the process of distributing and zeroing them. The Battalion's vehicles were brought up to T/E strength with the receipt of two M-54 cargo trucks and one M-52 truck tractor.

C. Civil Affairs MEDCAPS treated 350 Vietnamese and PSYOPS movies were shown to over 400 Vietnamese. Medical assistance was also provided in the evacuation of a child to the childrens hospital at the Force Logistics Command and the evacuation of two persons to the U. S. S. REPOSE.

D. There have been no instances of enemy contact on the perimeter during this period. One M-54 was ambushed in Hai Van pass at grid coordinates AT924926 resulting in one WIA from this Battalion and eight WIA's from other organizations. Another M-54 struck a mine which resulted in one WIA from this Battalion and six WIA's from the 7th Marines.

E. The Battalion drove 131,872 miles, transported 14,350 tons and carried 41,277 troops during this month.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- a. 1 November 1967: The Battalion carried on normal operations in support of the 1st Marine Division.
- b. 2 November 1967: A convoy of 12 M-54 trucks transported 43 tons of Class V supplies from Bridge Ramp to "H" Battery, 11th Marines. A serial of 16 tractor trailer units and seven M-54 trucks joined a 1st Motor Transport Battalion Rough Rider, and traveled to Phu Bai where it remained overnight.
- c. 3 November 1967. The "ROUGH RIDER" serial departed Phu Bai. Four tractor trailer units and four M-54 trucks with the 1st Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" returned to this organization while 12 tractor trailer units and three M-54 trucks remained overnight at Check Point #58.
- d. 4 November 1967: The remainder of the serial with the 1st Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" returned from Check Point #58. A serial of 17 M-54 trucks joined a 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" ultimately bound for Quang Tri. This "ROUGH RIDER" stayed overnight at Check Point #33. A "ROUGH RIDER" convoy departed this organization and moved to Check Point #58. After loading at Check Point #58, the convoy returned to Check Point #5 and remained overnight.
- e. 5 November 1967: A convoy of eight tractor trailer units transported 84 tons of matting to Hill #10 and returned to this organization. The "ROUGH RIDER" returned to Danang from Check Point #5. The serial that joined the 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" moved from Check Point #33 to Phu Bai and remained there overnight.
- f. 6 November 1967: The serial with the 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" moved from Phu Bai to Quang Tri and remained overnight. One M-54 truck from this Battalion was ambushed at grid coordinates AT924926 at 1641. This ambush resulted in nine USMC WIA's, one of which was a member of this organization.
- g. 7 November 1967: The serial with the 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" moved from Quang Tri to Phu Bai and remained overnight. A "ROUGH RIDER" moved from this organization composed of 10⁵ vehicles departed Danang and traveled to Phu Bai where it remained overnight. An M-54 truck from this Battalion struck a mine at DT348563, resulting in seven USMC WIA's, one of which was a member of this organization.

h. 8 November 1967: The "ROUGH RIDER" was forced to remain at Phu Bai because of road obstacles at Check Points #58 and #5.

i. 9 November 1967: The "ROUGH RIDER" convoy returned to Danang from Phu Bai.

j. 10 November 1967: This Battalion carried on normal operations.

k. 11 November 1967: A "ROUGH RIDER" convoy consisting of 88 vehicles departed Danang for Quang Tri and spent the night in Phu Bai.

l. 12 November 1967: The "ROUGH RIDER" departed Phu Bai, traveled to Quang Tri and spent the night. A second convoy of eight M-54 trucks transported one company of Marines from 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines camp to the 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines camp and remained overnight. A third convoy of six tractor-trailer units hauled 72 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned to this organization.

m. 13 November 1967: The "ROUGH RIDER" convoy departed Quang Tri and turned to Danang. A second convoy of six tractor-trailer units hauled 62 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned to this organization.

n. 14 November 1967: The Battalion carried on normal motor transport operations in support of the 1st Marine Division.

o. 15 November 1967: The Battalion carried on normal motor transport operations in support of the 1st Marine Division.

p. 16 November 1967: A serial of 11 M-54 trucks transporting 40 tons of Class III and 10 tons of Class V supplies joined a Force Logistics Command convoy to An Hoa. The convoy, unable to reach its destination due to an impassable section of road, stayed overnight at the 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines camp. A second serial of 10 tractor-trailer units and two M-54 trucks joined a 1st Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" and traveled to Phu Bai.

q. 17 November 1967: The vehicles with the 1st Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" returned to Danang. The serial with the Force Logistics Command convoy traveled from the 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines camp to An Hoa and remained overnight.

r. 18 November 1967: The serial traveling with the Force Logistics Command Convoy returned to this organization from An Hoa.

s. 19 November 1967: This Battalion carried on normal operations in support of the 1st Marine Division.

t. 20 November 1967: A serial composed of 10 vehicles joined a 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" and traveled to Phu Bai.

u. 21 November 1967: A serial of five tractor-trailer units carrying two M-76 amphibious cargo carriers, eight tons of PX supplies and one 155mm gun barrel joined a Force Logistics Command convoy to An Hoa and remained overnight. A second convoy of four tractor-trailer units carried 45 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned to Danang.

v. 22 November 1967: The "ROUGH RIDER" serial moved from Phu Bai to Quang Tri with a 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER." A convo of six tractor-trailer units and two M-54 trucks hauled 75 tons of matting to An Hoa and remained overnight. The serial with the Force Logistics Command convoy departed An Hoa and remained overnight in the 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines Camp.

w. 23 November 1967: The serial participating in the 3rd Motor Transport Battalion "ROUGH RIDER" moved from Quang Tri to Phu Bai where it remained until 26 November 1967. The convoy composed of six tractor-trailer units and two M-54 trucks returned to Danang from An Hoa.

x. 24 November 1967: A convoy of seven M-54 trucks picked up 200 Marines at Check Point #32 and transported them to the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines Camp. The convoy then proceeded south to Check Point #22, picked up bridging trailers, towed them to the 7th Engineer Battalion camp and returned to this command.

y. 25 November 1967: A "ROUGH RIDER" convoy composed of 127 vehicles departed Danang and traveled to Phu Bai.

z. 26 November 1967: The "ROUGH RIDER" convoy returned to Danang from Phu Bai.

aa. 27 November 1967: A convoy composed of four tractor-trailer units transported 48 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned to Danang.

bb. 28 November 1967: A convoy of four tractor trailer units carried 43 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned to Danang.

cc. 29 November 1967: Nineteen tractor trailer units and seven M-54 trucks began the movement of BLT 2/3 from the Tien Sha LST Ramp to the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines Camp. This move was completed on 1 December 1967.

dd. 30 November 1967: Commenced moving BLT 3/1 from their camp to the Tien Sha LST Ramp. This move was completed on 2 December 1967. A convoy of eight M-54 trucks picked up Marines at Check Point #6 and transported them to the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines Camp.
